FROM THE PRESS BOX

This evening the Seminoles take on Louisiana-Monroe hoping to even their record at 1-1 after the loss last week to Boise State.

First, thanks to those of you who rearranged schedules and were in the stands last week after the game moved from Jacksonville. Drawing over 50,000 fans for the game was impressive. The unique ticket price had something to do with that, and it was nice to see so many children in the stands in particular.

Secondly, thanks for being in the stands here tonight. It is so important that we support our team.

So, this message about the ACC Network may only come into play for you when the Seminoles are playing too far from home to be there in person.

The launch last month of the ACC Network was over nine years in the making for the ACC Office, the university presidents as well as the athletic directors who have been on the front line. It was far from a forgone conclusion that our league, though arguably the best top to bottom in the country, would end up with its own network on ESPN no less. It took real hard work, strategic planning, tough negotiating and many other factors, but most importantly it took schools, like FSU, whose athletic programs are so exceptional and attractive that they essentially earned their own network.

As of the season-opener last week, the ACC Network is in a staggering 48 million homes, and that is without Comcast or Cox cable — more on that in a moment. In comparison, the SEC Network is in 59 million homes and the Big Ten 55 million. The difference is the hay is in the barn so to speak for those leagues, while the ACC has yet to reel in the biggest fish in the cable TV sea.

The truth is that the ACC Network is precisely where the most optimistic projections predicted it would be if it launched in 2019. With Comcast's contract with ESPN not due for at least another year, their hesitation to join the ACC Network at this particular time is natural.

The question for Comcast customers, including all of us in Tallahassee, is if, and



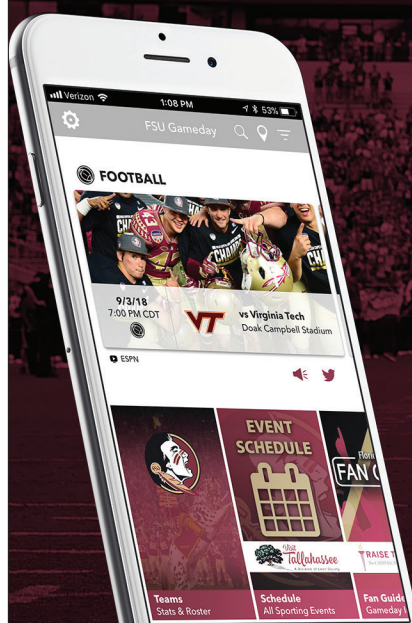
when, they will sign on? The answer to the former is simple. Yes, Comcast will carry the ACC Network. The answer to the latter may be up to ACC fans all over the country.

When Comcast senses enough demand for the ACC Network, they will sign on — simple as that. But precisely what level of demand triggers that move is known only to their executives. One thing we do know is the time is now for every Seminole fan, and those of all our league brethren, to make enough noise that Comcast hears them.

Sadly, the most effective measure ACC fans can take at this point is to drop off their Comcast box with the message that they are switching providers so they can get the ACC Network. It seems extreme and, frankly, is pretty extreme, because Comcast is a fantastic cable provider. But they need to know that for FSU fans at least; they are one channel short of satisfactory.

Heck, if we can put on a football game with three days notice and 50,000 of you come to cheer on your Seminoles, we can convince a cable company that watching FSU at Virginia next week is important, really important.
