#### 2007 Track — Outdoor

- Earned All-American honors racing the third leg of the fourth-place 4x400m relay team at the NCAA Championships with a time of 3:31.10.
- Part of the 4x400m team at the ACC Championships that finished with a 3:32.11, setting a conference meet record.
- Ran the third leg of the ACC Champion 4x400m relay team.
- Also competed in the 4x400m relay at the NCAA East Regionals.
- Finished with a time of 54.45 in the 400m at the ACC Championships.
- Awarded third-team Arthur Ashe Junior Sport Scholar for her work on the track and in the classroom.
- Finalist for the John Wooden Cup for academics and community service.

#### Indoor

- Part of the ACC Championship-winning 4x400m relay team with a time of 3:41.55.
- Best 4x400m relay time came at the Tyson Invite, with a 3:41.01 to provisionally qualify.
- Clocked a 400m time of 56.82 at the New Balance Invite.

#### 2006 Track — Outdoor

- Competed in the 4x400m relay preliminaries at the NCAA Championships.
- Ran the third leg of the 4x400m relay at the NCAA East Regionals for second place with a new FSU top-10 time of 3:31.43.
- Regionally qualified in the open 400m and as a leg of the 4x400m relay.
- Ran a lifetime-best 54.24 in the 400m at the Reebok Invitational.

- Ran the third leg of the team's top-two 1600m relays.
- Quartet of Alycia Williams, Alyce Williams, Batchelor and Evelyne-Cynthia Niako finished in 3:34.58 at the Texas Relays.
- One of 15 regional qualifiers on the women's team.
- Entering the Reebok Invitational, had a season-best 55.69 in the 400m.
- Earned All-ACC honors as the third leg of the winning 1600m relay.
- Shaved more than two seconds off her personal-best 400m mark of 56.74 entering the season.
- Participated in the 4x100m and 4x200m relays.

#### Indoor

- Had season-best 7.67 in the 55m dash at the Pepsi Invite.
- Raced a season-best 400m dash at the ACC Championships and placed 12th in the prelims (56.61).
- Ran 59.66 in the 400m dash at the Lobo Invite.

#### 2005 Track — Outdoor

- Was an integral part of the sprint group, running the 200m, 400m and 4x400m relay events.
- Ran season-best times of 25.19 in the 200m and 56.74 in the 400m.
- Finished in the top-20 runners at the Georgia Tech Invitational in the 200m with a clip of 25.19.
- Posted a then-season-best mark of 25.30 at the Seminole Twilight for 11th place.
- Was 21st in the 200m preliminary race at the Atlantic Coast Conference Championship.
- Alternate leg of the 4x400m relay that finished in second place at the league championships.



#### Indoor

- Ran a season-best 26.12 in the 200m at the Atlantic Coast Conference Championships.
- Finished in 14th place at the Clemson Opener.
- Ran a 26.29 at the Gator Invitational and 27.13 at the Florida Intercollegiate Championships, both in the 200m.
- Season-best time in the 400m of 58.57 came at the league championships meet.

- Garnered All-ACC honors a first by an FSU women's runner since 2003 by placing sixth at the conference meet with a 6k time of 21:20.2.
- Ran the fastest 5k time of the year, 16:52, as she took second at the Notre Dame Invitational.
- Finished second on the team with a 6k time of 21:08.1 at the NCAA Pre-National meet.



#### 2006 Track — Outdoor

- One of two freshman NCAA Regional qualifiers, taking part in the 1500m.
- Fastest freshman in the ACC and the NCAA East Region as well as the fifth-speediest rookie in the nation.
- Second on the FSU all-time top 5000m performers list with a 16:20.30 at the Stanford Invitational.
- Finished eighth in the 1500m (4:27.79) and 12th in the 800m (2:11.50) at the ACC Championships.
- Won the 3000m at the FSU Relays, running a 9:49.87.

#### 2007 Track — Outdoor

- Advanced to the NCAA Championships for the first time in her career, taking part in the 10,000m.
- Ran the second-fastest 10,000m time in school history, with a personal-best 33:56.38 at the Stanford Invitational; mark was also the seventh-best in the ACC.
- Turned in a personal-best 16:44.29 in the 5000m to take sixth at the ACC Championships.
- Took 24th at the NCAA East Region meet, turning in a time of 17:05.64 in the 5000m.
- Held the number six spot in the 10,000m, crossing the line in 34.37.04.
- Had the fastest 3000m time on the team, posting a personal-best 9:39.23 to take ninth at the Penn Relays.
- Won the 3000m at the Seminole Invitational, crossing the line in 9:41.62.

#### Indoor

- Scored points in a pair of races at the ACC Championships.
- Took seventh in the 3000m with a 9:45.00.
- Finished a spot back in the 5000m, crossing the finish line in 16:57.18.
- Ran an eighth-place, 17:08.99 5000m at the Tyson Invitational.

#### 2006 Cross Country

- Broke her personal best in the 5k by seven seconds (17:46) to finish 54th at the Notre Dame Invitational.
- Had her best 6k time, 21:40.7, at the NCAA Pre-Nationals.
- Ran a 22:17.1 to finish second on the team at the NCAA Championships.
- Came in fifth on the team with an 18:45.98 in her FSU debut during the 5k Covered Bridge Open.

• Posted a 22:25.1 in the 6k at the NCAA South Region Championships to rate fifth on the squad and 37th overall.

#### 2006 Track (Vanderbilt) — Outdoor

• Did not compete.

#### Indoor

- Opened the season running the 3000m at the Kentucky Invitational, finishing with a time of 10:43.
- Placed 21st in the 3000m at the Tyson Invitational with a time of 10:12.68.

#### 2005 Track (Vanderbilt) — Outdoor


- Opened the season with promise before injuries sidelined competition.

#### 2004 Track (Vanderbilt) — Outdoor

- Won the 3000m at the Vanderbilt Invitational in 10:07.25, the 10th-fastest time ever by a Commodore.
- Captured the 3000m title at the Vanderbilt Invitational in 10:07.25.
- Concluded the season with a low time of 17:33 for 5000m at the SEC Championships.
- Effort was the ninth-fastest in school history.
- Ran a 1500m personal best of 4:41.00 at the Ole Miss Invitational.

#### Indoor

- Posted a 5000m personal best of 17:28.72 at the lowa State Open, the fourth-fastest time in school history.
- Ran the fastest 3000m of the indoor season, finishing in 10:05.99 at the Tyson Invitational.
- Fastest indoor mile (5:08.15) came at Ohio State Invitational.

#### 2003 Cross Country (Vanderbilt)

- Finished either second or third on the team in all seven meets.
- Finished 20th at the NCAA Regional, posting a 21:35 that was the ninth-fastest in school history.
- Took 18th overall at the SEC Championships.
- Third-best freshman at the SEC Championships.
