WEISSING BREAKS SCHOOL DIG RECORD

Senior libero Summer Weissing had been working towards the school's all-time digs record and after four years was able to accomplish it. She concluded the 2006 season with 1,379 digs and in third place all-time at FSU. In her final season against ACC opponent Boston College, the 13-year old record set up Luiza Ramos was broken after Weissing had 14 digs to jump to 1,775. Weissing finished her career with 1,859 career digs.

ALL-ACC SELECTIONS

For the first time since the 2000 season, Florida State had two athletes make the All-ACC teams. Junior Mira Djuric received first team honors after leading the league with 83 service aces and ranking fourth in the country with 0.73 aces per game. Earning second team accolades was senior Makini Thompson who was a first team All-ACC member in 2006.

BARRY NAMED TO ALL-ACC ACADEMIC TEAM

Sophomore middle blocker Brianna Barry repeated in 2007 and was once again named to the All-ACC Academic Team. The sports management major had a stel-

lar year on the court this season, leading the Seminoles with 97 blocks in 111 games. She was also fourth in the ACC at season's end with a .333 attacking percentage.

SEMINOLES FINISH FIFTH IN ACC

For the second consecutive season, Florida State finished with a 16-14 overall record and a 13-9 record in the ACC to finish fifth in the conference. At the conclusion of the ACC schedule, the Seminoles fought back in October to win six-straight matches before falling to No. 14 Duke 3-2.

ACC RANKINGS

Sophomore Mira Djuric was named ACC Player of the Week on September 18 as she helped lead the Seminoles to a 3-0 sweep over rival Miami. The Seminoles ranked first in service aces (113), third in the ACC in hitting percentage (.236), fifth in assists (113) and fourth in kills (113) in the conference. Individually, Djuric led the conference in service aces (83), service aces per game (0.73) and ranked fourth in the ACC in total points (554.5). Sophomore Brianna Barry also ranked fourth in the ACC in hitting percentage (.333).

DJURIC MAKES BIG IMPACT ON SEMINOLE OFFENSE

From the moment she hit the court as a Seminole, Oregon transfer Mira Djuric dominated at the outside hitter position. Averaging 3.88 kills a game, the junior from Belgrade, Serbia, led Florida State with 438 kills on the season. Djuric also jumped to the number two spot in the records books with 83 service aces and was the only Seminole to be ranked in the NCAA for service aces per game in 2007.

NCAA RANKINGS

Sophomore Mira Djuric ranked fifth in the NCAA in aces per game (.73), leading the Seminoles to a 19th ranking in the NCAA in aces per game (2.10). The Seminoles were also ranked 84th in the final RPI.

FSU RANKINGS

Senior Summer Weissing set the Florida State school record for digs with 1,859 digs during her four-year career. Sophomore Mira Djuric also finished ninth in school history in kills per game (3.88) and seventh in school history in service aces (83).

A DOZEN DOUBLE-DOUBLES IN 2007

For the second straight year the Seminoles posted double-doubles 12 times. In 2007 it was three players that contributed: starting setter Nikki Bakker, Mira Djuric and Lauren Rosenthal. Sophomore Baker led the season with eight double dips, while Djuric had three and freshman setter Rosenthal notching one. Baker also recorded double-doubles against ACC opponent North Carolina in both meetings this year.

SEMINOLES 'DIG' FOR A CURE

Following the success from 2006, the Seminoles again participated in the "Dig for the Cure" event which raises money for Breast Cancer research. This year, FSU chose its televised match against Georgia Tech on October 5, with all proceeds benefiting the North Florida Susan G. Komen For The Cure Affiliate. The team raised over \$1300 for the event in 2007.

BACK-TO-BACK FSU INVITATIONAL CHAMPIONS

The Seminoles walked away with the tournament crown for the second straight year at the FSU Invitational on August 25. The Garnet and Gold swept UNC Asheville, 3-0, and downed TCU 3-1 to claim the title on Lucy McDaniel Court in Tully Gymnasium.

SPRING TOURNAMENT CHAMPS

The Florida State Volleyball team defeated the College of Charleston in the championship game to win the College of Charleston Spring Tournament on March 29-30. The Seminoles swept both the indoor and outdoor titles, as sophomores Brianna Barry and Nikki Baker won the beach tournament on Saturday. The Seminoles downed Charleston Southern, North Florida and Coastal Carolina in previous rounds to claim the tournament title.

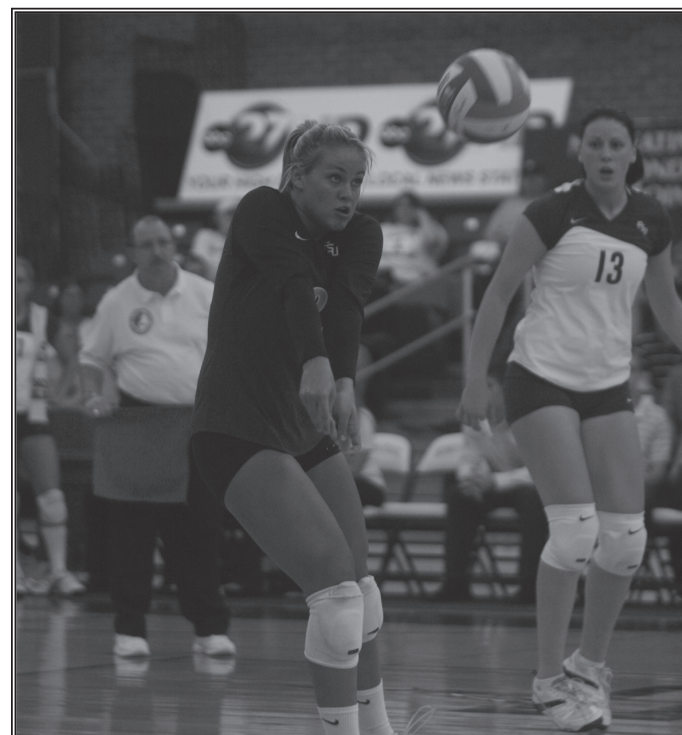

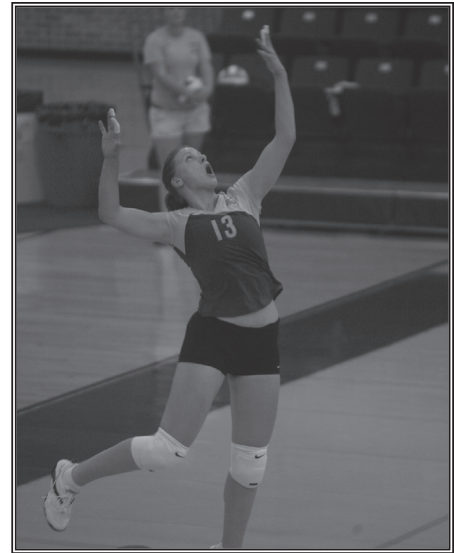
