Peter Mitchell averaged a career-best 74.25 strokes per round as a junior.

On Mitchell: Cemented his position in the Seminoles' starting lineup with an outstanding spring 2002 season ... averaged nearly 3.2 strokes fewer during the 2001-02 season (fall and spring combined) than he did during the first two years of his Seminole career ... played in more rounds and earned more top-10 individual finishes as a junior

than he did as a freshman and a sophomore combined ... averages 75.62 strokes in 42 rounds during 14 tournaments in his career.

Fall 1999: A member of the team who did not compete in any tournaments.

Spring 2000: Played in three events as he joined the Seminoles' starting five ... tied his career-low score for a single round with a 73 in the Billy Hitchcock Intercollegiate where he finished in a career-best tie for 36th place ... his one-over par 73 in the third round allowed him to total a season-low 12-over par 228 for the tournament ... also shot a one-over par 73 in the second round of the Seminole Classic where he totaled 230 for the tournament ... averaged 77.00 strokes per round in nine rounds during three tournaments.

Fall 2000: Played in two events as a member of the Seminoles' starting rotation ... two consecutive rounds of four-over par 76 came in the second and third rounds of the Cleveland Golf/Kiawah Island Intercollegiate ... season-low score of 74 in the first round of the Coca-Cola Tournament ... played consistently as he averaged 75.33 for the three rounds of the tournament and finished in a tie for 52nd-place ... averaged 76.00 strokes per round in six rounds during two tournaments.

Spring 2001: Competed in one event, the Beau Rivage College Classic, where he helped the Seminoles to an 11th-place finish ... shot a season-low round of four-over par 76 in the second round to finish with a three-round tournament score of 245 ... averaged 81.67 strokes per round in three rounds during one tournament.

70 and finished the event with a one-under par score of 71 ... his 140 score after 54 holes is the best two-round score of his career ... the Seminoles' team finish was an improvement of two positions from last season ... finished the event with a career-low tournament score of 211 which was five strokes better than his previous low tournament score ... finished with a career-best (minus-5) score vs. par that was five strokes better than his previous best low score vs. par ... carded back-to-back scores of two-under par 70 that tied his career low round that he shot three times during the season ... he has competed in two ACC championship events entering his senior season ... finished in ninth place in the individual standings at the Florida State hosted Seminole Intercollegiate at Golden Eagle Country Club in Tallahassee ... his best individual finish came at the Billy Hitchcock Intercollegiate as he finished tied for seventh in the individual standings ... carded two rounds of par or better (72 and 71 in the first and second rounds) to finish as the Seminole's top golfer for the career-high fifth time (in seven events) during the season ... helped lead Florida State to its best team finish of the season, sixth place ... averaged a career-low 73.62 strokes in 21 rounds during seven tournaments.

On Beaty: A member of the Seminoles' starting lineup and will be one of the team leaders throughout his career ... the only freshman (and one of only two players) to participate in all 12 tournaments during the Seminoles during the 2001-02 fall and spring seasons ... carded his single-round career-low score of 67 in the third round of the Mercedes-Benz Collegiate Championship during the spring 2002 season ... Florida State's top individual finisher in two events during his freshman season – the Mercedes-Benz Collegiate Championship and the Country Club of Louisiana Intercollegiate ... ranked first on the team in rounds at 75 or below (21), low-round score (67) and score vs. par (minus five), while tying for the team lead in tournaments competed in (12) rounds played in (36) and ranked second in rounds at par or better (six) during the 2001-02 fall and spring seasons combined ... carded the Seminoles' low round score during the fall season (67) and tied for the team lead during the spring season (69).

Fall 2001: Joined the Seminoles' starting lineup upon his arrival and competed in all five fall tournaments ... career-best tournament score of 215 came during the second event of his career – the Mason Rudolph Collegiate Championship ... carded a five-over par score of 215 in the event – the best tournament score of his first season by three strokes (218 in the ACC Championship) ... finished in a tie for 22nd place in the individual standings to gain his second best career finish (tied for 18th in the Mercedes-Benz Collegiate Championship) ... ranked second on the team with 10 scores of 75 or below and with two rounds of par or better ... best 54-hole score came at the Mason Rudolph with a 140 two-round total ... shot 69 in the first round of the tournament and 71 in the second ... was in a tie for 13th-place in the individual standings after the first two rounds of the event ... all 15 of his single-round scores came in at 78 or below during his first season ... ranked second on the team with a career-low 74.33 average in 15 rounds during five tournaments.

Spring 2002: A member of the Seminoles' starting lineup who competed in all seven tournaments ... competed in the ACC Tournament and finished as the Seminoles' second-highest finisher during the event ... career-best individual finish of tied

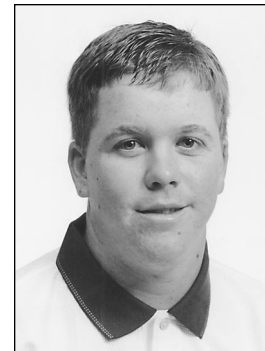

On Beers: One of the Seminoles' top five golfers during the 2001-02 season ... became a member of Florida State's starting lineup and competed in 11 of 12 tournaments during the fall and spring seasons ... ranked third on the team in tournaments played (11), third in total rounds played (33), fourth in stroke average among starters (75.36), fourth in rounds of 75 or better (17) and tied for fourth with four rounds of par or better ... career-low single-round score of 68 came in the third round of the Cleveland Golf Intercollegiate during the spring of 2002 and was the second lowest score of the entire year for the Seminoles ... originally recruited to attend Mississippi State by current Seminole and former Bulldog head coach Nicky Geotze ... participated in one tournament during his one year at Mississippi State.

Fall 2000: Participated in one tournament, the G. Gunby Jordan Intercollegiate ... totaled 119 for the rain-shortened 27 hole event ... carded a five-over par 77 in his first collegiate round and a 42 in nine holes during the second round ... finished in a tie for 53rd-place in the event ... helped the Bulldogs to a tie for third-place finish.

Spring 2001: A member of the Mississippi State varsity team but did not participate in any tournaments.

Alabama/Mississippi district ... earned second-place finishes in both of those tournaments in 2000 ... averaged 73.27 strokes per round in 6 junior national tournaments played in 2000 ... earned four varsity letters as a prep standout ... a three-time all-state honoree ... led his team to the state championship and finished second in the state tournament as a senior ... medallist awarded as a sophomore, junior and senior ... averaged 72.80 strokes per round during his senior season ... graduated with honors from Mercy Cross and was a Wendy's High School Heisman Nominee for scholarship, athletics and citizenship ... earned academic honors as a sophomore, junior and senior ... a member of the National Honor Society in grades 10, 11 and 12 ... high school coach was Jimmie Tucker.

On Lusenhop: Cemented his position as a member of the Seminoles' starting five ... participated in a career-high 12 tournaments as a redshirt sophomore during the 2001-2002 fall and spring seasons ... played in twice as many events as a redshirt sophomore than he had during his first two years as a member of the team ... ranked second on the team as he carded 19 rounds with scores of 75 or under.

Fall 1999: Played in one tournament, the Louisiana State Intercollegiate, and performed very well ... first two rounds, one-over par 73 and two over par 74 for a total of three-over par 150, placed him among the top 20 golfers after the first day of competition ... averaged 77.33 strokes per round for the fall season.
