

Swimming & Diving Facilities



The Florida State swimming and diving program has the luxury of using both an indoor and outdoor pool on campus.

Bobby E. Leach Center Pool

The Leach Center Pool is a 16-lane by 25-yard indoor swimming facility with two one-meter and two three-meter diving boards. A complete spa area is located just off the pool deck and is equipped with two whirlpools, two steam rooms and a sauna. The pool is part of the Bobby E. Leach Center, which is located on Chieftan Way next to Tully Gymnasium. The state-of-the-art student recreation facility was constructed in 1991 and underwent a renovation this summer, expanding by over 8,000 square feet. Included in the expansion is new workout space and equipment and two new group exercise rooms. To contact the Leach Center Pool, call 644-0556.

Bim Stults Aquatic Center

Named for Florida State's first swimming coach, who directed the Seminoles from 1949-73, the Bim Stults Aquatic Center pool is an eight-lane by 50-meter pool with two one-meter diving boards, one three-meter diving board and a 10-meter platform. The pool lanes may be reconfigured to represent

a 16-lane by 25-yard outdoor swimming pool. The Stults Pool is located in the heart of campus on Woodward Avenue and is utilized from Spring Break through Thanksgiving. To contact the Stults Pool, call 644-1867.
