# OPPONENTS

## Kennedy's 10<sup>th</sup>

**H** heading into the 1990-91 season most experts thought it would be Pat Kennedy's most challenging. Not only did his team consist of only three seniors, but he was also facing a schedule ranked among the five toughest in the country. Proving equal to the challenge, Kennedy led a 17-10 club into the Metro Conference tournament as the number two seed and one intent on claiming the school's first Metro title.

Facing perennial power Louisville for the championship, Kennedy found his team trailing 56-36 with 17:03 left in the contest. Using precise offensive plays and a suffocating defense, the Seminoles went on a 40-15 run over the game's final 17 minutes to claim a 76-69 victory and the conference's automatic bid to NCAA Tournament play.

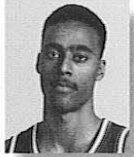

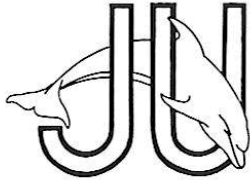

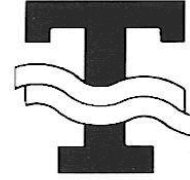

# The Atlantic Coast Conference: A Tradition of Excellence

## The Tradition

Consistency. It's the mark of true excellence in any endeavor.

However, in today's intercollegiate athletics, competition has become so balanced and so competitive that it is virtually impossible to maintain a high level of consistency.

Yet the Atlantic Coast Conference has defied the odds. Now in its 43rd year of competition, the ACC has long enjoyed the reputation as one of the strongest and most competitive intercollegiate conferences in the nation. And that is not mere conjecture, the numbers support it.

Since the league's inception in 1953, Atlantic Coast Conference schools have captured 55 NCAA and AIAW championships, including 30 in men's competition and 25 in women's. In addition, 90 men and 22 women have earned the coveted title of NCAA champion.

If success is best measured in terms of wins and losses, then the ACC is unrivaled in NCAA history. ACC teams have captured seven NCAA basketball championships, including three straight between 1991 and 1993.

No conference has posted a better NCAA Tournament record than the ACC since the NCAA's inaugural tournament in 1938. The nine current conference members have posted an NCAA Tournament-best mark of 237-123 for a .658 winning percentage. In the decade of the '90s, the ACC success story is even more impressive as league teams have compiled a 74-28 (.725) NCAA mark, including 20 "Sweet 16" appearances.

North Carolina, the nation's all-time winningest team with 1,626 wins, captured NCAA championships in 1957, 1982 and 1993. N.C. State walked away with the coveted crown in 1974 and 1983 while Duke won back-to-back titles in 1991 and 1992.

Over the years, ACC basketball teams have gained global recognition through their NCAA Tournament and national television exposure. The 1995-96 ACC television schedule boasts nearly 200 appearances by its nine member institutions. An all-time high 63 of the league's 72 regular season conference matchups will be televised as well as the league's four-day, eight-game ACC Tournament.

The ACC also stands at the forefront of intercollegiate athletics in terms of academic accomplishments of its student-athletes. A year ago, North Carolina's second-team All-ACC center Eric Montross became the 31st ACC player to earn first team Academic All America honors.

In addition, seven times over the past 11 years, an ACC school has claimed the CFA Academic Achievement Award, recognizing the school with the highest graduation rate among members of its football team. This past year, Duke captured the coveted award for the third straight year and sixth time overall. In addition, the ACC had four of the 20 CFA members who reported graduation rates of 70 percent or better.

## 1994-95 In Review

The 1994-95 academic year will be remembered as one of the best in the 42-year history of the ACC. Conference teams captured three national titles while two other ACC teams participated in national title games. In all, the ACC has won 21 national team crowns in the last five years.

The 1994-95 national champions from the ACC were Virginia in men's soccer, North Carolina in women's soccer and Maryland in women's lacrosse.

The two NCAA runners-up were Maryland in men's lacrosse and North Carolina in field hockey. Overall, ACC teams were 57-39-1 (.592) in NCAA Tournament play.

In addition, four ACC schools – North Carolina, Virginia, Duke and Florida State – were ranked in the top 25 of the Sears Directors' Cup, an all-sports award honoring the Division I school with the best performance by women's and men's athletic teams during the 1994-95 academic year.

Overall the ACC placed at least one team in the top 10 nationally in 13 of the 23 sports sponsored by the league. Other records of note during the 1994-95 campaign include 79 teams competing at NCAA championships, five bowl teams and 24 Top 10 showings.

Eight ACC teams, in seven different sports, representing five of the nine member institutions, earned a No. 1 ranking during the course of the 1994-95 academic year.

The ACC Academic Honor Roll record was broken for the ninth-straight year as 1,171 student-athletes were recognized for their work in the classroom.

## The Championships

The Atlantic Coast Conference currently conducts championship competition in 23 sports, including 12 for men and 11 for women.

The first ACC championship was held in swimming on February 25, 1954, while the league's inaugural basketball tournament took place March 4-6, 1954, at North Carolina State, drawing 36,000 fans over the three days. The conference did not conduct championships in cross country, wrestling or tennis during the first year.

The 12 sports for men include football, cross country, soccer, basketball, swimming, indoor and outdoor track, wrestling, baseball, tennis, golf and lacrosse. Fencing, which was started in 1971, was discontinued in 1981.

Women's sports were initiated in 1977 with the first championship meet being held in tennis at Wake Forest University, October 6-8.

Conference championships for women are currently conducted in cross country, volleyball, field hockey, soccer, basketball, swimming, indoor and outdoor track, tennis, golf and softball.

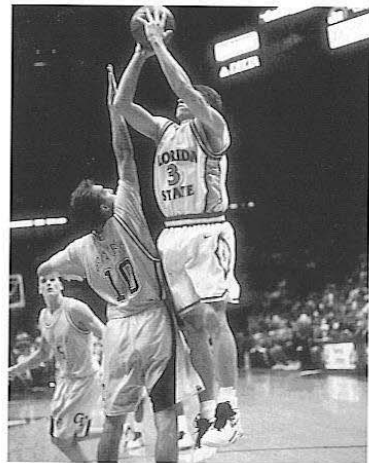
