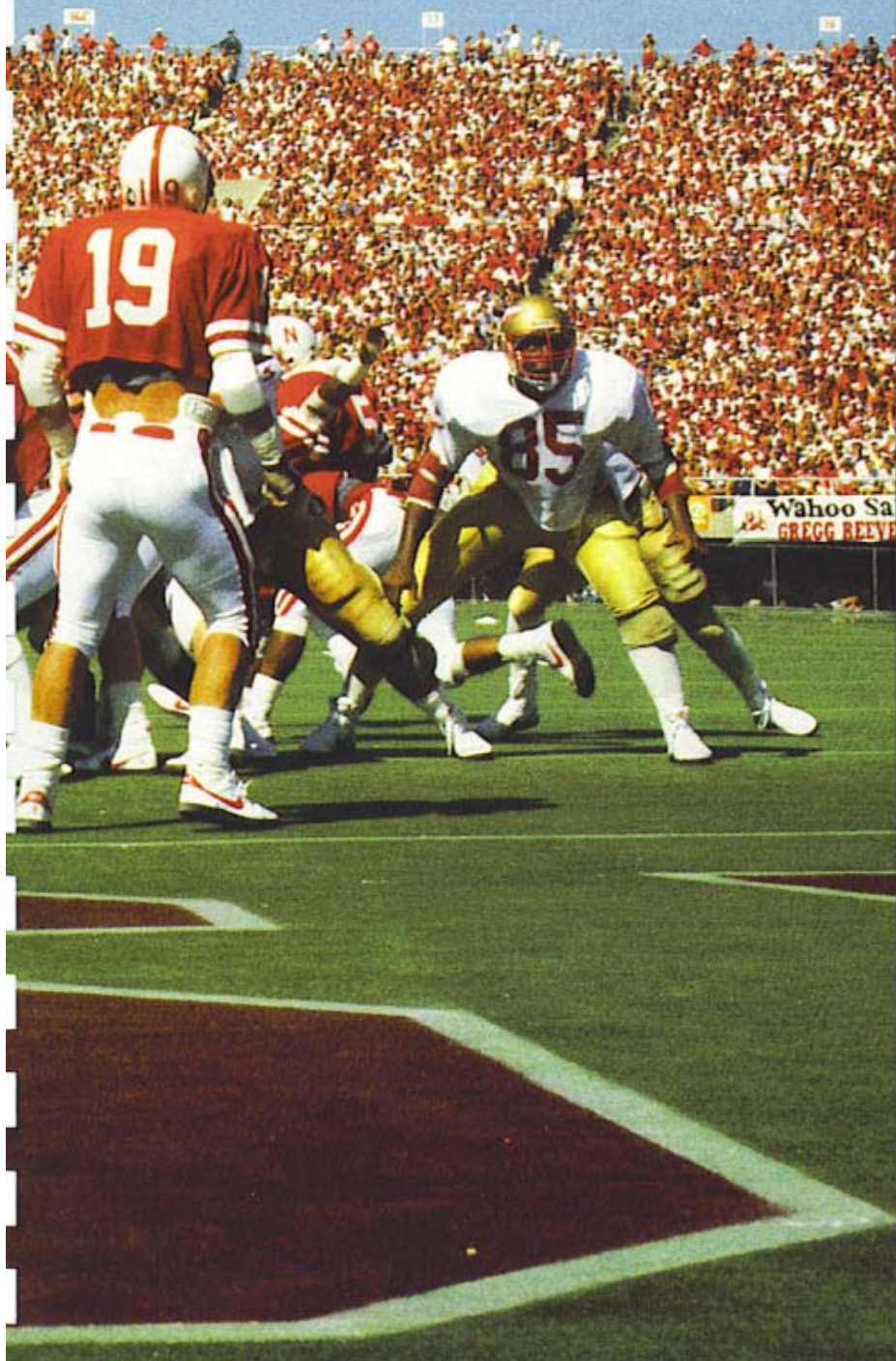

IN FSU HISTORY**

Fenner's Catch

1966

Lane Fenner ran out onto the field in the final minute of the 1966 FSU-Florida game in Tallahassee. Although the Seminoles were in their third game of the season, for Fenner it was his first play. The scoreboard clock showed 26 seconds to play with Florida out front 22-19. The ball was resting on the Gator 45, second-and-10.

Fenner brought in from the bench a play given him by assistant coach Don Breaux. He was in the game for the sensational Ron Sellers, who had been shaken up on the previous play. At the snap, split end Billy Cox moved downfield to clear out the middle. Fenner, the primary receiver on the play, delayed one count before

heading deep on a post pattern.

Gator defenders Larry Rentz and Bobby Downs suddenly found themselves chasing Fenner—Downs from behind, Rentz with an angle. Field judge Doug Mosley, later a principal in this fateful play, moved 12 yards or so down the sideline.

FSU quarterback Gary Pajcic, running to his right, heaved the ball some 55 yards just over the outstretched arms of Downs and Rentz. It landed gently on Fenner's left shoulder, his body open step into the endzone and clearly inside the red flag.

As Fenner, Rentz and Downs tumbled to the ground in a heap, a huge roar went up from the Florida State partisans in the west stands. But field judge Mosley, now sprinting across the 10-yard-line, ran immediately to the spot where the three had rolled off the playing field. He emphatically placed his right foot on the sideline and waved his arms across his face. No touchdown.

News photos, running in papers nationwide, seemed to show otherwise. The controversy still rages some 20 years later.

the Seminoles and Green Wave will be meeting for the fourth consecutive year ... Tulane is also on the schedule for the next three years ... Florida State holds a 3-0 advantage in the series, including a 38-7 win last season ... actually, Tulane won the first game of the series, 34-28, but a letter dated Feb. 3, 1986 advised FSU athletic director Hootie Ingram that the 1983 game would be forfeited to the Seminoles ... that action was taken in compliance with the NCAA's ruling on the ineligible participation by Jon English in that game ... second-year head coach Mack Brown is a 1974 FSU grad ... he played on the '71 and '72 teams before coaching the freshman team in 1973 along with FSU assistant athletic director Larry Pendleton and Tulane defensive coordinator Bill Shaw ... 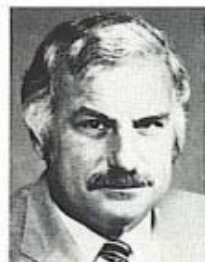
