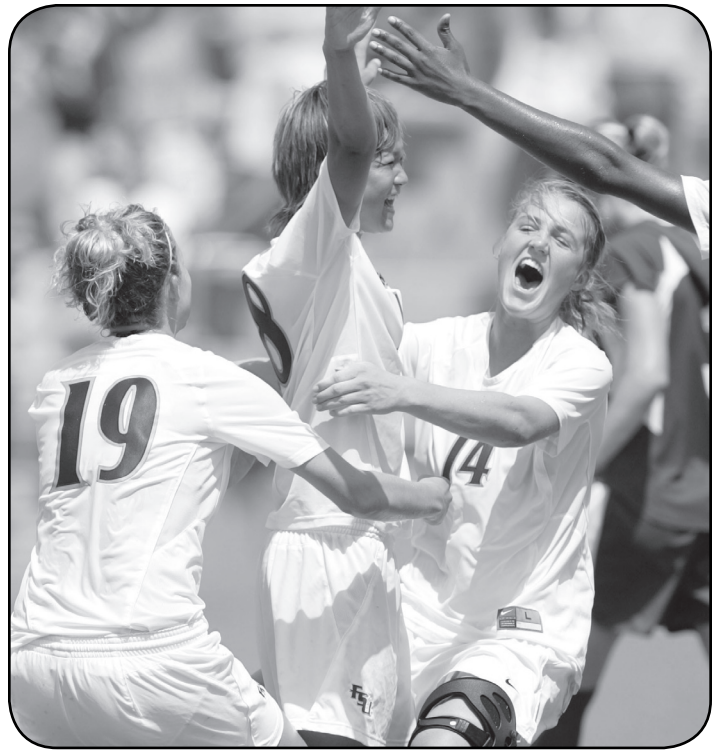

HOW TO COVER THE SEMINOLES

Members of the media will be provided with media guides, weekly releases and games notes. Updated individual and team stats will be available immediately following every match and games stories with a box score will be emailed, faxed and posted to the official athletic department web site at www.seminoles.com following each match. If you would like to be included on an email or fax release list, please contact Jason Leturmy. Media do not need to request credentials for regular season home matches and seating will be provided for any media covering FSU women's soccer games. However, credential requests and passes are required if Florida State hosts any NCAA Tournament matches. All home matches are played at the Seminole Soccer Complex (1,500). The complex is located just north of the FSU football practice field off of Stadium Drive.
