2004-05: Joined the Seminoles at the semester, competing only at the ACC Championships (Feb. 16-19)...Tied Andree-Anne LeRoy's school record in the 200 backstroke, touching in at 1:59.50 to take third and earn All-ACC honors. Time was also an NCAA "B" Cut...Took fourth in the 100 backstroke at the conference meet, posting the third-fastest time in school history with her NCAA consideration time of 55.99...Notched her third NCAA provisional time with a 16th-place 1:50.71 in the 200 freestyle that rates as the ninth-fastest in Seminole lore...Member of the 800 free relay that set a new school record of 7:19.59 while taking fourth place...Swam the backstroke leg of the 400 medley relay that placed second with a time of 3:40.93...Made the consolation heat of two events at the 2005 World University Games in Izmir, Turkey...Took fourth in the consolation final, 12th overall with a time of 1:03.97 during the 100-meter backstroke...Placed fifth in the heat and 13th overall with a 2:20.51 at the 200-meter distance...Added a time of 30.65 in the 50-meter backstroke that missed making the consolations by 0.14.

HIGH SCHOOL: Swept the backstroke events at the 2004 All-Africa Games with gold medals in the 50, 100 and 200 events...Added a silver medal in the 100 backstroke and a third-place finish at the 200-meter distance at the 2004 South African Senior Nationals...Collected six gold medals at the 2002 All-Africa Games...Advanced to the finals of the 50, 100 and 200 backstroke at the World Cup Championships...Won the 2003 Sports Writer Award as the top female athlete in the Western Cape...Coached by Wendy Way for both the German International School and CADO club teams.

2004-05: Captured her first individual ACC title and second All-ACC award by taking the 100-yard breaststroke with a gold medal time of 1:02.45, winning the event by nearly one second. Victory was Florida State's third in a row in the event...Took 24th at the NCAA Championships (March 18-20) with a time of 1:02.84...Also competed on four relays at the national championships...Added a top-16 finish in the 200

breaststroke at the conference meet (Feb. 16-19), posting a 13th-place time of 2:19.97...Swam the breaststroke leg of the second-place 400 medley relay...Improved all-three of her career-best times at the Georgia Fall Invitational (Dec. 3-5)...Took third in the 100 breast with a 1:02.32 that ties Samantha White for the second-fastest time in school history. Eighth-place time of 2:19.80 at the 200-yard distance rates 10th. Also improved her 50 freestyle standard with a 23.95...Posted NCAA "B" cuts six times throughout the season...Scored nine first-place finishes during the year, including a victory in the 100 breast against second-ranked Auburn (Jan. 29) and No. 4 Florida (Nov. 16).



2003-04: Made an immediate impact, earning Honorable Mention All-America...Swam the breaststroke leg of the 200 medley relay that took 11th, while also taking part in the 12th-place 400 medley relay...Individually, placed 26th in the 100 breaststroke with a time of 1:02.96...Finished second at the ACC Championships (Feb. 18-21) with a time of 1:02.72...Member of the winning 200 medley quartet that set the school and conference meet record (1:40.84)...Also notched a season-best time of 2:21.08 during the 200 breaststroke at the conference meet to hit the wall in 17th...Captured All-ACC honors in both the 100 breast and 200 medley relay...Placed third in the 100 breaststroke at the Texas A&M Fall Invitational (Nov. 21-23) with a season-best time of 1:02.48, the fastest 100 breaststroke time by an ACC freshman in 2003-04 and 24th in the NCAA...Scored 11 top three finishes during the season, including four victories...Notched four NCAA "B" cuts in the 100 breast throughout the year with one at the 200-yard distance...Upbeat demeanor earned her the team's Spirit Award at the annual team banquet.

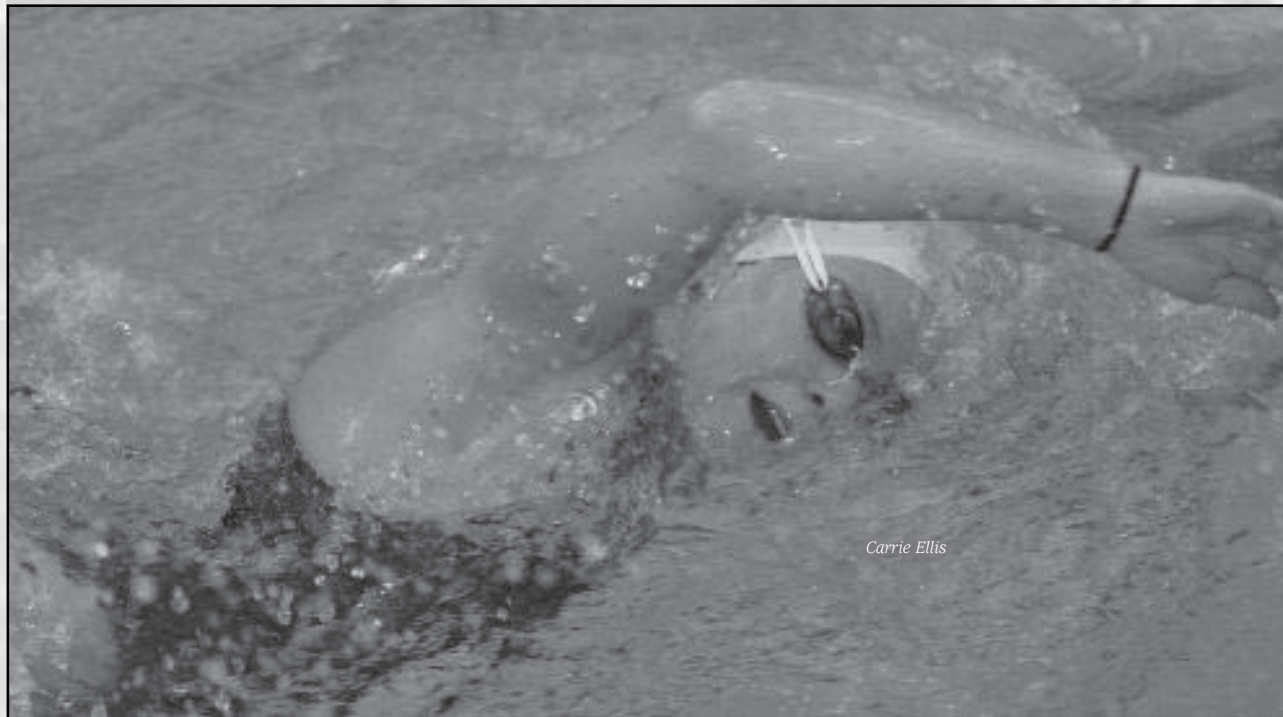
2004-05: Returned after a two-year absence to earn her second All-ACC honors and take part in her second NCAA Championships...Placed second in the 100 freestyle with a time of 50.05 at the ACC meet (Feb. 16-19). Came back to lead off the 400 freestyle relay with a career-best time of 49.77 that rates as the second-fastest mark in school history...Took second in the 50 freestyle with a personal-best time of 23.08 that lists as the fourth-fastest at FSU...Broke into the Florida State all-time top ten in the 200 freestyle at number eight, posting a time of 1:50.70 to take 11th...Member of three top three relays, including the 400 freestyle and 400 medley quartets that

finished second...Swam a pair of events at the NCAA Championships (March 18-20), taking 36th in the 100 freestyle at 50.34 to go along with a 59th-place 23.61 during the 50 freestyle...Also swam on four relays at the national summit...Made the finals of both the 50 and 100 freestyle at the Georgia Fall Invitational (Dec. 3-5), taking eighth in both events with times of 23.38 and 50.59 respectively...Scored seven victories throughout the dual meet season with 16 top-three finishes...Won both the 50 freestyle (23.73) and 100 freestyle (51.31) against fourth-ranked Florida...Posted seven NCAA "B" cuts during the season...Honored as team MVP, while also picking up the Comeback Award at the annual team banquet...Tied for 24th in the 50-meter freestyle at the 2005 ConocoPhillips US National Championships with a career-best long-course time of 26.54...Placed 36th in the 100-meter freestyle with a time of 57.90 that she bettered to 57.32 in a time trial.

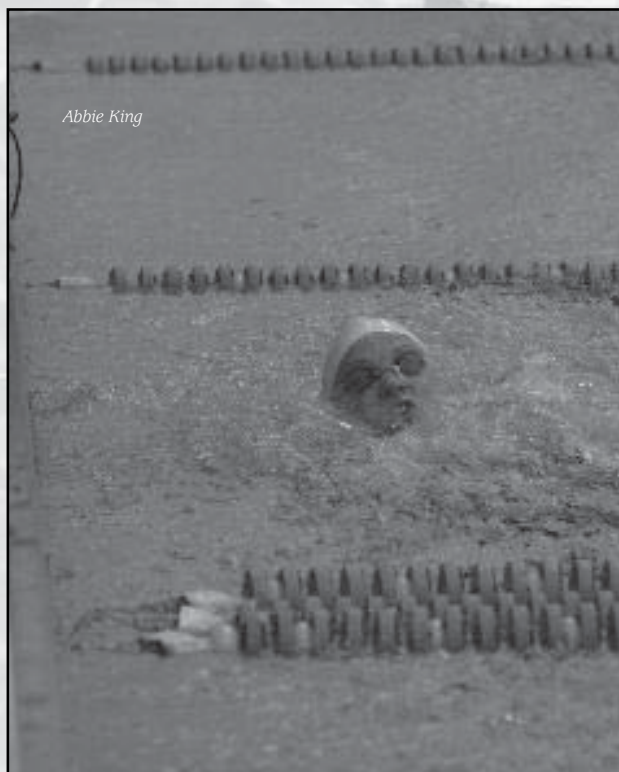

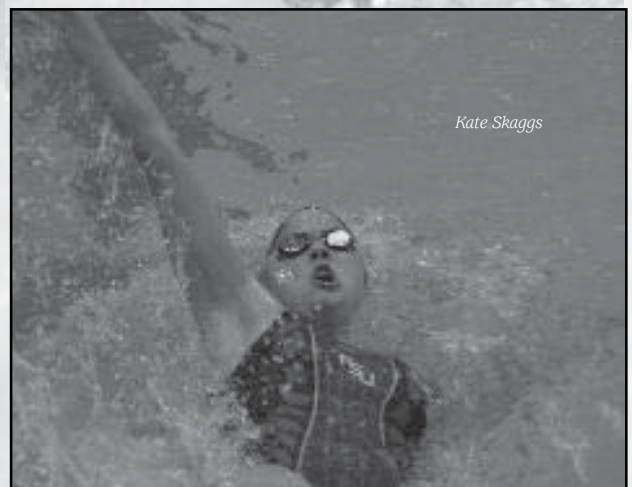
