The Blue Devils, two-time defending NCAA Division I champs, have the lowest player-growth figures in the women's top 100.

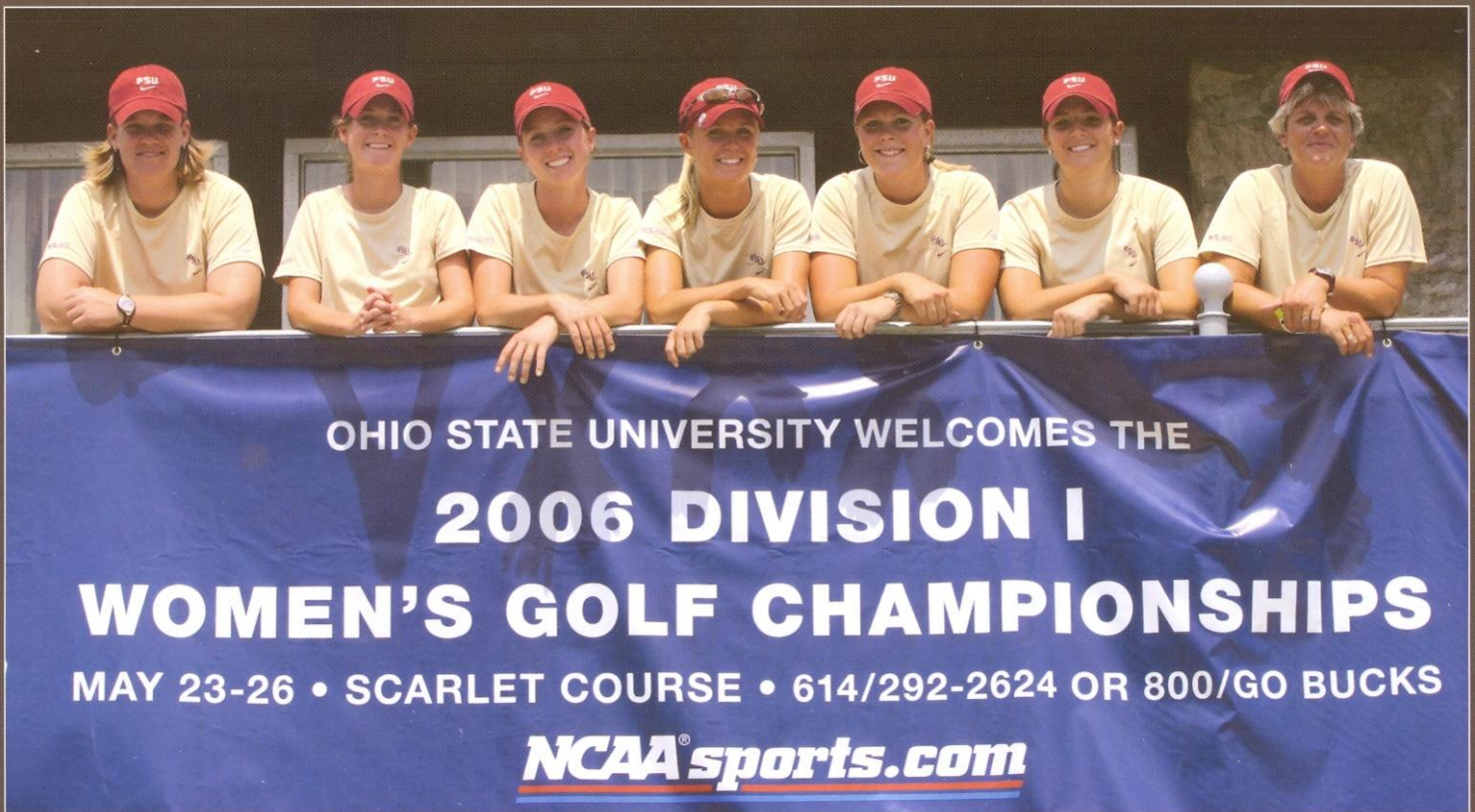


Playing at Ohio State means cold winters, but the Buckeyes share our top coaches/facilities score for women with Duke.
