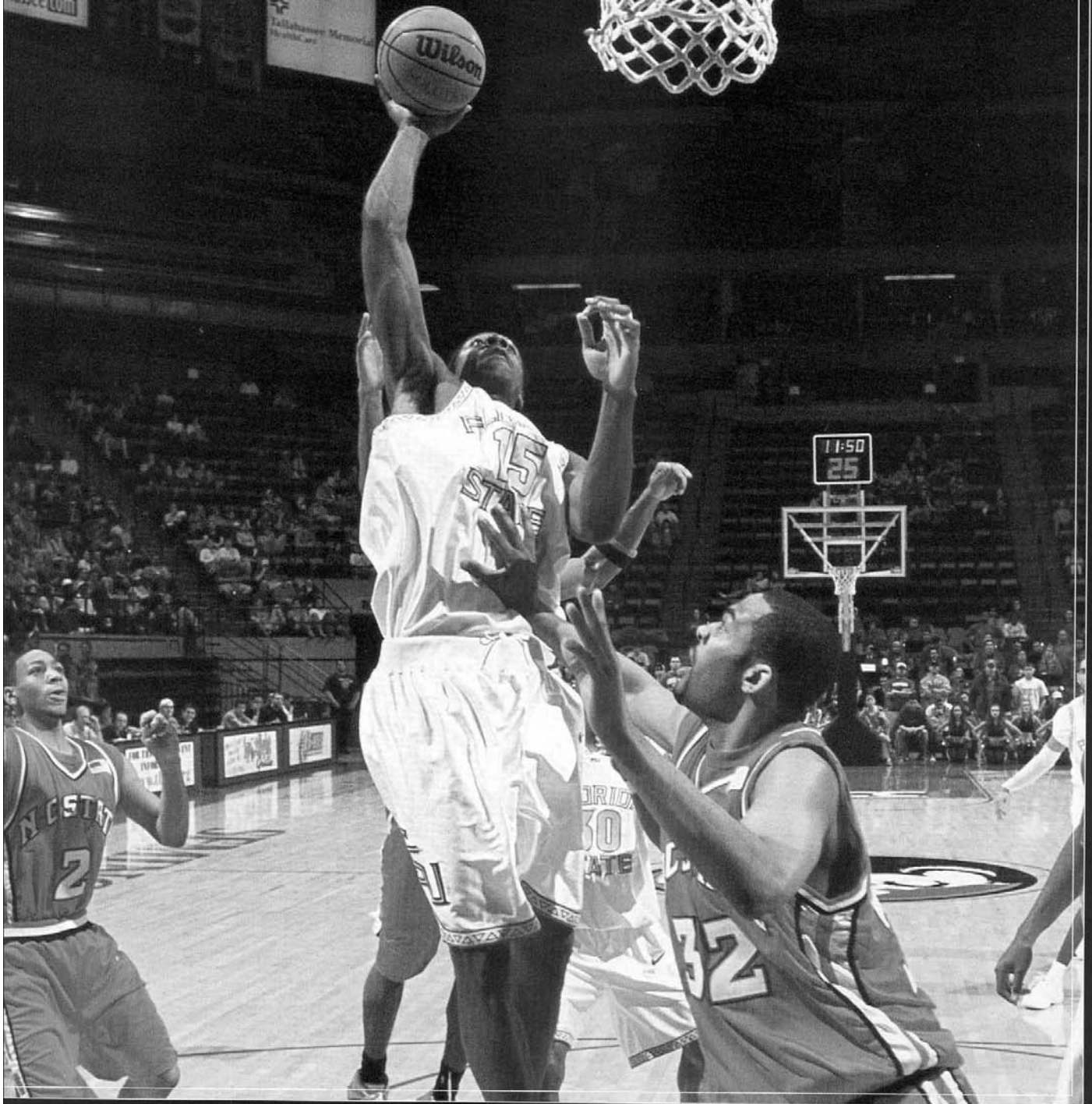

Florida State Basketball On The Road



The Florida State men's basketball team travels on charter airplanes to nearly every destination on its schedule throughout the season. Charter flights reduce travel time considerably and allow the team to get to any location easily and comfortably. In addition, this type of travel minimizes time away from campus and out of class which increases time spent concentrating on academics.

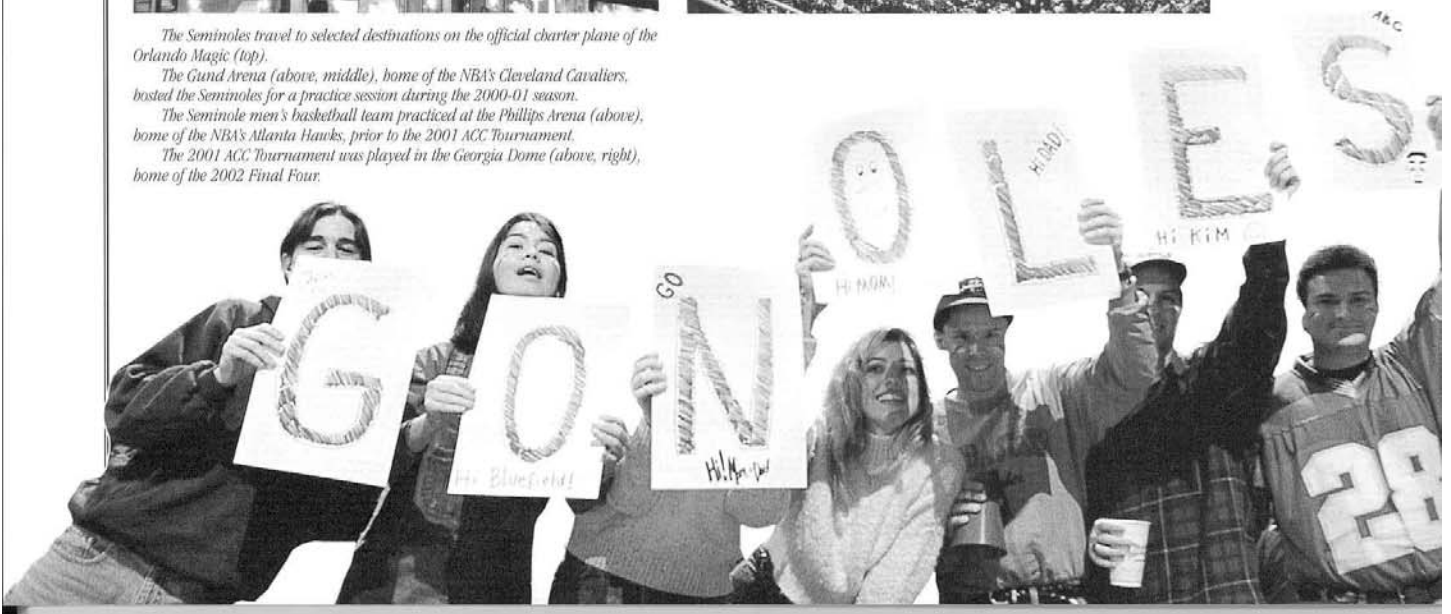


The Seminoles travel to selected destinations on the official charter plane of the Orlando Magic (top).

ACC basketball is special and the ACC Tournament only adds to the athletic luster of the nine conference institutions. The tournament's pageantry, quality, tradition, players and coaches make it the most special of all the conference tournaments.

The 2001 ACC Tournament at the Georgia Dome in Atlanta, Ga., was the most attended college conference basketball tournament in NCAA history.

The tournament set NCAA attendance records for total attendance (182,525), per session average (36,505) and single session attendance (40,083).

The ACC Tournament was held at NC State's Reynolds Coliseum for its first 13 years (1954-66). Since then, it has been held at the original Charlotte Coliseum, the Capital Centre in Landover, Md., the Omni in Atlanta, Ga., the current Charlotte Coliseum, the Greensboro Coliseum and the Georgia Dome.

The inaugural tournament in 1954 attracted 39,200 fans to the seven games at Reynolds Coliseum. The last year there was a "public" sale of ACC Tournament tickets was 1966. Over the past two decades all of the tournaments have been sold out in advance as the tickets are equally distributed among the nine member institutions.
