All-America First-Team in 2006 and 2007 by the National Golf Coaches' Association and GolfWeek Magazine and All-America Second-Team in 2008 by the NGCA and GolfWeek... also won the honor of being named to the All-ACC team for the third time in 2008 – she is the first golfer in school history to earn All-ACC honors as a freshman, sophomore and junior... has competed in the NCAA Championship finals in each of her three seasons as a Seminole – 2006 with her teammates and 2007 and 2008 as an individual... won the individual title at the Women's World Amateur Championship in South Africa in 2006... helped Sweden to a second place finish in the team standings at the 2006 World Amateur Championships... led Sweden to a second-place finish at the European Ladies Team Championship at the Castelconturbia Golf Club in Italy in 2007... finished in third place at the 2007 British Amateur Open... earned five top-five individual finishes as a sophomore – first at the Liz Murphey Collegiate Classic, second at the Lady Gamecock Invitational, tied for second at the Ryder/Florida Championship, tied for third at the NCAA East Regional Championship and fourth in the ACC Championship as a freshman and seven top five finishes as a sophomore – first at the Florida State hosted Chrysler Challenge, tied for first at the Lady Tar Heel Invitational, second at the Cougar Classic, second at the ACC Championship, third at the Lady Gator Invitational, tied for third at the Liz Murphey Collegiate Classic and tied for fifth at the NCAA East Regional Championship... finished in a career-best tied for 11th place at the 2007 NCAA Division I Women's Golf Championship at LPGA International in Daytona Beach, Fla... Westrups' finish in the

2007 national championship ranks as the highest finish for a Seminole individual in the NCAA Championship... finished in a tie for 13th place at the 2008 Division I Women's Golf Championship at the University of New Mexico Course... finished in 29th place at the 2006 NCAA Championship at the Scarlet Course at The Ohio State University... the 29th place finish is the lowest she has finished in an event during the first two years of her career... earned National Player of the Week honors by Golf Week Magazine on March 29, 2006 after earning medalist honors in the Liz Murphey Collegiate Classic... also named the Golf Week player of the Week on March 5, 2007 after her individual victory at the Florida State hosted Chrysler Challenge... Florida State's top individual finisher in all seven events during her freshman season, in the nine events she completed as a sophomore and in nine of the team events she competed with her team as a junior... was a cumulative total of 36 strokes over par during her ENTIRE freshman season... was a cumulative total of 30 strokes over par during her ENTIRE sophomore season... was a cumulative total of 51 strokes over par during her ENTIRE junior season... career-best single-round score of 66 has come four times - in the third round of the fall 2006 Cougar Classic, in the third round of the Northrup Gruman Regional Challenge in the spring of 2007, the first round of the ACC Championship during the spring of 2007 and in the third round of the UCF Challenge during the spring of 2008... her low 36 hole score of 138 came at the 2007 NCAA East Regional Championship with scores of 69-69-70 as she finished tied for fifth with an eight under par score of 208... her 208 score at the 2007 NCAA East Regional Championship and the spring 2008 LSU/Cleveland Golf Classic is the best tournament score of her career... counted 21.5 of her 22 single-round scores (.977 percent) toward the team score in her first season... counted had all 21 of her rounds (100 percent) toward the team score during her sophomore season... counted 30 of 30 rounds (100 percent) toward the team score during her junior season... has counted a full percentage since the third round of the 2006 ACC Championship - a total of 69 consecutive rounds counted... was celebrated by the Florida State University Department of Athletics as the torch on the Unconquered Statue in front of Doak Campbell Stadium was lit in her honor after she own the individual world championship...
