

Lucy McDaniel Arena at Tully Gymnasium

Tully Gymnasium has been home to Florida State volleyball over the years. Overall, Tully Gym has been good to the Lady Seminoles as they have accumulated a 255-89 record on its home court for a winning percentage of .741 in the past 25 years in the facility.

The facility, which was constructed in 1956, was named for the late Robert Henry (Bobby) Tully, a 1952 FSU graduate who played football. Active on campus, Tully was a member of the Gold Key, ODK, the Arnold Air Society and Alpha Tau Omega fraternity. He died in May 1954 after battling a long illness.

The 2,500 capacity gymnasium has undergone several renovations in recent years. Just prior to the 1999 season, the playing floor was resurfaced and repainted and new lighting was added. The new facility features arena-style padded seating with armrests which were installed to create a movie theater experience while watching the Lady Seminoles.

On November 2, 2000 in a special ceremony, Florida State dedicated the Tully Gym volleyball floor to Lucy McDaniel, the first woman in the state of Florida to donate more than one million dollars to a women's athletics program. Beginning this season at volleyball matches, the facility will be known as the Lucy McDaniel Volleyball Arena at volleyball events in Tully Gymnasium, in honor of the wonderful gifts and support that McDaniel has provided to the Lady Seminole volleyball program and Florida State athletics.

The ceremony included an address from Athletic Director Dave Hart, as well as an appearance by University President, Sandy D'Alemberte. Reynaud said a few words regarding the magnificent gift, which was followed by a touching tribute by FSU volleyball players Kristin Frye and Martha Hamilton. Frye presented McDaniel with a ball signed by all the players followed by a poem written by Hamilton about the relationship of the 2000 squad with McDaniel.

McDaniel first gave \$100,000 to endow a volleyball scholarship at Florida State and later designated another \$50,000 so the team could take a European tour in May of 2000. McDaniel wanted to do more, so she asked her accountant to run through her financial statements to see what she would be able to gift now and later in her will. When the accountant told her, she called Seminole Boosters Planned Giving Director Joel Padgett to start the process.

In addition to the always exciting Atlantic Coast Conference schedule, the 2001 Florida State home schedule is highlighted by two tournaments. The Tallahassee Democrat/Lady Seminole Classic, a five-team tournament featuring FSU, Louisiana-Lafayette, Massachusetts, Bethune-Cookman and Manhattan College, kicks off the home season. Tully Gym will also have the chance to host this year's ACC Tournament.
