Junior All-ACC candidate Alexander Johnson and his Florida State teammates will play seven games against NCAA Tournament teams and seven more against NIT participants on its 2005-06 schedule. The Seminoles will play 15 home games in the Donald L. Tucker Center with contests scheduled against North Carolina, Georgia Tech and Duke – all ACC opponents who played in the NCAA Tournament in 2005. The Seminoles are 35-15 (.700 winning percentage) at home in the first three years of the Leonard Hamilton era.

The ACC Tournament:

A ONE-OF-A-KIND EVENT BY THE MEMBERS OF A ONE-OF-A-KIND CONFERENCE.

In the 52 years that the Atlantic Coast Conference has crowned its champion, thus its recipient of the league's only official bid to the NCAA Tournament, the ACC Tournament has become the greatest of them all when it comes to college basketball tournaments.

The ACC Tournament has come to be viewed as "The Grandfather of All Tournaments" for its ability to sustain its competitiveness, success, passion, enthusiasm and commitment since the tournament's beginning in 1954. Basketball in the ACC is unmatched and the ACC Tournament only adds to the athletic luster of the 12 conference institutions. The tournament's pageantry, quality tradition, players and coaches make it the finest of all conference tournaments.

From 1954 through 1974, only the ACC Tournament champion advanced as the league's representative in the NCAA Tournament. During those years as college basketball was shaping itself, the ACC was the only league to host a postseason tournament and the only league

where the regular season results only meant where a team would be seeded in the chase for the most coveted conference championship in college athletics.

Since 1975, the ACC regular season champion has been guaranteed a bid to the NCAA Tournament regardless of how the conference tournament turned out. Since 1980, there has been no limit on the number of teams a conference can send, and the ACC has never sent fewer than three teams. Now, every conference except the Ivy League stages a postseason tournament.

The ACC Tournament was held at NC State's Reynolds Coliseum for its first 13 years of existence from 1954-66. Since then, the tournament has been held at various sites including the original Charlotte Coliseum, the Capital Centre in Landover, Md., the Omni and the Georgia Dome in Atlanta, Ga., the current Charlotte Coliseum, the Greensboro Coliseum and the MCI Center in Washington, D.C. The tournament will be played at the St. Petersburg Times Forum in Tampa, Fla., in 2007.

The inaugural ACC Tournament in 1954 attracted 39,200 fans to the seven games at Reynolds Coliseum. The 2001 ACC Tournament at Atlanta's Georgia Dome was the most attended conference basketball tournament in NCAA history as established records for total attendance (182,525), per session average (36,505) and single game attendance (40,083).

The demand for those who go to the event has grown to where the last "public" sale of tickets was in 1966. In the past four decades all of the tournaments have been sold out in advance as the tickets will soon be distributed equally to the 12 member institutions.
