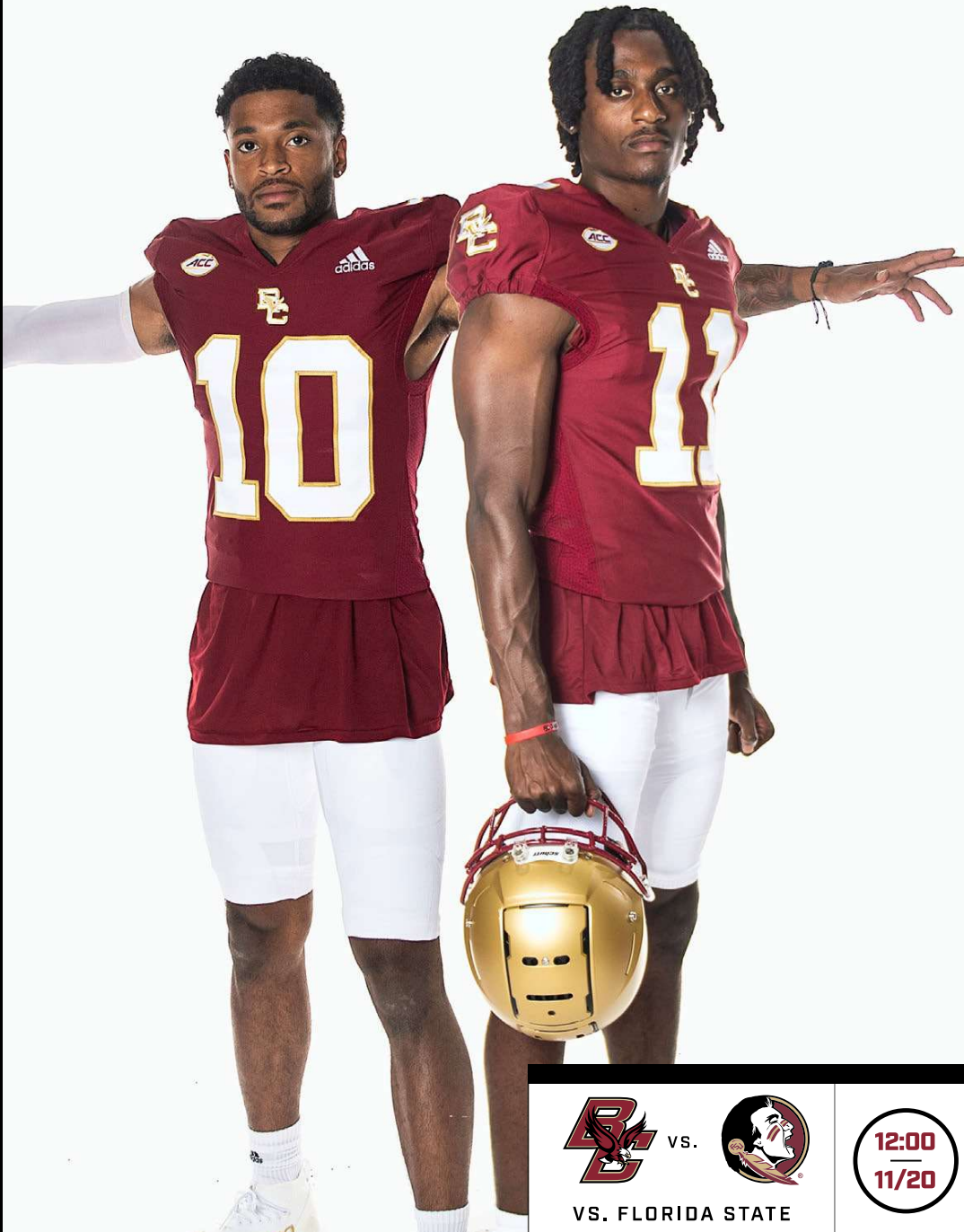

## BC VARSITY CLUB HALL OF FAME WEEKEND



- 2021 Inductees -

**Will Blackmon '06, Football**

A dynamic player in all three facets on the football field for Tom O'Brien's squad from 2002-2005, Will Blackmon was a three-time all-conference performer as a cornerback, kick returner and wide receiver. In his time with the Eagles, BC compiled 35-15 record with four bowl game appearances. Searching for another offensive weapon to receive targets from first-time starting quarterback Matt Ryan, Blackmon took on wide receiver snaps for the first time at the collegiate level as a senior for the 2005 season. He caught 51 passes for 763 yards and four touchdowns. He finished his career first all-time in kickoff returns (110) and kickoff return yardage (2,700) in BC history. Blackmon was drafted by the Green Bay Packers in 2006 to launch a 12-year NFL career that included a Super Bowl XLVI championship with the New York Giants.

**Tim Hasselbeck '00, Football**

An ultimate competitor and one of the most highly-recruited quarterbacks in New England, Tim Hasselbeck spent two seasons under center as the Boston College starter in 1999 and 2000. Hasselbeck was battle-tested through his first two seasons with the Eagles, facing tough competition within his position group, before winning the starting job as a junior. In his first season at the helm of the offense, Hasselbeck led BC to eight wins, a bowl appearance and a 31-29 upset at No. 25 Notre Dame. As a team captain in 2000, he guided the Eagles to a seven-win season, including the Aloha Bowl, and was named the team's Scanlan Award winner. Hasselbeck ranks 10th all-time in passing (3,980) and ninth in touchdowns (29) in BC history. Despite being an undrafted free agent, he went on to have an eight-year NFL career.

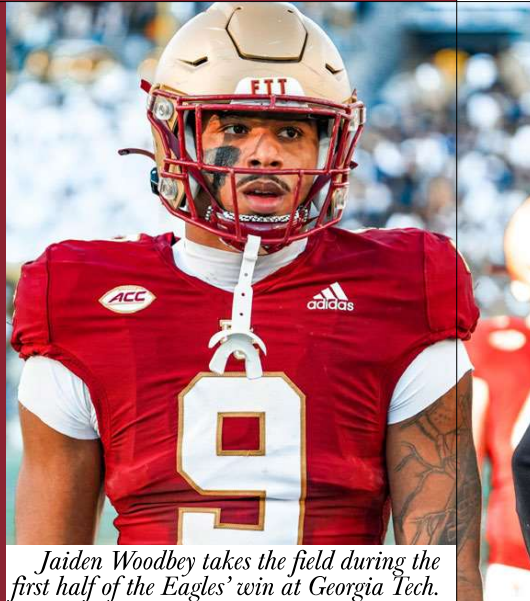

## WEEK11 NOTES: THE FLORIDA STATE GAME



The series between the two schools began in 1957 in Chestnut Hill as the Eagles came away with a 20-7 victory. FSU had won seven straight in the series before BC's 35-3 win in 2017 in Chestnut Hill. It was the largest margin of victory for BC in the series and the most points they have ever scored in a game against the Seminoles. BC strong safety Jaiden Woodbey faces his former school Saturday for the first time. Woodbey played three seasons for the Seminoles, including earning Freshman All-American honors from ESPN in 2018.

Phil Jurkovec accounted for five touchdowns – running for three and passing for two – and **BOSTON COLLEGE** beat Georgia Tech 41-30 to become bowl-eligible. Zay Flowers scored on receptions of 39 and 48 yards, and Pat Garwo ran for 104 yards.

**FLORIDA STATE** completed a fourth-quarter comeback to claim a 31-28 victory over rival Miami. Quarterback Jordan Travis had a 1-yard plunge with 26 seconds left for the winning touchdown. It was the second rushing TD of the day for Travis, who also threw for 274 yards.

## JEFF HAFLEY



**JEFF HAFLEY** was introduced as The Gregory P. Barber '69 and Family Head Coach of the Boston College football program on Dec. 14, 2019. In his first season on the Heights, Hafley finished with the most victories of any first-year head coach in college football in 2020.

The 36th head coach in Boston College history, Hafley led BC to a 6-5 season that included near upsets of No. 1 Clemson and No. 11 North Carolina.

More impressive than the marked improvement on both sides of the ball from Boston College in 2020 was how the program handled playing in the COVID-19 pandemic. BC's team had just one positive COVID-19 result in over 9,000 administered tests since the team returned to campus last June.

On the recruiting trail, Hafley and his staff signed the top recruiting class in school history in his first season. The recruiting class ranking by ESPN was the best in school history since their rankings began in 2006. It was BC's best showing in the 247 Sports rankings as well and the Eagles' highest Rivals ranking since 2008.

Hafley, one of college football's top defensive minds, helped improve a BC defense 52 spots in the national rankings in total defense as the Eagles allowed 62 fewer yards per game than the previous year prior to his arrival.

Nine Eagles were named All-ACC in 2020, including the first wide receiver to be named All-ACC First-Team in Zay Flowers since 2012.

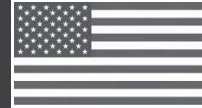

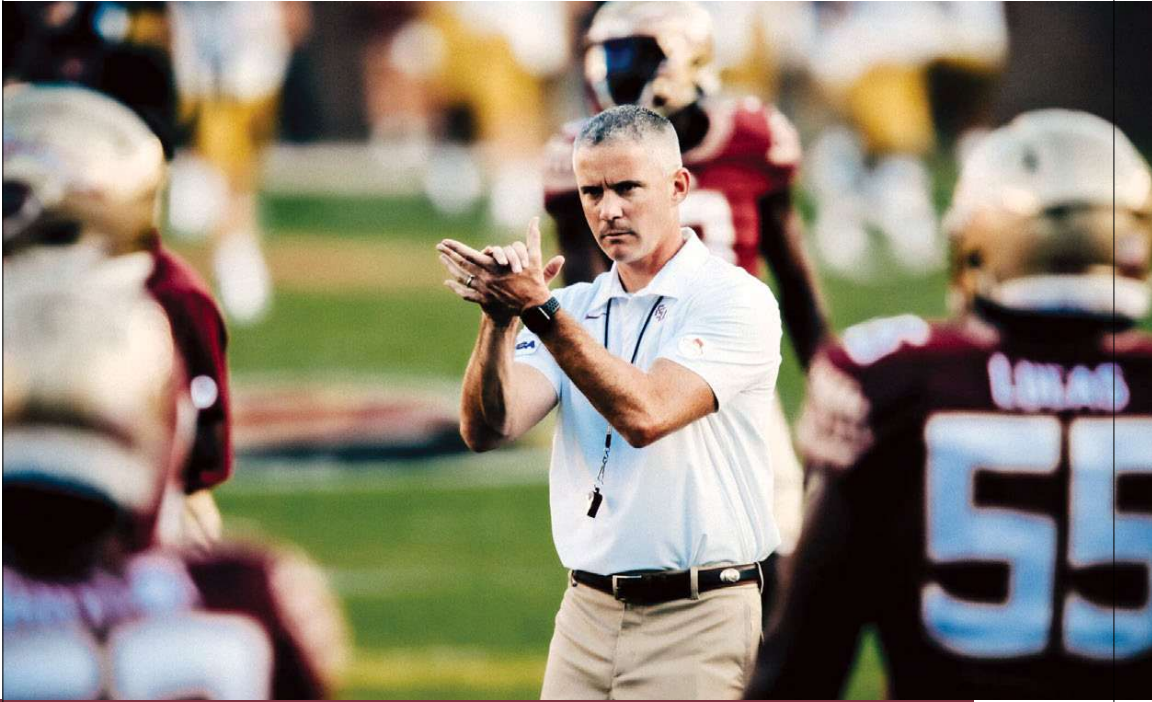

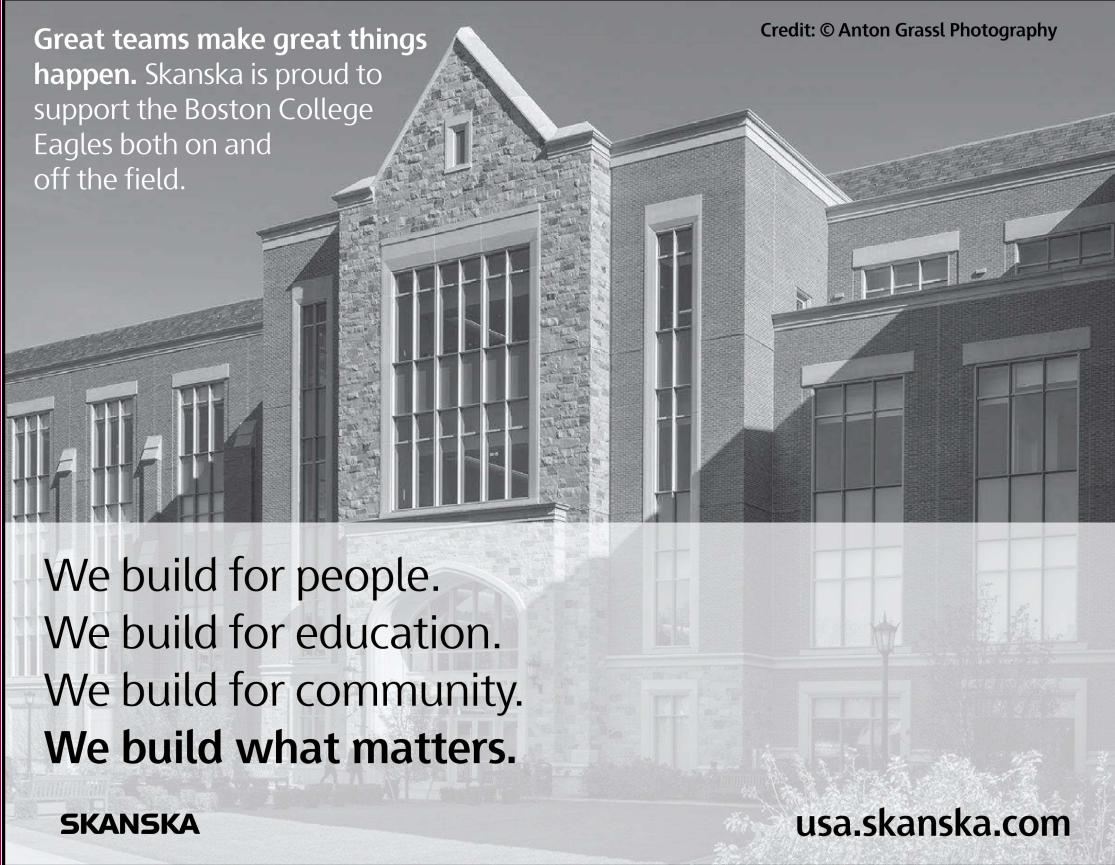
