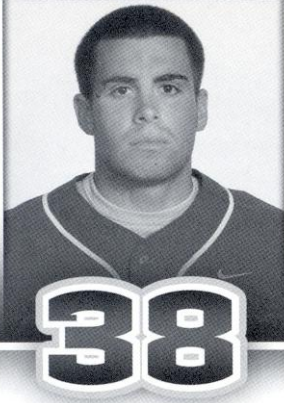

2010: Third team preseason All-American by Collegiate Baseball.

2009: Baseball America first team All-American at shortstop...became just the second shortstop in school history to earn first team All-America accolades joining Dick Howser (1957 & 1958)...named a semifinalist for the Brooks Wallace Award presented to the nation's top shortstop...earned second team All-ACC accolades... named to the NCAA Tallahassee All-Region Team... honored as the ACC Player of the Week on March 30...finished the season hitting .376 in 62 games with 20 doubles, 10 home runs and 51 RBI in his first year as an everyday starter...ranked second on the team in hits (89), runs (76) and stolen bases (20), while tying for the team lead in triples with three...surpassed his career totals in every major offensive category...finished the year ranked in eight offensive categories in the ACC including runs scored (t-2nd), walks (t-4th), stolen bases (t-5th), on-base percentage (6th), hits (7th), batting average (7th), doubles (t-7th) and total bases (t-9th)... ranked nationally in runs per game, runs, hits and walks...had a record setting performance against Ohio State in the NCAA Tallahassee Regional championship final going 7-for-9 with five RBI, five runs, three doubles and a triple...set the NCAA Tournament single-game record for hits and at-bats...tied the school record for hits and at-bats in a game...established a career-high with five runs scored...finished the series with a .600 average and 12 hits, recording multiple hits in all three games, 10 RBI, four doubles and 18 total bases...made 62 starts on the year - 47 at shortstop,



12 at first base and three more at second...led the team with 28 multi-hit games...put together a team best 17-game hitting streak during the season...went 11 straight games without committing an error at shortstop, a span covering 36 total chances...finished the Maryland series batting .571 (8-for-14)...recorded three home runs, drove in eight and scored seven times...went 3-for-5 in the series finale against the Terps with two home runs

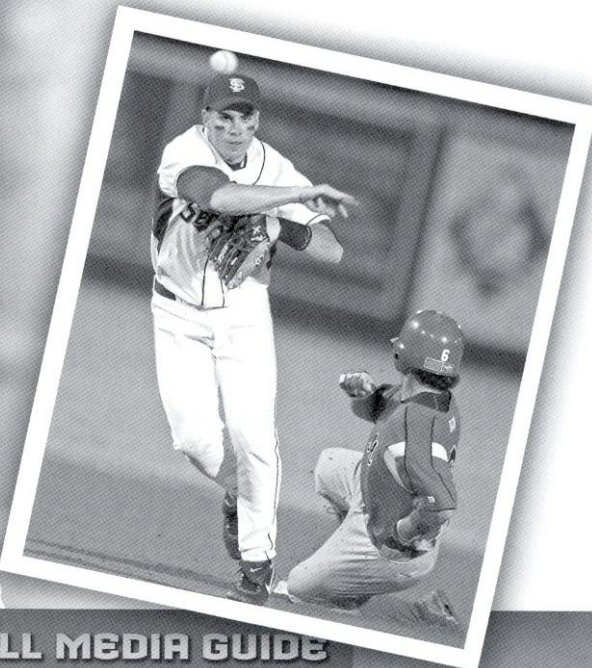
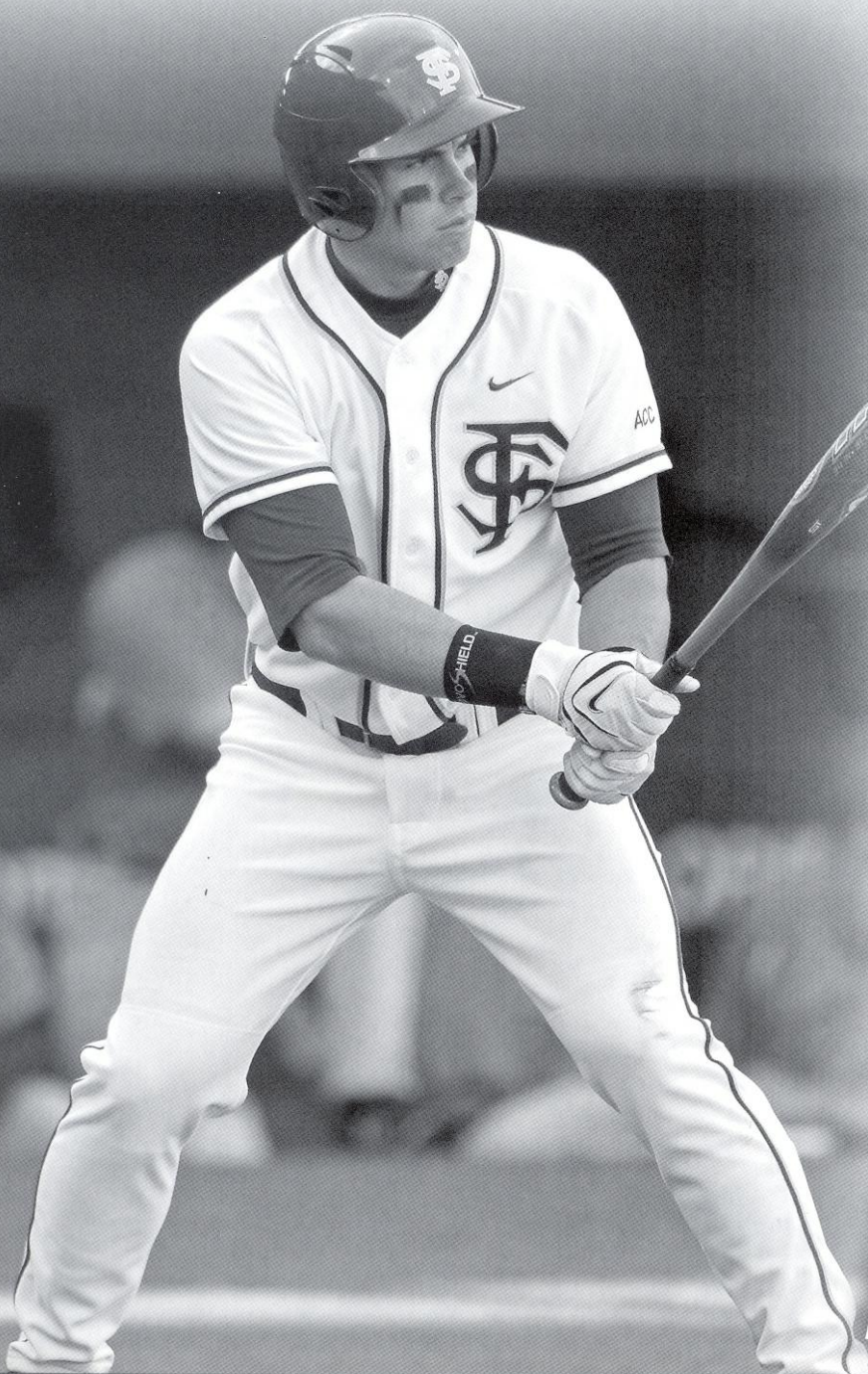
to a .613 slugging percentage...finished the year with 17 runs and 17 RBI...was equally impressive during league play batting .400 with 12 hits in 30 at-bats...belted three doubles and two home runs (Miami and NC State), while scoring seven times and driving in six...was a perfect 2-for-2 in stolen bases against conference foes...made his first start of the season in game three against Miami collecting two hits, two runs scored and an RBI...was the starting third baseman for all three games at North Carolina...led all Seminoles in average (.444), on-base percentage (.538) and hits (4) during the three-game set against the Tar Heels...recorded a career-high three hits in game two versus Savannah State...finished the series hitting .667 with two multi-hit games...batted .500 (2-for-4) at the ACC Tournament in Jacksonville...biggest hit of the tournament was a one out, ninth inning single to ignite the Seminoles' ninth-inning rally over UNC...

earned playing time in four of the five games of the Tallahassee Regional...recorded a hit and two RBI in an elimination victory over Bucknell...played in all three games of the Super Regional series victory over Wichita State...tied for third on the team with four pinch hits...posted a .448 average with runners in scoring position, the third highest on the team...hit .432 against right handed hitters.
