Little did Pat

Kennedy know that when he signed a lightly regarded recruit from Wilkes-Barre, PA during the spring of 1991, that four years later Kennedy would mold him into the most prolific scorer in school history and one of the most accomplished players in Atlantic Coast Conference annals. That is exactly what happened when Kennedy inked Bob Sura to a scholarship offer that year. Sura shattered Bob Oler's 39-year old record as Florida State's all-time leading scorer with 2,130 career points. He became the only player in ACC history to amass over 2,000 points while collecting 700 rebounds, 400 assists and 200 steals in a career.

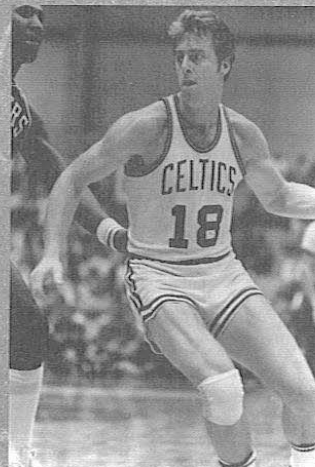

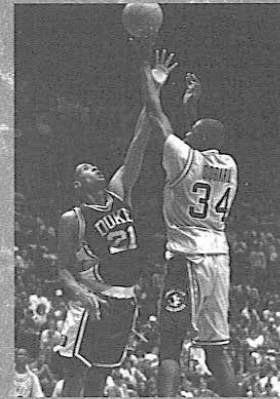

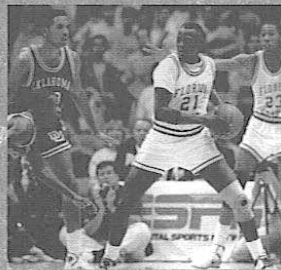

**Don Loucks
(1947-48)**

Don Loucks, one of the most respected members of the Florida State athletic family, was the first coach of men's intercollegiate basketball at FSU. He guided the team to a 5-13 record during the 1947-48 season.

Loucks would go on to become a member of FSU's Hall of Fame after six decades with the university. The tennis courts at the university are named in honor of Don Loucks.

**J.K. Kennedy
(1948-66)**

J.K. Kennedy was better known as "Bud" during his 18 years as head coach of the Florida State program. A warm and compassionate man, Kennedy led the Seminoles from a limited program to major college status. He compiled a record of 237-208 from 1948-49 to 1965-66. His finest single season came in 1954-55 when he coached the Tribe, led by future Hall of Famers Jimmy Oler, and Ham Wernke, to a 22-4 record.

**Hugh Durham
(1967-78)**

Hugh Durham's tenure at Florida State included four 20-win seasons and saw the program play for the national championship in 1972. Durham led the Seminoles to a 230-95 record and his .708 winning percentage was among the nation's best. He took FSU to three NCAA Tournaments.

Durham also made an impact with the Florida State program as a player in the late 1950s. From 1956-59 he scored 1,281 points, an average of 18.9 a game. His name is still prominent in many FSU records.

**Joe Williams
(1978-86)**

Joe Williams took over as head coach of the Seminoles in 1978 after very successful stops at Jacksonville (1964-70) and Furman (1970-78). He led the FSU program for eight seasons and won 129 games while losing 105. He took Florida State to the NCAA Tournament in 1977-78 (0-1) and 1979-80 (1-1) and to the National Invitational Tournament in 1983-84 (1-1). The Seminoles had two 20-win seasons under his leadership.

**Pat Kennedy
(1986-present)**

Pat Kennedy is credited with leading the Florida State program back to national prominence. Kennedy registered a Metro Conference regular season and tournament championship before the school joined the ACC five years ago.

Kennedy has led the Seminoles to five NCAA Tournament berths and one N.I.T. appearance in his 10 years. FSU advanced to the Final Eight of the 1993 NCAA Tournament, marking the second best season in FSU history.

Florida State is 182-119 under Kennedy, having posted a .604 winning percentage in his 10 seasons. Kennedy set a record for road wins and total ACC wins by a first-year coach with six and 11 respectively, in 1991-92.

SEMINOLES IN THE PROS

W

ith five former players listed on NBA rosters to open the 1996-97 season, few college basketball programs are better represented at the highest level of basketball in the world than Florida State. FSU has had a first round pick in the NBA Draft four times in the last four years. Bob Sura, the Seminoles' all-time leading scorer, was the Tribe's most recent No. 1 pick, going to the Cleveland Cavaliers with the 17th pick in the 1995 NBA Draft.

Sura joined former Florida State teammates Charlie Ward (New York Knicks), Doug Edwards (Vancouver Grizzlies) and Sam Cassell (Phoenix Suns), along with George McCloud (Dallas Mavericks) in the NBA.

Florida State was well represented in the opening round of the 1993 draft. For the first time in school history, a pair of Seminoles were selected in the first round as Edwards (Atlanta Hawks) and Cassell (Houston Rockets) were taken with the 15th and 24th picks, respectively.

Cassell has wasted little time making a mark in the league, helping the Rockets capture NBA titles in his first two years. Cassell was Houston's third leading scorer in his third season before being traded to the Phoenix Suns last summer.

McCloud came into his own during the 1995-96 season and ranked second on the Mavericks in scoring. He is also one of the NBA's best three-point shooters and participated in the league's three-point shootout during last year's All-Star Weekend.

Ward and Sura made solid contributions to their teams last year as well. Ward started to blossom with the Knicks late in the season and played the best basketball of his pro career in the NBA Playoffs against the Chicago Bulls. Sura came off the bench for the Cavaliers and participated in the NBA's Rookie All-Star Game. Edwards, meanwhile, spent most of last season on injured reserve.

Dave Cowens remains Florida State's most accomplished alum in the NBA ranks. He was named the Charlotte Hornets head coach at the conclusion of the 1995-96 season, after working as an assistant coach for the San Antonio Spurs. Cowens enjoyed a long career with the Boston Celtics, leading them to a pair of world titles. The star center is a member of both the FSU and NBA Hall of Fame. He

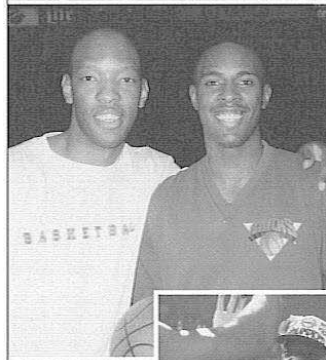
played nine years in the NBA and was the first Seminole ever taken in the draft's opening round when Boston tabbed him in 1970.

Florida State has had eight players taken in the first round of the NBA Draft, including five in the last eight seasons under Pat Kennedy. In Kennedy's 10 seasons at the helm of the FSU program, nine of his players have had NBA careers. Under Kennedy, 11 Seminoles have gone on to sign NBA contracts.

In the 49-year history of the Florida State basketball program, 30 Seminoles have been taken in the draft and 34 players have signed NBA contracts. Dave Fedor was the first FSU alum selected in the draft when the Philadelphia 76ers chose him in the third round in 1962.

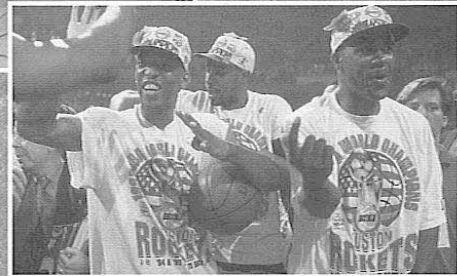

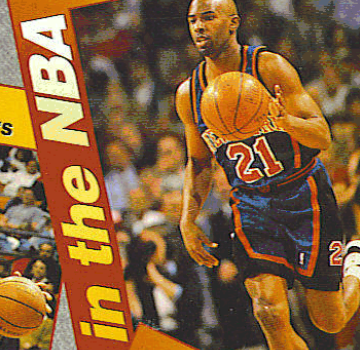
