MIKE LOSCO TROPHY ROOM

College football has dominated conference play like Florida State during the ACC in 1992. During that 13-year span, FSU has won conference titles. In addition, Florida State players have won a number of individual awards.



DON FAULS ATHLETIC TRAINING ROOM

Fauls Athletic Training Room, named after FSU's longtime trainer, opened during the fall of 2003 and stretches more than 15,000 square feet. Some of the most impressive amenities are the three in-ground pools — a workout pool and a pair of 9 x 12 whirlpools (one cold, one warm).



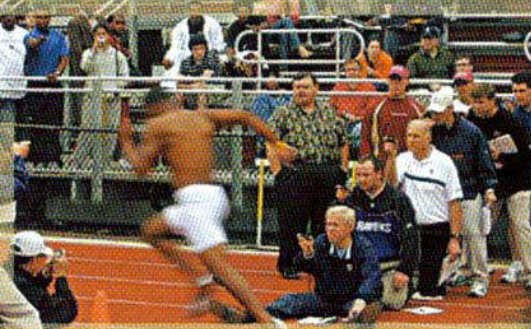
ROGER HOLLER CHAMPIONS TRAINING COMPLEX

Completed prior to the 2003 season, the new weight room in the Moore Athletic Center is regarded as one of the top workout facilities in the country. The weight room, conveniently located down the hall from the locker room and training room, covers more than 15,000 square feet.



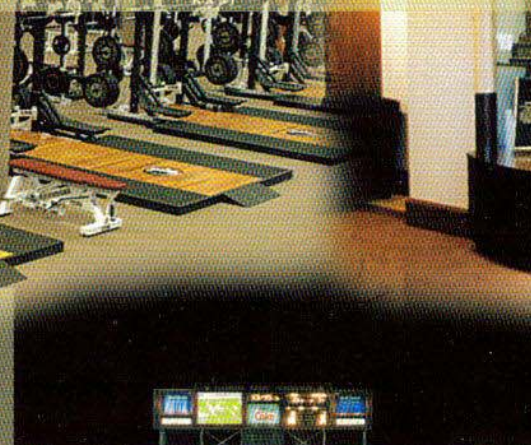
MOORE ATHLETIC CENTER

The Moore Athletic Center, completed in 2004, is the four-story home for Florida State's Department of Athletics. The state-of-the-art building includes the football locker room, weight room, training room, and cafeteria, as well as academic support, student services and compliance. A bronze statue of head coach Bobby Bowden was dedicated prior to the Clemson game last season and now stands in front of the main entrance.



NFL PRO DAY

Over 100 NFL scouts and coaches were on hand for Florida State's pro day this spring. The 40-yard dash (seen here with Craphonso Thorpe) is held at Mike Long Track while other testing is held in the weight room and turf room, as well as on the practice fields. Mike Long Track was also the site of the 2005 ACC Track & Field Championships. FSU had the second-highest number of players drafted in 2005, including first-round picks Travis Johnson and Alex Barron.



THE MANNY GARCIA LOCKER ROOM

The Florida State football locker room, named for longtime FSU supporter Manny Garcia, was renovated at a cost of \$2 million and was doubled in size to 18,000 square feet. New wooden lockers, a player lounge and an expanded equipment area are among the new features.

THE JIM AND LINDA OWENS MULTIPURPOSE ROOM

The turf room is located above the weight room on the second floor of the Moore Athletic Center and covers 6,500 square feet. The room is used for specific workouts designed by the strength and conditioning staff and is also used as a practice area when weather forces the football team indoors.

HEISMAN TROPHY WINNERS

As you enter the Florida State football suite, a glass display honors FSU's two Heisman Trophy winners — Charlie Ward (1993) and Chris Weinke (2000). The display includes the two Heisman Trophies, game jerseys, action photos and plaques detailing Ward's and Weinke's accomplishments.

BOBBY BOWDEN FIELD AT DOAK S. CAMPBELL STADIUM

With recent additions to the north endzone, Bobby Bowden Field at Doak S. Campbell Stadium's capacity has reached 82,300. The stadium, which includes offices and classrooms around the exterior, is considered to be the largest brick structure in the southeast.
