The ACC Tournament:

“The Top Event of its Kind in the Nation.”

The 47th annual Atlantic Coast Conference Tournament, long recognized as the top event of its kind in the nation, is again in Charlotte, NC and the Charlotte Coliseum for the second straight year in 2000 on March 9-12.

Last year, Duke captured the ACC Tournament crown, defeating North Carolina in the championship game. Total attendance for the four-day, eight-game tournament exceeded 100,000 for the eighth consecutive year.

Seven of this year's eight games will be televised on a national basis by ESPN and ESPN2, while one first round game, the quarterfinals, semifinals and championship game will be aired regionally by the conference's Raycom/Jefferson-Pilot Sports Network. ESPN's coverage marks the 18th straight year that the championship game has been telecast nationally.

The ACC has always determined its basketball champion by tournament play, a continuation of a style which began with the formation of the Southern Conference in 1921. The main reason for the continuation of the championship by tournament format is the tremendous popularity of the event with fans in the nation's finest basketball conference.

Since being moved from NC State's Reynolds Coliseum, where it was held for 13 consecutive years (1954-66), the Tournament has been held at the original Charlotte Coliseum, the Capital Centre in Landover, MD and the Omni in Atlanta, GA, three times each and the new Charlotte Coliseum five times.

The inaugural ACC Tournament in 1954 attracted 38,000 fans for the seven games at Reynolds Coliseum. In 1995, an all-time high 114,044 fans attended the tournament. Over the past two decades, there has not been a public sale of tickets and all of the tournaments have been sold out in advance. The tickets are equally distributed among the ACC's nine member institutions.
