- Florida State extended its home winning streak to 15 straight games.
- Sophomore tailback Dalvin Cook rushed for 156 yards and two touchdowns on 19 carries, making him the first Seminole to rush for 100 yards in four consecutive games since Greg Jones accomplished the feat in five consecutive games from 2001-2002.
- Redshirt senior transfer Everett Golson eclipsed the 300-yard passing mark in his first game as a Seminole and seventh time in his career, finishing with 302 yards while tossing four touchdowns to four different receivers. Golson finished 19-for-25 with a passing efficiency rating of 230.3, good for fourth nationally and tops in the ACC during the opening weekend.
- Sophomore wide receiver Ja'Vonn Harrison caught his first career touchdown pass with 11:05 left in the fourth quarter, a 55 yard strike from Everett Golson.
- Junior All-American cornerback Jalen Ramsey took his first career kickoff return for 37 yards, while wearing Charlie Ward's retired number 17. Ramsey also had four tackles and a pass breakup.
- A pair of young defenders stood out in their first career starts in the secondary, Trey Marshall at "star" nickelback and Marquez White at cornerback. Marshall finished with four tackles and a sack while White finished with three tackles and a tackle for loss.

- Florida State extended its home winning streak to 16 straight games.
- Sophomore tailback Dalvin Cook rushed for 266 yards and a career-best three touchdowns on 30 carries. It marked the second-most rushing yards by a Seminole, only eclipsed by Greg Allen's school-record 322 rushing yards in 1981 vs. Western Carolina. Cook became the fifth Seminole ever to rush for 200+ yards in a game.
- All-American placekicker Roberto Aguayo made his 161st consecutive PAT, setting a new ACC record. He also tacked on two field goals, moving him to 51-of-55 for his career. He is now the most accurate kicker in NCAA history for the highest percentage of extra points and field goals made (minimum 100 PAT's and 50 field goals made), surpassing Alex Henery of Nebraska, who was .967 through 2007-10.
- The Florida State defense forced 10 USF punts, which was the most by an opponent since Maryland punted 11 times on Oct. 5, 2013 - 26 games ago.
- Redshirt senior transfer Everett Golson finished with 163 yards passing and 1 TD, including 13-of-17 passing in the second half.
- Sophomore linebacker Jacob Pugh and redshirt sophomore linebacker Ro'Derrick Hoskins shared a team-leading seven tackles, which was a career-high for both players.

- Florida State extended its win streak against ACC opponents to 25 consecutive games. Jimbo Fisher's record improved to 61-11 (.857) and a 20-5 mark (.800) in road games after stringing together 13 straight.
- The shutout victory marked the first time FSU shut out an opponent on the road since beating Notre Dame 37-0 on Nov. 1, 2003. It's the first since FSU defeated Maryland 63-0 at home in Oct of 2013. It's the sixth of the Jimbo Fisher era and first of defensive coordinator Charles Kelly's career.
- FSU played its third consecutive game without committing an offensive turnover.
- Junior cornerback Jalen Ramsey's fumble return for a TD in the second half, aided by senior linebacker Terrance Smith's caused fumble, changed the complexion of the game. The last time FSU scored a defensive TD was against Florida in 2014 on a 94-yard interception return by Smith. It was Ramsey's second career TD.
- Senior punter Cason Beatty booted five punts out of seven over 50 yards, kicking his season-best of 58 yards in the third quarter.
- Junior wide receiver Kermit Whitfield set a career high with four catches, while freshman defensive end Josh Sweat, redshirt sophomore linebacker Ro'Derrick Hoskins and redshirt freshman tight end Mavin Saunders made their first career starts.

- Dalvin Cook's first quarter 94-yard touchdown run was the longest run in BB&T Field history. It was also the third-longest rushing touchdown in the history of FSU football and the third run of 50+ yards for Cook this season.
- Junior wide receiver Kermit Whitfield had a 5-yard touchdown catch in the third quarter – his first career touchdown reception and fifth touchdown overall. Whitfield finished the day with 135 total yards (24 yards receiving & 111 yards on kickoff returns).
- Senior linebacker Reggie Northrup stepped in and contributed 10 tackles and four QB hurries while sophomore Trey Marshall led the team with 11 tackles.
- Sophomore running back Johnathan Vickers scored his first career touchdown in the second quarter on a 9-yard run to cap a 13-play, 76-yard drive that covered six minutes and 49 seconds.
- Redshirt junior center Ryan Hoefeld made his first start of the season at center, while redshirt freshman right tackle Derrick Kelly made his first career start. Redshirt junior OL Chad Mavety also made his debut.
- With Wake Forest driving near the end of the game looking for the tie, redshirt senior Tyler Hunter picked off a pass in the endzone, sealing the win. It was his sixth career interception.
- The Seminoles played their fourth-straight game without committing an offensive turnover.

- Sophomore tailback Dalvin Cook rushed for 222 yards on 22 carries, establishing a new series high against Miami by a Seminole running back. The previous high against the Hurricanes was Greg Jones' 189 yards in 2002.
- Cook eclipsed the 200-yard rushing mark for the second time this season with his 23-yard touchdown run with 6:44 remaining to give the Noles a 29-24 lead.
- Redshirt senior quarterback Everett Golson completed 25 of 33 attempts for 291 yards and one touchdown.
- FSU trailed for the first time this season (23-24) with 10:02 remaining in the game after Michael Badgley's PAT followed Brad Kaaya's 29-yard touchdown pass to Stacy Coley.
- The Seminoles went their fifth-straight game without committing an offensive turnover.
- FSU rolled up 358 total yards in the first half, which is the highest first half output of the season and the most before intermission since rolling up 374 yards vs. Syracuse on Nov. 16, 2013.
- Redshirt junior kicker Roberto Aguayo maintained his mark of never missing a FG inside the 40-yard line following conversions of 22, 32 and 25 yards.
- The Seminoles had five pass breakups on the night, including four by defensive linemen. Giorgio Newberry led the way with two, including the game-clincher on fourth down of Miami's final possession. Josh Sweat and DeMarcus Walker were credited with one each.

- After trailing 14-13 in the third quarter, the Seminoles scored 21 unanswered points in the second half that would lead to a 41-21 victory.
- Sophomore tailback Dalvin Cook rushed for 163 yards on 22 carries, pushing his season total to 955 rushing yards through six games. That's an ACC record for rushing yards through the first six games of the season, eclipsing the record previously held by Virginia's Thomas Jones (888 yards, 1999) according to STATS LLC.
- The Seminoles were turnover free for the fifth straight game.
- Quarterback Everett Golson completed 26 of 38 attempts for 372 yards and three touchdowns – the completions, attempts and yardage all FSU career-highs for Golson, including a 70-yard TD pass to Kermit Whitfield - his longest in the Garnet & Gold and second best of his career.
- One-time walk-on safety Javien Elliott collected his first career interception, picking off Louisville's Lamar Jackson with 3:32 remaining in the third quarter. The senior was awarded a scholarship in the preseason by Jimbo Fisher.
- FSU's pass rush produced a season-high five sacks as sophomore linebacker Jacob Pugh tallied a career-best 2.0 sacks while leading the defense with seven tackles. Redshirt senior DB Lamaricus Brutus and freshman DB Derwin James each had six tackles.

- Sophomore tailback Dalvin Cook passed the 1,000 rushing mark for the 2015 season joining Warrick Dunn (who was in attendance) as the only two players in FSU history with multiple 1,000 yard rushing seasons. Dunn did it in 1994, 1995 and 1996. He also became the fastest Seminole to reach 2,000 career yards rushing.
- FSU committed its first offensive turnover in the loss to the Jackets. It happened in the fourth quarter with 8:07 remaining as redshirt senior quarterback Everett Golson fired a pass to Travis Rudolph that was juggled before being picked off in the endzone. The interception ended a streak of five consecutive games without a turnover, tying an NCAA record (STATS, LLC).
- Freshman defensive end Josh Sweat recorded his first tipped-pass that led to an interception before registering his first career sack on a big third down to force a punt.
- Redshirt senior defensive back Lamarcus Brutus recorded FSU's second interception in the game during the second quarter. It was the first multiple-interception game of the season and first since Nov. 29, 2014 when the Seminoles snagged four vs. Florida.
- Redshirt junior kicker Roberto Aguayo kicked three field goals - it was the ninth time in his career he had converted three kicks into points and second time this season.
- The loss to the Jackets snapped FSU's 28-game win streak over league opponents - the second longest streak in ACC history and one win shy of FSU's league record 29-game win streak (1992-95).

- Redshirt junior quarterback Sean Maguire stepped in and established career-highs in completions, yards and touchdowns, going 23-for-35 for 348 yards with three touchdown passes.
- Jacques Patrick became the third different true freshman running back to start in the backfield in the Jimbo Fisher era. He rushed 24 times for 162 yards with three touchdowns.
- Sophomore wide receiver Travis Rudolph caught five passes for 191 yards, reaching the end zone on three occasions against Syracuse. He eclipsed 100 yards receiving (191 yards) for the first time in his Seminole career. With his third quarter receiving touchdown, Rudolph became the first player since Kelvin Benjamin at Florida in 2013 to have three touchdown receptions in a game.
- Freshman safety Derwin James forced a fumble and shared the game-high in tackles with a career-high 12 (Reggie Northrup).
- Freshman Josh Sweat recovered the fumble forced by James. It was his third recovery of the season which tied him with Texas Tech's Ja'Shawn Johnson for the most by a player from a Power 5 conference at that point of the season.
- Three Seminoles - center Alec Eberle, tailback Jacques Patrick and defensive back Javien Elliott made their first career starts against the Orange.

- Sophomore tailback Dalvin Cook put up 194 rushing yards - including 157 in the first half and 128 in the first quarter, following an opening 75-yard touchdown run on his first touch. At the time, it marked the most rushing yards Clemson allowed all season.
- In the first quarter, junior Jalen Ramsey had three solo tackles and four total tackles and a sack. He had a key fourth down stop and a crucial pass break up in the second quarter. Ramsey had seven tackles in the first half, including five solo. Ramsey finished with a new season-high of nine tackles.
- The Seminole defense held Clemson to its lowest first half point total of the year and was the first team in 2015 to hold Clemson out of the endzone for the entire first half.
- Redshirt junior quarterback Sean Maguire made his first career road start at Death Valley. The Sparta, N.J., native became the first quarterback to start against Clemson in back-to-back seasons since Christian Ponder (2008, 2009).
- Senior linebacker Reggie Northrup registered double-digit tackles for the fifth time this season. He finished with a game-high 14 tackles.
- Redshirt senior linebacker Terrance Smith returned to the lineup after missing four games with an ankle injury and amassed 12 tackles.
- Demarcus Christmas made his first career start at defensive tackle against Clemson. He finished the game with four tackles.

- Trailing 17-7 at the 7:32 mark in the second quarter, redshirt junior quarterback Sean Maguire replaced redshirt senior quarterback Everett Golson and helped the Seminoles rally to score 27 unanswered points. He completed 18-of-28 passes for 231 yards and two touchdowns.
- Sophomore tailback Dalvin Cook broke Warrick Dunn's single-season rushing mark (1,242 yards), set in 1995, on the sixth offensive play of the game for the Noles with an 11-yard scamper in the first quarter. Cook surpassed the 100-yard mark for the 11th time in his career - and the sixth time this season. Cook, who finished with 138 yards on 22 carries, recorded at least 20 carries for the eighth time in his Florida State career.
- Junior defensive end DeMarcus Walker turned in a monster performance against the Wolfpack, matching his career-high in sacks with two, while chipping in a third down pass breakup. Walker finished with four tackles, including two tackles for loss.
- Jesus 'Bobo' Wilson established a new single-game career-high in receptions with seven, breaking his previous career-high of six which came against NC State (6 rec., 109 yards; 2014) and Syracuse (6 rec., 69 yards; 2015). Wilson's 78 receiving yards mark the second most of his Seminole career behind a 109-yard outing, also against the Wolfpack, on Sept. 27, 2014.
- Kermit Whitfield recorded his second 100-yard receiving game of the season after hauling in 117 yards on six catches and two touchdowns.

- Make it 10 wins, a new school record for victories in a four-year span and – most importantly – another triumph over the Florida Gators. A stadium-record crowd of 90,916 watched as FSU earned its first three-game winning streak in Gainesville and held UF to its fewest points in the series' 60-game history.
- Sophomore tailback Dalvin Cook picked up the pace in the second half, wearing out the highly touted UF defense, accounting for 183 yards, 150 in the fourth quarter, on 26 carries with two TDs.
- Redshirt junior placekicker Roberto Aguayo kicked two long field goals, first converting from 45 yards before knicking the left upright to secure a season-long 51-yard attempt.
- On fourth-and-goal at the 1-yard line, redshirt junior quarterback Sean Maguire threaded a pass off a bootleg to sophomore tight end Jeremy Kerr. It was Kerr's first career catch and first career TD, lifting the Seminoles to a 10-0 lead with 7:47 left in the first half.
- The FSU defense recorded four sacks on the night as junior defensive end DeMarcus Walker accounted for 2.5 along with blocking a field goal. He also contributed 3.5 tackles for loss for 23 yards.
- The only points the Seminoles allowed came on a safety in the fourth quarter.
- Senior linebacker Terrance Smith, junior defensive tackle DeMarcus Walker, freshman safety Derwin James and senior linebacker Reggie Northrup all recorded nine tackles in the win.

- After exiting the game in the first quarter with an injury, redshirt junior quarterback Sean Maguire came back in the game at the 9:29 mark in the second quarter to finish the day 22-of-44 for 392 yards and two touchdowns. He would be responsible for eight plays of 20+ yards.
- In Maguire's relief, redshirt freshman J.J. Cosentino entered his third career game.
- The Seminoles were known for taking care of the football all season, however Houston forced Florida State into a season-high five turnovers in the game.
- Sophomore wide receiver Travis Rudolph had his first career 200+ yard day, accounting for seven catches for 201 yards and a touchdown that came with 11:12 left in the game. It was a 65-yard pass from Maguire. It was the third-longest touchdown pass in FSU bowl history.
- Freshman safety Derwin James led the team with tackles for the fifth time in 2015, registering his fifth 10+ tackle game with a career-high 14 including nine solo, one sack, one PBU and two TFL.
- Junior defensive end DeMarcus Walker recorded his first career interception.
- Cason Beatty averaged 51.5 yards on six punts recording a long of 55 yards three times. He finished the bowl game with five punts of 50 yards or more to tie a season-high.
- Roberto Aguayo connected on all three extra points against the Cougars finishing his career a perfect 198-for-198 on PATs.
