LET'S NOT FORGET

Because of FSU's solid young talent, many forget that the Seminoles lost one of their starting guards after just the sixth game of the season. Junior guard LaQuinta Neely tore her ACL in practice on Dec. 9th and was lost for the season. The Tribe was also without Genesis Choice for the last 10 games. The junior post player suffered a severe high ankle injury in practice on February 3rd.

FSU IN POSTSEASON

While the Seminoles competed in their third postseason tournament in the last four years, the program's progress can be looked at in an even greater light. Prior to FSU's participation in the 2001 NCAA Tournament, FSU hadn't played in a postseason tournament since 1990-91 — a 10-year absence. So, this season will actually be FSU's third postseason appearance in the last 14 years! In all, FSU has played in four NCAA Tournaments and now three WNITs.

FSU IN THE NIT

This season marked the third time that FSU has participated in the women's NIT. Back in the 1982 season, the Seminoles finished as the runner-up in the National Women's Invitational Tournament — the program's first national tournament appearance. FSU defeated Pepperdine, 76-63, and BYU, 75-71, before falling 76-60 to champion Oregon. Back then, the tournament was called the NWIT and included just eight teams. The NWIT later went to 16 teams. The 1996 season was the last NWIT tournament and there was no tournament in 1997. In 1998, the tournament was brought back under the new name WNIT and in 1999, the field expanded to its current 32 teams.

FSU VS. TEAMS IN THE POSTSEASON

FSU faced just two teams in the regular season among the 32-team 2004 WNIT field. The Tribe swept Clemson and took a 65-58 win over South Florida for a 3-0 record vs. the foes. FSU faced eight teams that participated in the 2004 NCAA Tournament. In fact, 11 of the Seminoles' 14 regular-season losses this season came against those eight teams.

NOLES FACE CHAMPS AGAIN!

For the second straight season, FSU has faced the eventual national champion in the UConn Huskies and also played 2003 Final Four participant LSU. Not only did Florida State have the distinct honor to play two No. 1-ranked teams this season (Duke and UConn), but the Seminoles also faced three of the four top seeds from the 2003 NCAA Tournament in Duke, UConn and LSU.

1000-POINT PLATEAU

In the Duke game on January 5th, Tasheika Allen became the 18th player in FSU history to reach the 1000-point mark but only the third player to achieve this status as a three-year letterwinner. Lisa Foglio (1227) and Wanda Burns (1394) are the others. Allen finished her career with 1,229 points.

ALLEN, WILLIAMS EARN ACC HONORS

The Atlantic Coast Sports Writers Association announced the 2004 All-

ACC Women's Basketball teams March 3rd and for the third straight season, Florida State's Tasheika Allen was recognized. A 6-0 senior guard from Huntsville, Ala., Allen earned second team honors for the second straight year, while freshman Shante Williams garnered honorable mention All-ACC honors and was named to the five-player All-Freshman Team. During the season, Allen earned ACC Player of the Week honors once while Williams was a three-time winner of ACC Rookie of the Week.

WHO WILL SCORE?

It was hard to say who the hero would be when the Seminoles played. Seven different Seminoles scored in double figures in FSU's last five games. Overall, eight different Seminoles led the Tribe in scoring, including five different players in the last six games. Tasheika Allen led the way, being the scoring leader in 12 games.

BEST EVER

Senior Lauren Bradley has had the best season of her career. Perhaps the healthiest of her time at Florida State, Bradley scored more points and grabbed more rebounds this year than any previous season. She averaged a career-high 22.8 minutes per game, topping her 18.5 mpg as a freshman. She had just 13 career starts heading into the year and started 25 games this season.

LINNEA FOR THREE!

Junior Linnea Liljestrand scored a season-high 18 points in 22 minutes in the season-finale at Richmond. Even more impressive, however, was that Liljestrand went 6-for-9 from three-point range, helping the Tribe set a new FSU single-game record for three-pointers with 12. Liljestrand also had luck from beyond the arc with 11 points, including three three-pointers, in just 10 minutes of play in the win at UVA. She was nearly perfect, going 4-for-5 from the field, including 3-for-3 from beyond the arc.

HEADS UP!

The other four Seminoles on the court really had to be attentive because it was hard tellin' when point guard Shante Williams was going to throw the ball. And that was a good thing. Williams averaged a team-high 5.1 assists per game which ranked second in the ACC.

ANOTHER FIRST

The Seminoles' win at Virginia on February 22nd marked Florida State's first EVER win in Charlottesville. Prior to the 2000-01 season, the Seminoles were 0-20 all-time vs. UVA. Over the last four seasons, the Tribe has beaten the Cavaliers four times.

DISHIN' IT OUT

Shante Williams averaged a team-high 5.1 assists per game which ranked second in the ACC. She had five or more assists in 20 games, including 15 of the last 17 games.

G-MONEY WAS ON THE MONEY

Sophomore Ganiyat Adeduntan scored a season-high 13 points in the win at South Alabama. The wing player shot 50 percent from the field (4-8) and from three-point range (2-4) and was a perfect 3-for-3 from the free throw line. She also contributed five rebounds, which tied for the second most she's had in a single game all season. Adeduntan scored in double figures in four games this season.

REACHING HIGH

Sophomore Hannah Linqvist made the most of her career-high 16 minutes of play in the season-opener vs. Savannah State. The post player, who scored in four games this season, set her career-high with eight rebounds in FSU's win over Savannah State.

PIERCE WAS FIERCE

Rookie post Ronalda Pierce scored in double figures for the sixth time this season when she had 11 points in the win at South Alabama. She also had two blocks, giving her 21 on the year which ranked second only to senior Lauren Bradley's 29.

CAREER-HIGH

Shante Williams led FSU with 19 points in the WNIT win at South Alabama and she made a career-high nine field goals in the process. The rookie scored

15 of FSU's 19 points during one stretch. Williams also had a team-high eight rebounds on the night, marking the third time this season at she has led the team in both scoring and rebounding in a single game. She led the team in scoring six times.

SWATTIN' IT AWAY

Ronalda Pierce recorded a career-high six blocks to go with her eight rebounds in the Maryland game. Pierce ranked second on the team with 21 blocks and had eight or more rebounds four times this season.

FINDING HER PLACE

Sophomore guard Holly Johnson was utilized in a number of ways this season. In the last 10 games, however, it seemed she really found her place. At UNC, Johnson played a season-high 34 minutes after seeing just 11 minutes of action vs. Georgia Tech in the game before. Including that game, Johnson averaged 27.0 minutes per game over the last 11 contests, well above her 19.9 mpg overall.

FSU'S DOUBLE-DOUBLES

FSU had four double-doubles this season by four different players.

- Genesis Choice – 18 pts, 11 rbs vs. Troy State (2nd career)
- Shante Williams – 14 pts, 10 rbs at Clemson (1st career)
- Trinetta Moore – 13 pts, 11 rbs vs. Clemson (3rd career)
- Lauren Bradley – 18 pts, 10 rbs at Maryland (1st career)

PULL IT DOWN

FSU outrebounded its opponents in 16 games this season, including seven ACC games. FSU tied its opponent in rebounding in three games, including two ACC opponents. The Tribe's biggest margin this season has been by 34 boards in the win over Troy State.

LITTLE GIANT

Shante Williams recorded a career-high 12 rebounds to lead all players in the win over Wake Forest. The 12 boards is a season-best for the entire team as well. The rookie, all 5-7 of her, ranked second on the team at 5.4 rebounds per game. She led the team in rebounding a team-high eight times.

TWICE THE ICE

In two straight games, freshman Alicia "Ice" Gladden led the team in scoring. She more than doubled her season average (5.2) when she scored a career-high 13 points to lead FSU in the

in the last four years under Sue Semrau's direction. FSU has finished .500 or better in the ACC three times. FSU has finished a program best fourth in the ACC twice in the past four years.

ACC HONORS ALLEN

Tasheika Allen was named the Atlantic Coast Conference Player of the Week, league officials announced Monday, Jan. 19th. Allen had an amazing week, averaging 23.0 points and 4.5 rebounds to guide FSU's to two wins the previous week. The guard shot 59 percent (13-22) from the field, 60 percent (6-10) from three point range and 93 percent (14-15) from the free throw line. Allen becomes the second Seminole to earn ACC honors in as many weeks. The previous week, Shante Williams earned ACC Co-Rookie of the Week.

ACC HONORS WILLIAMS — THREE TIMES!

#1 — Shante Williams earned ACC Co-Rookie of the Week honors on Jan. 12, as she led FSU with averages of 16.0 points, 8.5 rebounds, 4.5 assists and 4.0 steals in FSU's two ACC road games the previous week. The point guard scored a career-high 18 points in 25 minutes of play and grabbed seven rebounds at No. 1 Duke. At Clemson, she recorded her first career double-double with 14 points and 10 rebounds while also adding a team-high six assists and a team-high five steals and committing just one turnover in a team-high 31 minutes of play. Williams shot 40 percent from the field in the two games and was 11-for-12 from the free throw line for 92 percent.

#2 — After leading the Seminoles to two victories the past week, including an 80-74 win over No. 2 Duke, Shante Williams was named the ACC Women's Basketball Rookie of the Week on February 9. It was the second such honor for Williams this season. Williams averaged a team-high 16.0 points, 5.5 rebounds, 7.0 assists and 2.5 steals in last week's wins and shot 63 percent from the field and 64 percent from the free throw line. Against Duke, the Jacksonville, Fla., native led Florida State with 20 points, which tied her career high, five rebounds, eight assists and three steals. The win snapped the Blue Devils' 51-game ACC winning streak. Williams followed that up with a strong performance in the win over Clemson, turning in 12 points, six rebounds and six assists. The Seminoles never trailed in the game vs. the Tigers and completed the sweep of Clemson with the victory.

#3 — Shante Williams earned her third ACC Rookie of the Week honor on February 23 after helping to guide the

Seminoles to two ACC wins. While averaging 32.0 minutes per game, Williams averaged 11.0 points, 8.0 rebounds and 6.3 assists while shooting 41 percent from the field in FSU's three games. The floor leader scored 18 huge points, including 16 in the second half, to help FSU to its first win ever at Virginia.

TAKE IT AWAY SHANTE

Shante Williams had 26 or more steals than any other Seminole this season. She recorded five steals in three different games this season.

BLOCK IT TO 'EM

Lauren Bradley recorded a career-high four blocks in the win over Clemson and she had a team and career-high 29 blocks on the year. Bradley recorded 20 or more blocks in three of her four seasons at FSU.

HOT SHOTS

Florida State shot 50 percent or better in nine games this season, including an impressive 63 percent vs. Harvard. The Seminoles shot 44 percent on the season - tying their best for a season (also shot 44 percent in 1999-2000) under Sue Semrau. Semrau-coached teams have shot 40 percent or better over the past seven years.

TOSS IT OVER

FSU averaged 13.5 assists per game this season and had double-digit assists in 24 games including 19 of the last 21 games. The Seminoles recorded two games of 20 or more assists. FSU's 25 assists in the season-opener was the most the Tribe has recorded since February 11, 2001. FSU has done it three times in the Sue Semrau era:

- 25 vs. Savannah State on 11/23/03
- 25 vs. Clemson on 12/16/97
- 25 at Maryland on 2/11/01

THAT'S MINE

FSU snagged 59 rebounds vs. Troy State, outrebounding the Trojans by 34. It was the most rebounds FSU had this season and the most since recording 64 in a triple overtime win vs. Wake Forest on Feb. 2, 2003.

WOW!

- No. 2 Duke was the highest ranked opponent Florida State has ever beaten. The Tribe defeated Duke, 71-69, back on February 8, 2001 when the Blue Devils were ranked No. 4 and defeated No. 3 Maryland, 68-61, on January 12, 1993 in Tallahassee.
- The win over Duke snapped the Blue Devils 51-ACC game winning streak. In fact, two of Duke last three league losses have come at the hands of the

win over Wake Forest. She nearly tripled it when she bettered that mark with a new career-high 15 points at NC State. Gladden scored in double figures in three games this season. Another thing that doubled was Gladden's minutes played. She went into the Wake Forest game averaging 17.2 minutes per game and including that game, averaged 25.0 minutes per game in the last six contests.

JUST SHY AGAIN

With 22 points, Tasheika Allen was well on her way to a new career-high before being sidelined with an ankle sprain with nine minutes left vs. North Carolina on Senior Night. Six times this season, Allen finished just five or fewer points shy of her career high of 26 points. She scored 20 or more points eight times this season and 18 times in her career.

THE WIN TOTAL

FSU's 7-9 ACC record marked just the fourth time since joining the league that FSU has earned seven or more conference wins, including the third time

Seminoles.

- The win over Duke snapped FSU's 19-game losing streak vs. ranked opponents.
- FSU's win over Duke stopped the Blue Devils' streak of ACC road wins at 20 and stopped its streak of road wins overall at 24.

GIVE ME FIVE

Led by Shante Williams' 20 points, five Seminoles reached double figures in scoring, for just the third time this season, in the win over No. 2 Duke. The other games were also wins — vs. Savannah State and Harvard.

DECISIVE WIN

FSU's 38-point win over Troy State was the Tribe's 15th win of 30 or more points since Sue Semrau took over the program in 1997-98. It was Semrau's fifth-largest victory, by margin, of her career. Semrau's first win of 25 points or more was vs. Georgia Tech. In fact, she has two of them to her credit.

ROCKIN' TO THE 80s

FSU reached the 80+ point mark in seven wins overall this season. FSU scored 80 or more points in three wins last season, but none were ACC games. FSU's 82-80 OT loss to Virginia was the team's only loss when scoring 80+ points. The 80 points in the win over No. 2 Duke ties for the second most points the Seminoles have ever scored against the Blue Devils. Overall, FSU has scored 80 or more points vs. Duke three times and is 2-1 in those ball games. On the flip side, Duke, at that time, was 0-2 this season when giving up 80 or more points.

UNSUNG HERO

Ganiyat Adeduntan, who was a quiet contributor all season long, played 22 minutes in the win over No. 2 Duke with her main job being to guard Alana Beard. It was the most minutes Adeduntan had played since the Tribe's first meeting with Duke on January 5th.

NICE SHOT

FSU's .574 shooting in the Duke win was the Tribe's best performance in an ACC game this season and second only to shooting .627 in the Harvard win. It was also the best shooting performance a team had vs. Duke this season. Prior to the game vs. FSU, the Duke defense had allowed just one team to shoot 50 percent against them and that was Purdue who shot exactly 50 percent but fell 93-63. At the time of the win, FSU had also scored more points against Duke this season than any other ACC opponent.

HOLLY HAD A DAY

Sophomore Holly Johnson scored a season-high 14 points, just one shy of her

career high, to lead the team at Georgia Tech. She made a career-high four three-pointers in the game. Johnson had scored just 20 points all season long heading into the Georgia Tech game.

IMPRESSIVE SHOOTING

Florida State shot a season-high 63 percent in the Harvard game which ranks second for best shooting performances in the Sue Semrau era. FSU shot 64 percent vs. Austin Peay on Dec. 2, 2001. The Tribe shot 57 percent in the two games of the Seminole Classic. Genesis Choice led the way in the tournament with 71 percent shooting (12-17).

ABOUT THE WIN OVER SAVANNAH STATE

- FSU held Savannah State to just three first half points (54-3), setting a new NCAA record for fewest points in a half by a Division I team. The previous mark was eight points by Liberty on Jan. 27, 2001.
- With 107 points, FSU reached the 100-point plateau for the first time since December 19, 1999 when FSU won 102-70 at Loyola-Chicago.
- It was the first time FSU scored 100 or more points at home since a 112-101 overtime loss to North Carolina on December 5, 1998.
- The 107 points is the third most points an FSU women's basketball team has ever scored and the 22nd 100-point game in FSU women's basketball history. It is also the most points FSU has scored under the reign of Sue Semrau.
- It marked the most points FSU has scored in a season opener in program history. The previous mark in a season-opener was 100 points vs. Central Michigan on November 25, 1988. It was the second most points FSU has scored in a home opener as the Seminoles topped Marquette 110-75 on Dec. 1, 1990.
- The 79-point margin of victory ranks as the second largest in program history.

DEFENSE HOLD 'EM

As noted, an NCAA record was set when FSU held Savannah State to just three first half points. The 28 points Savannah State finished with is also noteworthy. That total is not only the

fewest points FSU has allowed in the Sue Semrau era (since 1997-98), but it's also the fewest since holding West Florida to just 16 points in an 84-point win back in the 1975-76 season.
