

## 2007 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Named Second-Team All-ACC, the first conference honor of her career.
- Led the team with a career-best .340 batting average that ranked eighth in the ACC.
- Ranked in the top five on the team in five offensive categories.
- Put together a career-long seven game hitting streak at the start of March.


