- Junior receiver Auden Tate had two receptions for 41 yards, including a three-yard touchdown pass from redshirt sophomore Deondre Francois in the second quarter.
- Francois was 19-of-33 for 210 yards and a touchdown. He completed passes to seven different receivers, including seven to sophomore Keith Gavin for 50 yards. Gavin did not record a catch as a freshman and made his first start against the Crimson Tide.
- The defense, led by redshirt senior linebacker Matthew Thomas and redshirt sophomore safety Derwin James, held Alabama to 96 passing yards and 173 rushing yards. It was just the second time under Nick Saban that Alabama has passed for fewer than 100 yards and rushed for fewer than 200 in the same game (Tulane, 2008).
- Matthew Thomas led the team with 10 tackles. Over his past three games (Florida & Michigan in 2016), Thomas has 32 tackles and has led the team in tackles each game.
- Junior Josh Sweat led the team with one sack as the Noles took down Jalen Hurts twice.
- Freshman running back Cam Akers was one of six true freshmen to play for the Seminoles. Akers had 30 rushing yards and an 11-yard reception. Two redshirt freshmen - Josh Ball and Janarius Robinson - also made the first appearances of their career.
- Three sophomores - Gavin, defensive end Brian Burns and defensive back Levonta Taylor - made the first starts of their careers.
- Francois continued to climb FSU's all-time lists. Francois ranks 16th in FSU history with 3,560 passing yards, 17th with 254 completions and 21st with 21 touchdown passes. Francois left the game in the fourth quarter with a leg injury.
- Defenders Tarvarus McFadden (5), Fredrick Jones (5) and Ro'Derrick Hoskins (9) all set career highs for tackles.
- George Campbell's 21-yard catch in the first quarter was his first since the 2015 opener.

- James Blackman became the first true freshman quarterback to start since Chip Ferguson against Miami in 1985.
- Junior receiver Auden Tate had a career-high 51-yard reception on FSU's first possession of the second half. Tate also recorded his single-game career-highs for receptions (9) and yards (138).
- Freshman running back Cam Akers led the Seminoles in rushing with 56 yards on 12 carries (4.7 ypc).
- Redshirt sophomore receiver George Campbell's 60-yard reception late in the third quarter was a career long. Campbell also registered career highs with three receptions for 85 yards.
- Redshirt senior linebacker Ro'Derrick Hoskins led the Seminoles with nine tackles, tying his career high from the season opener against No. 1 Alabama.
- Senior Derrick Nnadi and sophomore Brian Burns shared the team lead with 2.5 tackles for loss each. Burns also blocked A.J. Cole's punt with 3:31 to play in the game, his second career blocked punt.
- Sophomore kicker Ricky Aguayo converted field goals of 37, 36, 37 and 34 yards. It was his sixth career game with multiple field goals and the most in a single game since setting an FSU record with six against Ole Miss last year.
- The Seminoles converted on 5 of 6 red zone trips.

- Kyle Meyers had FSU's first turnover of the season in the second quarter. It was his first career interception. Meyers also forced a Wake Forest fumble in the third quarter that was recovered by Jalen Wilkerson.
- Auden Tate had one catch for seven yards entering the final minute of the fourth quarter but his 40-yard reception for the game-winning touchdown extended his streak to three straight games with a TD catch.
- Freshman QB James Blackman engineered the first game-winning touchdown drive of his FSU career with just 53 seconds remaining, ending with his second career touchdown pass to Tate.
- Jacques Patrick's 69-yard run from the FSU 1-yard line was the longest of his career and FSU's longest of the season. It highlighted a 120-yard game for Patrick.
- True freshman Cam Akers added 58 yards. His 27-yard run on FSU's first drive of the third quarter was a career long.
- Kicker Ricky Aguayo added four field goals in the game. His first, from 51 yards, was the longest of his career. It was his second straight game with four made field goals.
- Aguayo has made eight straight field goals over the last two weeks, the most for an FSU kicker since his brother Roberto made 23 straight in 2013-14.
- Keith Gavin's 81-yard kickoff return was FSU's longest since Kermit Whitfield's 100-yard return against Auburn in the 2013 BCS National Championship Game.
- Matthew Thomas had two 13-yard sacks on Wake Forest quarterback John Wolford. It was Thomas's third and fourth career sacks and his first two-sack game. He finished the game with team-high 10 tackles.

- True freshman QB James Blackman was brilliant in the fourth quarter, completing 9-of-10 attempts for 142 yards and two touchdowns. The Belle Glade, Fla., native finished 17-of-28 passing for 203 yards and his first career multi-touchdown game.
- Auden Tate's go-ahead 20-yard touchdown reception from Blackman with 1:24 remaining marked the fourth consecutive game he has caught a touchdown. The last Seminole to have a touchdown catch in the first four games of a season was Rashad Greene in 2013.
- Tight end Ryan Izzo's 15-yard touchdown reception with 12:17 remaining was the fourth scoring grab of the redshirt junior's career and first since the 2016 opener against Ole Miss. Izzo led the Noles with four catches, equaling his single-game high.
- Freshman tailback Cam Akers' career-long 46-yard run with 14:18 remaining in the game pushed him over 100 yards rushing for the first time in his career. Akers finished with 121 rushing yards on 20 carries. It was the third consecutive game the Noles have had a 100-yard rusher against Miami (Dalvin Cook, 2015 & 2016).
- Freshman cornerback Stanford Samuels III collected his first career interception in the end zone with 8:38 remaining in the third quarter.
- Logan Tyler tied a career long with a 57-yard punt and had four in excess of 50 yards in the game.
- The Seminoles out-gained Miami in total offense (406-337), rushing yards (203-83), time of possession (34:59-25:01), yards per play (5.7-4.6) and first downs (22-20).
- The Florida State defense came away with three sacks against Miami and held the Hurricanes starting running back, Mark Walton, to 31 yards on 12 carries.
- FSU's 12 pass breakups were its most in a game since having 13 vs. Miami in 2008.

- Auden Tate's 20-yard touchdown on FSU's opening drive was his fifth straight game with a touchdown, the second-longest stretch to open a season in FSU history.
- James Blackman completed his first seven passes against the Blue Devils. After completing his final eight against Miami, Blackman's 15 consecutive completions were one shy of the FSU record for consecutive completions (16, Christian Ponder 2009 and Danny Kanell 1995).
- Freshman running back Cam Akers finished with 115 yards on 15 carries and had his first career touchdown in the fourth quarter to break a 10-10 tie. It was his second straight 100-yard rushing game after running for 121 yards vs. Miami.
- Redshirt sophomore linebacker Adonis Thomas and left tackle Josh Ball made the first starts of their career.
- Punter Logan Tyler booted a 51- and 52-yarder in the first half and a 61-yarder in the second half. The 61-yarder was the longest punt of his career.
- Emmett Rice recorded his first career interception on a pass from Duke running back Shaun Wilson, becoming the fourth Seminole to record his first turnover this season.
- Wide receivers D.J. Matthews and Jared Jackson caught the first passes of their career in the same drive in the second quarter.
- Nyqwan Murray set a season high with 81 receiving yards. His 38-yard catch and run in the third quarter was his longest catch of the season.
- Kicker Ricky Aguayo's 23-yard field goal in the third quarter was his 11th consecutive made field goal, the longest stretch of his career.

- Freshman quarterback James Blackman finished the game 16-of-28 for 248 yards with two touchdowns and two interceptions. It was his third 200-yard passing game of the season.
- Wide receiver Nyqwan Murray's first touchdown of the season came on an end zone fumble recovery with 13:21 remaining; he scored a second fourth-quarter touchdown on a 20-yard pass from Blackman that tied the game at 28-28.
- Defensive end Josh Sweat registered a career-high nine tackles, including six solo stops. He had a sack among two tackles for loss.
- Matthew Thomas and Trey Marshall led the Noles with 10 tackles each.
- Thomas' 34-yard fumble return for a touchdown with 4:08 remaining in the first half put the Noles in front 14-7. It was Thomas' first career fumble recovery and first touchdown. Freshman Joshua Kaindoh forced the fumble, his first career forced fumble. It was the Seminoles first defensive touchdown since 2015.
- The Seminoles limited Louisville quarterback and reigning Heisman Trophy winner Lamar Jackson to a season-low 156 passing yards. Jackson finished with 334 total yards, well below his season average of 411.
- The Noles continued to excel in the red zone, converting all three visits against the Cardinals. The Noles extended their consecutive conversion streak to 16. It marked the first time this season FSU has converted three red zone visits into touchdowns.
- Wide receiver Auden Tate led FSU with five receptions, while Murray had four catches for a season-high 95 yards. Running back Jacques Patrick and Cam Akers combined for 145 yards on the ground.

- Matthew Thomas tied a career high with 15 tackles against the Eagles. Thomas also had 15 tackles against Michigan in the 2016 Orange Bowl.
- The 15 tackles are tied for the most for a Seminole since 2010. It has now happened four times – Thomas twice, Telvin Smith in 2014 BCS Championship Game vs. Auburn and Kendall Smith in 2010 vs. NC State.
- Derwin James came away with 13 tackles, one shy of his career high of 14 against Houston in the 2015 Peach Bowl.
- Nyqwan Murray had 102 yards on three receptions; it was his third career 100-yard game and first of 2017.
- Josh Sweat recorded two tackles for loss, 0.5 tackles short of his career high 2.5 tackles for loss that he last had against Florida in 2016.
- Jacob Pugh recorded six tackles and two pass breakups in his first game back since the Miami game. Pugh's two pass breakups were a career high and tied the amount he had in his previous three years as a Seminole.
- FSU converted a 4th-and-8 in the second quarter; it was FSU's longest fourth down conversion since a 4th-and-9 fake punt by Graham Gano in 2008 vs. Boston College.
- True freshman running back Cam Akers completed his first career pass for 47 yards to Murray on FSU's opening drive.
- Akers and redshirt senior wide receiver Jared Jackson made their first career starts.
- Logan Tyler had seven punts for 299 yards, good for a 42.7 yard average.
- Ermon Lane played at receiver for the first time since switching to defensive back a season ago. He had one reception for nine yards.
- Jalen Wilkerson tied his career high with three tackles.

- True freshman tailback Cam Akers turned in a career-high performance with 199 rushing yards on 22 carries, including touchdown runs of 54 and 63 yards. That moved him from sixth to No. 3 on FSU's all-time rushing list for true freshmen.
- The Seminoles posted their earliest touchdown strike of the season on their opening possession of the game. James Blackman's 51-yard touchdown pass to Nyqwan Murray with 10:02 on the game clock finished off a 4-play, 53-yard drive.
- It was the first time since November 28, 1976 against Virginia Tech, the final game of Bobby Bowden's first season as head coach in Tallahassee, that FSU had three offensive touchdowns of at least 50 yards.
- Matthew Thomas and Derwin James both blocked field goals, the first time since Duke in 2003 that FSU blocked two FGs in a game. FSU has four blocked kicks this year (two Brian Burns punts as well), the most in a season since 2010.
- Freshman defensive back Hamsah Nasirildeen made his first career start. He joins Blackman and Akers as the third true freshman to start this season.
- Ermon Lane made his first start at wide receiver since the 2014 season. It was his seventh career start, the last four of which came at defensive back in 2016.
- Blackman's 51-yard touchdown pass to Murray was his longest touchdown pass this season and his second-longest completion (60 yards to George Campbell vs. NC State).
- Derwin James had his second career interception on Syracuse's first drive. The defense finished with three sacks, six tackles for loss, nine pass breakups and nine QB hurries.
- Syracuse ran 95 plays, the second-most by an opponent in FSU history (Houston, 99, 2015 Peach Bowl).

- Brian Burns set a career high with seven tackles and 4.5 tackles for loss. Burns added two forced fumbles and a fumble recovery, the first player in FSU history with two forced fumbles and a fumble recovery in the same game.
- Burns is the first Seminole with two forced fumbles in a game since Jalen Ramsey at NC State in 2014.
- Burns' 4.5 tackles for loss are the most for a Seminole since DeMarcus Walker had 4.5 (all sacks) against Ole Miss in the 2016 season opener.
- Demarcus Christmas recovered the second fumble of his career at the FSU three-yard line after Clemson traveled 71 yards in 15 plays. Christmas' first fumble recovery came against Charleston Southern in 2016.
- Nyqwan Murray finished with a team-high 73 yards, including a 39-yard catch that led to FSU's first touchdown. Over the past five games, Murray has 19 catches for 411 yards.
- Redshirt senior linebacker Matthew Thomas finished with 11 tackles, his fifth game this season with at least 10. He added 1.5 tackles for loss.
- True freshman defensive back Hamsah Nasirildeen had 10 tackles, more than doubling his previous career high of four against Syracuse.
- Redshirt junior tight end Ryan Izzo's 60-yard touchdown in the fourth quarter was the longest catch of his career. The 60-yard score was the longest touchdown catch for FSU this season and the second-longest score overall (Akers' 63-yard run vs. Syracuse). It was the longest TD for an FSU tight end since 1993 (Lonnie Johnson vs. Clemson).
- The 60-yard pass was the longest of true freshman quarterback James Blackman's career, matching a 60-yard pass to George Campbell against NC State.
- FSU had a pair of touchdown drives of at least 85 yards at Clemson.

- FSU's 77 points scored are the most in the country in 2017 and the second-most in FSU history. FSU's 56 first-half points are the most in school history (also vs. Tulane, 1992).
- Derwin James' 41-yard interception return for a touchdown in the first quarter was FSU's first pick-six since Terrance Smith did it against Florida in 2014. Tarvarus McFadden added a touchdown on a blocked field goal, FSU's first since 2006 against Clemson.
- Freshman D.J. Matthews amassed 138 yards on 5 punt returns. Matthews is the first Nole with more than 100 punt return yards in a game since Tyler Hunter (122) vs. Duke in 2012 and is the third-highest single-game total for FSU.
- Fullback Gabe Nabers (2-yard) and receiver Justin Motlow (12-yard) scored the first receiving touchdowns of their careers.
- Senior running back Ryan Green's 5-yard TD run in the third quarter was his first score since a 1-yard plunge against Nevada in 2013. Green capped his day with a career-long 50-yard TD run and a team-leading and career-high 96 yards on 7 carries.
- Freshman defensive end Joshua Kaindoh recorded four sacks - the first four of his career. Kaindoh's four sacks are the second-most by a player in the country this season and the most sacks by a Nole since DeMarcus Walker had 4.5 vs. Ole Miss last season. Kaindoh led the Noles in tackles with six after entering the game with nine through his first nine games.

- FSU won for the fifth straight time against Florida and the fourth consecutive time in Gainesville. Both of those are FSU highs against the Gators. FSU improved to 7-1 against the Gators since 2010.
- This game was the first time since 1988 that FSU scored two non-offensive touchdowns in a game against Florida and the first time ever that FSU has scored two defensive touchdowns against the Gators (62 games).
- Jacob Pugh's fumble recovery for a touchdown was his third career fumble recovery. The score was the first of his career.
- Brian Burns' sack on Florida quarterback Feleipe Franks was his fourth of the season and 13th of his career. Burns forced the fumble that led to Pugh's touchdown. Burns has three of FSU's seven forced fumbles this season. Burns added 2.5 tackles for loss and two pass breakups.
- Cornerback Levonta Taylor's interception on the final play of the first quarter was his first career takeaway. His second was in the second quarter, an 18-yard interception return for a touchdown. He is the first Seminole since Pugh against Notre Dame in 2014 with two interceptions in a game.
- Stanford Samuels III recorded his first career sack, a seven-yard loss in the second quarter.
- FSU converted all four Florida turnovers into touchdowns. FSU entered the game with just 24 points off turnovers on the season. The four takeaways are the most for the FSU defense since forcing four in the 2016 season opener against Ole Miss.

- The win over ULM was FSU's sixth of the season, making FSU eligible for a bowl game for an NCAA-record 36th straight season.
- FSU was led by interim head coach Odell Haggins. It was Haggins' first game as acting head coach after being a Seminole assistant since 1994.
- Defensive back Stanford Samuels III made his first career start, the fourth true freshman to start in 2017 (QB James Blackman, RB Cam Akers and DB Hamsah Nasirildeen).
- Redshirt senior defensive back Nate Andrews made his 22nd career start and first of 2017.
- Running back Jacques Patrick had 155 rushing yards, his fourth career 100-yard game and second this season. Cam Akers added 117 yards on the ground, the first time since USF in 2016 that FSU had a pair of 100-yard running backs.
- Akers finished with two touchdowns, tying a career high. He has 930 yards on the season and trails Dalvin Cook by 79 for the FSU freshman rushing record (1,008, 2014).
- Defensive back Levonta Taylor had four tackles (all in the first half), tying his career high (at NC State, 2016).
- Receiver D.J. Matthews caught his second career pass - and first career touchdown - to give FSU a 14-0 lead in the second quarter.
- Senior receiver Ermon Lane tied a career high with three catches for 45 yards. Lane also caught three passes as a freshman against The Citadel before playing as a defensive back in 2016 and early in 2017.
- Derwin James finished with 12 tackles, his second double-digit tackle game of the season. James had 13 at Boston College.
- Freshman Tre' McKitty's 23-yard catch in the fourth quarter was the first of his career.

- Playing in a bowl game for the 36th consecutive season, Florida State beat Southern Miss 42-13 in the Walk-On's Independence Bowl. Interim head coach Odell Haggins moved to 2-0 in his career as head coach.
- The win improved FSU to 7-6 on the season, FSU's 41st consecutive winning season, one shy of the all-time record (Notre Dame, 1889-1932).
- FSU is 29-16-2 all-time in bowl games, with eight wins in the past 10 tries.
- FSU had a 23-6 halftime lead and improved to 7-1 in 2017 when leading at halftime.
- FSU had 16 scoring drives of 75 or more yards (15 touchdowns, one field goal), including three TD drives against USM.
- FSU forced at least one turnover in eight of 13 games this season.
- After allowing 63 yards and a touchdown on the first drive of the game, FSU's defense allowed 86 yards on the Golden Eagles' next five drives combined, resulting in three punts, a lost fumble and the end of the first half.
- FSU was 6-for-7 in the red zone vs. USM and finished 2017 44-of-48. Before ending the game on the USM 5-yard line, FSU had converted 26 consecutive red zone tries. In that span, FSU scored 22 touchdowns and four field goals (five TDs vs. USM).
- FSU had a 1,000-yard rusher for the fifth straight season (D. Freeman 2013, D. Cook 2014-16, Akers 2017). FSU did not have a 1,000-yard runner between 1997 and 2012.
- FSU made its first appearance in the Independence Bowl and improved to 11-6 when playing in a bowl game for the first time.
- FSU outscored opponents 199-51 over the season-ending four-game win streak.
- FSU's 42 points scored are its most in a bowl game since also beating Wisconsin 42-13 in the 2008 Champs Sports Bowl.
- True freshman quarterback James Blackman and redshirt senior Nate Andrews were named offensive and defensive MVPs, respectively.
- Freshman running back Cam Akers ran for 94 yards on 13 carries, passing Dalvin Cook for the most rushing yards by an FSU freshman in a season (1,024). Akers also caught a 14-yard touchdown pass from James Blackman in the second quarter. It was Akers' first career receiving touchdown.
- Blackman passed for a career-high four touchdowns. Blackman threw for at least one touchdown in 11 of 12 starts and had multiple touchdown passes in five games, including three of the past four.
- Blackman's four touchdown passes set an Independence Bowl record for TD passes in a game and were the most for a Seminole QB in a bowl since Chris Weinke had four against Virginia Tech in the Sugar Bowl (1/4/2000).
- Junior wide receiver Auden Tate caught five passes for 84 yards against Southern Miss, including three touchdowns. Tate's 10 touchdown catches are the most for a Seminole since Kelvin Benjamin (15) in 2013. It was the first multi-TD game for an FSU receiver in 2017 and tied the Independence Bowl record for TD catches in a game.

- Blackman's 19 TD passes tied for No. 19 in single-season history. Tate's 10 TD catches tied for 13th in FSU single-season history.
- Freshman wide receiver D.J. Matthews, redshirt sophomore defensive end Jalen Wilkerson and sophomore linebacker Emmett Rice made the first starts of their careers.
- FSU's starting offensive line of Josh Ball, Derrick Kelly, Alec Eberle, Cole Minshew and Rick Leonard started for the ninth consecutive game.
- Sophomore kicker Ricky Aguayo made three field goals. He was 18-for-21 on the year and made seven straight over the final seven games. Aguayo entered bowl season 21st nationally and third in the ACC with an .833 field goal percentage.
- Redshirt junior tight end Ryan Izzo had six catches for 59 yards, setting a career high for receptions in a game.
- True freshman defensive back Stanford Samuels III forced a Southern Miss fumble late in the second quarter, the first of his career. It was recovered by junior A.J. Westbrook, his first career recovery.
- Playing his final career game, redshirt senior Nate Andrews led FSU with six tackles, a season high.
- Junior running back Jacques Patrick ran 16 times for 61 yards, including his 16th career rushing touchdown, tied for 18th in FSU history.
