Men's 2003 Outlook

Sprints

The continuing development and experience of seniors Cederick Robinson, Kolby Jones and David Johnson will be needed to lead a group of newcomers. Brian Dizingai, a transfer from Truman State, is expected to have an immediate impact at both the conference and national levels. Freshman Derrick Baker and Ricky Argro are anxious to get a taste of collegiate level competition. B.J Ward and Craphonso Thorpe will rejoin the track team at the conclusion of the football season to round off the sprint group for the men's team.

Hurdles

Danyne Brown enters his senior year of competition as the number one hurdler for the Seminoles. Brown finished second last year in the 400m hurdles at the ACC Championships but has his eyes set on faster times and a trip to the NCAA outdoor champion-

barrier since All-American Jeff Bray in 1992. Atkinson leads a group of talented vaulters that includes Brooks Webber and Jared Sweetser, both of whom scored at the ACC outdoor championships last season. Redshirt vaulter Patrick Gerberick returns to the Tribe and is excited to get back into uniform. Several freshman vaulters are working to break into the travel group. In the high jump, freshman Craig McClure and Shawn Allen look to fill the void left by the graduation of All-American Shawn Brown and NCAA qualifier Christian Bland.

Throws

Josh Bowling enters his senior year and will lead an outstanding group of throwers who are ready to climb to the top of the ACC and break into the national scene. Bowling recorded his highest finish ever in the conference championship last year, placing third in the hammer throw. Junior Dorrian Scott is primed for a break

ships. Senior Nabavi Oliver, a third place finisher at the ACC championships, along with Joe Paiva and Peter Prato help to round out the hurdles squad. The Seminoles look to follow tradition by having a strong showing in the 400m hurdles at the conference championships.

Jumps

Kolby Jones, a senior and former ACC long jump champion, leads the horizontal jumps along with freshman USA Junior triple jump champion Rafeeq Curry. This dynamic duo hopes to claim conference titles during the 2003 track and field season. Adding depth to the horizontal jumps is freshman Ricky Argro and transfer Willie Johnson.

In the vertical jumps, senior pole vaulter Jeff Atkinson looks to raise the bar and become to first Seminole to clear the 18 foot

through year in the shot put as he sets his goal to cross the 60-foot barrier. Marcus Johnson returns focused and is determined to reclaim his spot as the ACC discus champion while working towards All-America honors. Dan Royal and red shirt freshman Andrew Diakos continue to improve and will add strong depth.

High school All-American Garrett Johnson has the ability to move into the upper level of the ACC rankings as a true freshman and leads a talented group of freshman throwers who are all from the state of Florida.

Middle Distance

The return of ACC champions Maarten van den Heuvel (1500m) and Sean Campbell (800m) should enable the Seminole mid-distance runners to have a huge impact at the conference and national levels. Another key returnee is senior Dave Johnson, who finished third at the 2002 ACC outdoor meet in the 800m. Senior Giscard Titus, a transfer from Auburn, brings experience to the indoor mile and the 1500m. Freshman Robert Cooper, a top 50 high school runner in the nation, looks to race in the 800m and 1500m, while competing for a spot on the distance medley. Senior Phillip Daniels will compete for a spot on the 4 x 400 and distance medley. Junior Tony Martin, who holds a personal record of 1:50.7 in the 800m, returns after a year hiatus. Lars Tveter, Steve Dibari, Chris Potter and Bruce Chapman continue to work hard and should provide much needed depth.

Distance

The distance crew returns stronger than ever. Junior Joep Tigchelaar, the 2002 ACC champ in the 10,000m and runner up in the 5,000m will provide a huge spark for the Seminole distance runners. Senior Dave Guerra provides leadership and experience after finishing sixth in the ACC 3000m steeple chase last season. Nate Adams, a junior and top-three cross country runner, should have a big impact in the 10,000m at the ACC's. Andrew Bautel, a red shirt freshman, looks to compete and add depth in the 5k and 10k. Another freshman, A.J. Wilson should contribute in the 5k. Other members competing for time in distance events include Jim Van Veen, Nate Davis, Shawn Patterson and Nathan Timm.
