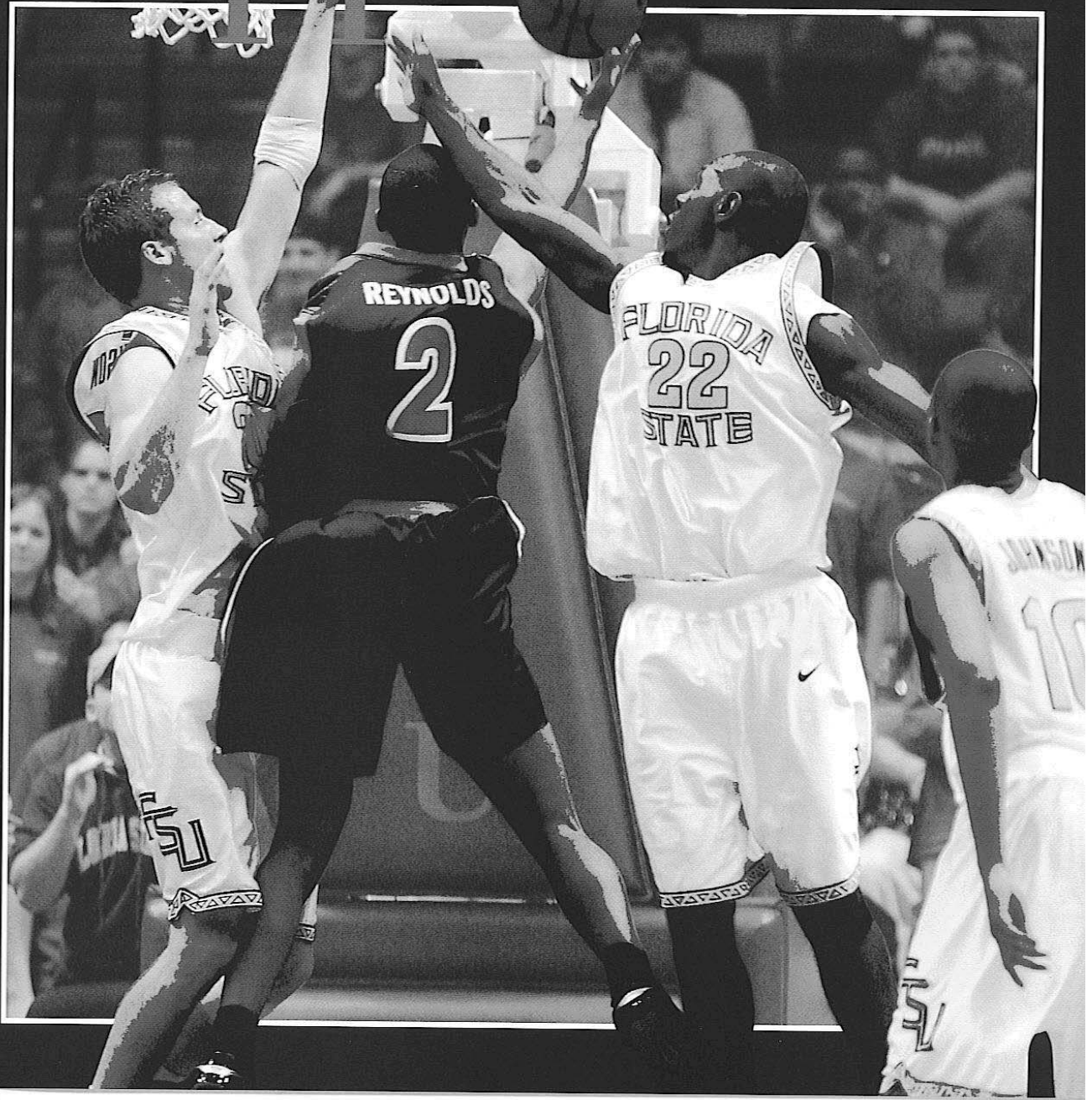

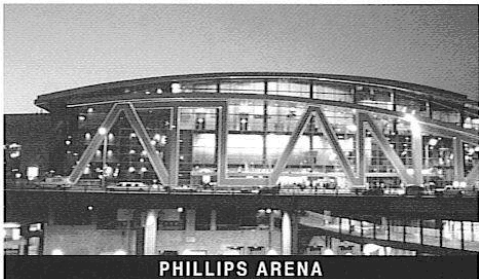

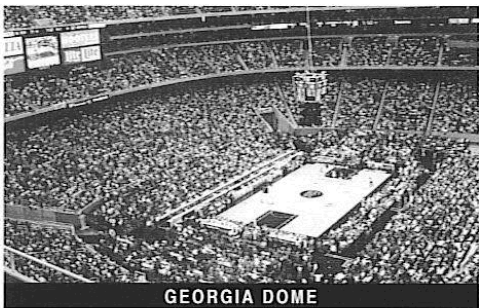
GUND ARENA

The Atlantic Coast Conference Tournament is a gathering of the finest college basketball players playing for the best college basketball teams in the greatest college basketball conference in the nation. The ACC tournament is viewed as "The Grandfather of All Tournaments" for its ability to sustain its competitiveness, success, passion, enthusiasm and commitment to excellence since the tournament's beginning in 1954.

ACC basketball is one of a kind and the ACC tournament only adds to the athletic luster of the eleven conference institutions. The tournament's pageantry, quality, tradition, players and coaches make it the finest of all conference tournaments.

The 2001 ACC Tournament held at the Georgia Dome in Atlanta, Ga., was the most attended college conference basketball tournament in NCAA history. The tournament set NCAA attendance records for total attendance (182,525), per session average (36,505) and single session attendance (40,083).

The ACC Tournament was held at NC State's Reynolds Coliseum for its first 13 years of existence from 1954-66. Since then, the tournament has been held at various sites including the original Charlotte Coliseum, the Capital Centre in Landover, Md., the Omni in Atlanta, Ga., the current Charlotte Coliseum, the Greensboro Coliseum and the Georgia Dome.

The inaugural ACC tournament in 1954 attracted 39,200 fans to the seven games at Reynolds Coliseum.

The year 1966 marked the last time that there was a "public" sale of tournament tickets. In the past two decades all of the tournaments have been sold out in advance as the tickets are equally distributed to the eleven member institutions.

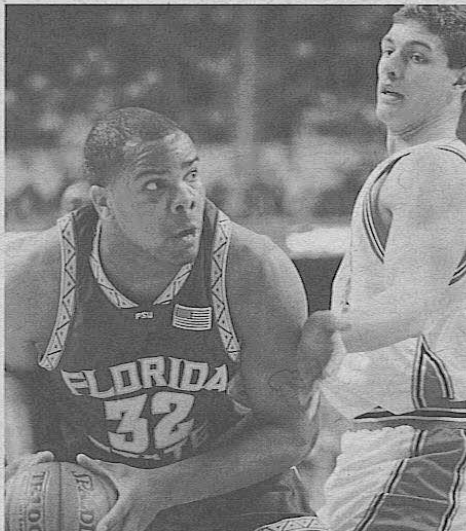
