
# ACC Track & Field 50th Anniversary Team




- JOE ALLEN (2000-2001) was the outdoor ACC champion in the long jump during 2000 and 2001, as well as the 2001 ACC outdoor triple jump champion. Allen was named the ACC Outdoor Meet Most Outstanding Performer following first place finishes in the long and triple jump and earned NCAA provisional qualifying mark (long jump) at FSU Relays. Allen was also named the ACC outdoor event MVP during his senior season. He earned All-ACC honors in 2000 and 2001.
- JEFF BRAY(1990-1993) was the only other Seminole to be named to the indoor team. His accomplishments include the 1992 and 1993 ACC championship in pole vault. Bray was named to the All-ACC team in 1992 and 1993 and was selected as an All-American in the pole vault in 1993.
- **JONATHAN CARTER (1993-1996)** was a six time All-American. He was an All-American in the 100m dash in 1995 and 1996. He also received 200m All-America honors in 1996. Carter was a three-time All-American in 1993, 1994 and 1996 as a member of the 4 X 100m relay team. Furthermore, he was the 100m dash outdoor champion in 1994 along with being named to the All-ACC team the same year.
- TONYA CARTER (1997-2000) was the 2000 indoor NCAA National Champion in the 60m-dash. She was a two-time All-American in the 60m-dash in 1999 and 2000. In addition, she was awarded All-America honors in 2000 in the outdoor 100m-dash. That win, along with winning the 200m dash, led FSU to its first ACC title. She holds the ACC meet record in the 100m dash with a time of 11.31.
- SHERYL COVINGTON (1991-1994) earned All-America honors in 1993 for the indoor 55m- and 200m-dashes. She was a 1993 ACC Champion in the 55m, which she repeated in 1994. That same year she was also awarded ACC Champion honors in the 200m dash.
- **SOPHIA DANVERS (1994-1997)** was a three-time All-American in the 4x400m and received All-America honors once in the 4x100m. She was the 1997 ACC Champion in the 400m-dash and two-time ACC Champion in 1996 and 1997 in the 4x400m. Furthermore, she was a four-time All-America honoree and four-time All-ACC honoree.
- **SAMANTHA GEORGE (1997-2000)** was a 2000 indoor All-American in the 400m-dash and a two-time ACC Champion in 1999 and 2000 in the outdoor 400m. She earned an All-America title for her sixth-place finish in the outdoor 400m-dash in 1999. She represented Canada at the 2000 Atlanta Olympics in the 400m-hurdles and dash. She was a 1999 and 2000 All-ACC honoree.
- **LAURA GERBER (1999-2001)** was the 1999 ACC Champion for the indoor 800m run. She was named a 2001 All-American in that same event. A two time All-ACC member in 1999 and 2001, she was also a member of the NCAA runner-up 4x400m relay team
- TRINETTE JOHNSON (1990-1993) was a three-time All-American in outdoor track and field, earning these honors in the long jump in 1992 and 1993 and in the 4x400-relay in 1992. She was named ACC Champion in the long jump twice in 1992 and 1993, as well as holding the ACC Meet record in the long jump with a distance of 21-0.5.
- ERICA SHEPARD (1994-1997) named All-American in indoor 800m run in 1996. Twice earned All-America honors in


1996 and 1997 in the 4x400m. She was the ACC Champion in the 800m two years straight beginning in 1996.

PHILLIP RILEY (1993-1996) was the 1995 NCAA indoor national hurdles champion. He was an All-American in the outdoor hurdles and 4X100m relay team during the 1996 campaign. Riley was also the outdoor ACC champion in the 110m hurdles in 1994 and 1996. He earned All-ACC honors in 1994 and 1996 and was named to the 1994 and 1995 All-American team in the 55m-hurdles. In addition, he was named to the 1994 All-ACC team.



## KE LONG TRACK T

Prior to 1957, the Florida State track facility was on the old west campus, near where Tallahassee Community College is today.

1957-First track built on the campus of FSU. Served as a joint facility with Florida High School's football and track programs. The track surface consisted of a mix of clay and fine grain crushed granite slag.

Preparation procedure

included wetting down and dragging the track, similar to what is done on a baseball field, then lining the lanes with marble dust.

1974-First synthetic surface is installed. Six lane track except for 8 lanes on the home straightaway. The construction was considered a \$100,000 investment. Admired and appreciated throughout the southeast for optimal comfort and

absorbency

1979-Officially named Mike Long Track, who retired at the end of the 1977 season. The Florida State Athletic Director at the time, John Bridges was tired of calling it "The Track."

1984-New Rekortan surface is installed, which was the same surface used in the Olympic track facilities in Munich, Moscow and Los Angeles. The work crew came directly from LA to install the track surface in Tallahassee. New bleachers were also put in place.

1988-Mike Long Track hosts the USA Track and Field National Junior Championship.

1991- Host of 1991 AAU National Championship.

1992-Host of ACC outdoor track and field championships.

1994-Host of USA Track and Field National Junior Championship.

2002-After 19 seasons with the same base of asphalt, large cracks and

other structural damage had occurred. The new state of the art facility would include major revisions. The track turns were widened and equal quadrants were in place. This would ensure better training and competition.

Three major phases make up the new construction:

Track and infield completely redone. Removal of east lights,

seating, fencing and sidewalks Renovate lights and seating on the west side of the facility. In addition, new concessions and restrooms will be installed. New office complex, locker rooms and strength and conditioning area to be constructed.
