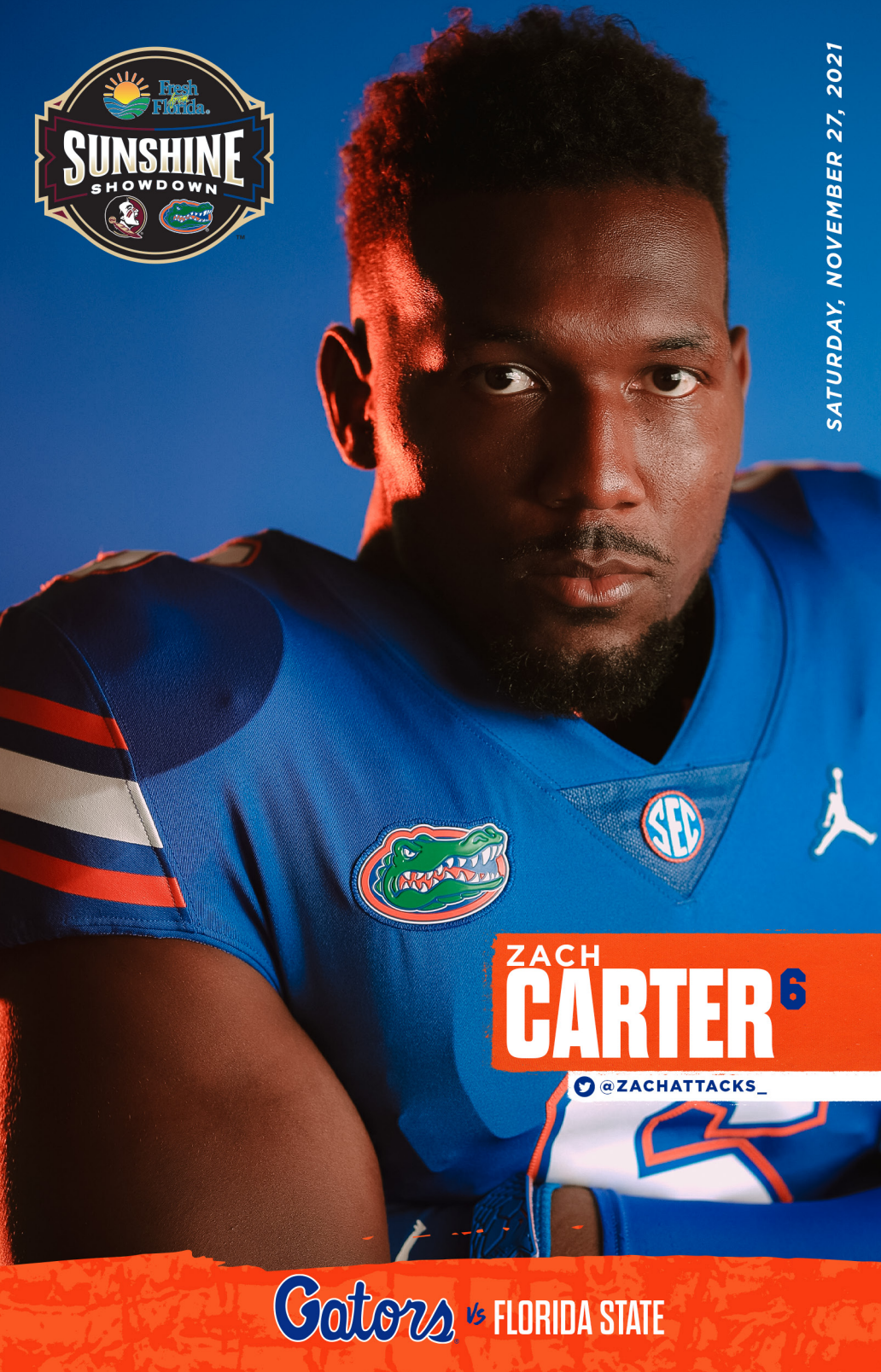

Florida Football Gameday Information



## PARKING & TRAFFIC

Public parking lots are limited around the Stadium. Lots that are not reserved, are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Visit [FloridaGators.com/Parking](http://FloridaGators.com/Parking) for details. As always, parking over sidewalks is NOT permitted, and cars are at risk of being towed. Utilizing the Gator Aider Shuttle service by RTS could help save time and avoid searching for a parking space in the lots. For additional information regarding parking, see Park & Ride (Shuttles) below.

Please have your digital parking pass available upon entering designated lot. Please display your parking pass at all times. Decal restrictions are lifted on campus in non-reserved lots only. A vehicle may only take up one space. The UAA is not responsible for any lost or stolen items. Three hours prior to kickoff, no traffic is permitted on Gale Lemerand Drive from University Avenue to Stadium Road and on Stadium Road from Gale Lemerand Drive to the Florida Gym.

## PARK & RIDE (SHUTTLES)

Save time and avoid searching for a parking space by utilizing the Gator Aider Shuttle service by RTS. RTS Gator Aider/Regional Transit System provides local park & ride service from the following locations:

- The Oaks Mall in former Toys 'R' Us parking area located in the SW corner of the Mall parking lot.
- The Hilton Hotel & Conference Center
- Haile Plantation at Haile Village Center
- Town of Tioga at the Tioga Town Center
- Downtown Parking Garage
- Celebration Pointe

The service costs \$10 per game or \$50 for the 2021 season. Game ride tickets can be purchased using the PASS-PORT Transit app in advance, or on the day of the game using a credit card. Tickets can be purchased at Park and Ride locations the day of game. Cash only. Service begins three hours before the game, and the last bus departs 10 minutes prior to kickoff. Return buses run at the start of the 4th quarter and throughout the first hour after the game ends. All locations and busses are ADA accessible. Contact RTS at (352) 334-2600 TDD/TTY 711 or <http://go-rts.com/gator-aiders/> for more information. This is a special service. Gator1 ID cards are not valid.

## RV PARKING

For non-Gator Boosters RV parking questions, please call UF Transportation and Parking Services at 352-392-8048 TDD/TTY 711. All RVs must use an exhaust extension pipe to project all fumes upward and away from other parking lot users. No RV parking will be permitted unless you have a football gameday RV parking pass. Overnight parking will not be permitted on campus anytime (pre- or post-game).

## DISABLED PARKING

Reserved disabled parking passes are distributed prior to the season to qualified season ticket holders, and are given based on season ticket longevity. Passes are for one of three areas: the O'Connell Center Lot, Murphree Hall area, and adjacent to the infirmary, off Fletcher Drive.

Fans who do not qualify for a reserved disabled parking pass are encouraged to park at Garage IX, on the South side of Archer Road on Gale Lemerand Drive, and utilize the free lift-equipped disabled bus with their state-issued disabled placard to the Graham Hall Parking lot. Two tickets will be dispersed at no cost, per state-issued placard. If more tickets are needed, they can be purchased on-site.

## ADA SHUTTLES

Shuttles pick up at Garage IX (located at the intersection of Archer Road and Gale Lemerand Drive) and drop off at the Graham Hall Parking lot. Service is free for disabled patrons using state-issued placards. Service begins four hours prior to kickoff and ends at kickoff. Return service begins at the start of the fourth quarter and ends 30 minutes after the game has finished.

## ATMS

ATMs are located near Gates 8 and 18.

## DISABLED SERVICES

Wheelchair seating is located in the North and South End Zones of the lower concourse and in select areas of the Ben Hill Griffin Stadium. Those fans needing a wheelchair space or accessible seating should call the Gator Ticket Office at (800) 34-GATOR or (352) 375-4683, ext. 6800 TDD/TTY 711 prior to game day. Tickets should be purchased prior to your arrival at the stadium.

## FIRST AID STATIONS

There are eight (8) locations inside the Stadium for medical treatment:

- South End Zone: 2nd level concourse behind Section 53.
- North End Zone: Centrally located on each level.
- East Stands: Lower concourse between Gates 13 and 14.
- West Stands: Two (2) stations, lower concourse outside Gate 2 and outside Gate 3.
- Skyboxes: South end of Evans Champions Club (5th Floor).

Physicians and emergency medical personnel are available at the First Aid Stations to respond to any emergency medical needs. Please ask security personnel for assistance/directions to the nearest station.

## GATORS SPORTSHOP, THE OFFICIAL SHOP OF FLORIDA ATHLETICS

Gator merchandise can be purchased at various locations throughout the stadium. The two main Gator Sportshops are located at the North End Zone at Gate 9 and South End Zone inside Gate 18. Both accept credit, debit cards, Apple Pay and Google Pay. The North End Zone store is open Monday-Saturday from 10 a.m.-5 p.m., year-round, and 11 a.m.-3 p.m. on Sundays following home football games. The South End Zone store is open Monday-Saturday from 10 a.m.-3 p.m. Gators souvenir stands are located throughout the main concourse areas of the Stadium, and feature additional items not available at the Gator Sportshop.

### GUEST SERVICES BOOTHS

Guest Services booths are located on the stadium concourse at Gates 1, 7, and 16 on game days. Representatives can also be found throughout the Stadium in bright green shirts. Several services are available, including Tag-A-Fan, emergency paging, lost & found turn-in, etc.

### LOST & FOUND

Lost and found articles can be reported or turned in to any Gator Guest Services representative. On game day, all items may be retrieved at the main Guest Services desk in the UAA Ticket Office Lobby (between Gates 1 & 2). Afterwards, all items are held at the UAA Operations Office (800) 34-GATOR or (352) 375-4683, ext. 6800 TDD/TTY 711. Fans can also visit [FloridaGators.com/lostandfound](http://FloridaGators.com/lostandfound) to submit a lost item form and relocate their items.

### TEXT MESSAGE SYSTEM

### TOBACCO USE

The University of Florida is a tobacco-free campus, and the UAA adheres to this policy at all of its facilities. Violators are subject to ejection. Electronic cigarettes and vape pens are also prohibited.

### FAN CODE OF CONDUCT

Gator fans are widely known for their enthusiasm, team support, hospitality and sportsmanship. Our image is shaped not only by our student-athletes, coaches, students and faculty, but by our fans as well. Our goal is to create a first-class environment to lend support to our team while maintaining a safe and fun atmosphere. Fans must follow safety and health guidelines as indicated by on-premise signage and any potential SEC guidelines regarding COVID-19.

### PROHIBITED BEHAVIOR

Threatening or inconsiderate behavior such as profane and abusive language, use of tobacco, fighting, and drunkenness will not be tolerated and can result in ejection, arrest, and/or loss of season-ticket privileges. Standing on seats/bleachers, and throwing of any objects in the stands or onto the field, is also prohibited. Should you observe any of this disruptive behavior, please notify your nearest law enforcement officer. NCAA policy prevents fans from entering the field of play unless they are properly credentialed or accompanied by an authorized staff member. Violators are subject to arrest.

### ENFORCEMENT

Individuals found violating any policies can be removed from the stadium.

Non-students, while not affected by the Student Conduct Code, are subject to arrest and prosecution under applicable laws and state statutes.

Offenders' names will be forwarded to the UAA by the law enforcement representative reporting the citation. The offender may be contacted by the UAA and issued a warning that a future violation could result in loss of ticket privileges. Season-ticket holders are responsible for the behavior of anyone using their tickets and will be subject to this policy if the person using their ticket violates the Code of Conduct.

Students involved in such activities or other disruptive behavior also will be subject to disciplinary action through the Dean of Students' Office and University of Florida's Code of Student Conduct. Students enjoy the rights and privileges that they gain as a member of the University community and are subject to the responsibilities that accompany that membership.

The University Athletic Association reserves the right to remove the ticketholder from the premises if in the sole opinion of the security personnel his or her conduct endangers or disrupts the players, coaches, officials or fans.

### PROHIBITED ITEMS

- Alcoholic beverages
- Artificial noise makers
- Backpacks
- Bags not compliant with the clear bag policy
- Cameras with extendable lenses larger than six inches
- Electric Scooters, skateboards
- Flags
- Ice chests or bags
- Outside food or drink (fans are permitted to bring one commercially branded, i.e.: Aquafina, empty plastic water bottle, no larger than 20 oz., into Ben Hill Griffin Stadium)
- Personal seatbacks
- Strollers
- Tobacco products (including e-cigarettes, vapor pens, and chewing tobacco)
- Umbrellas
- Video cameras/cases
- Weapons

Any permissible clear plastic, vinyl or PVC bag that does not exceed 12"x6"x-12" or small clutch no larger than 4.5"x6.5", is subject to inspection upon entry into the Stadium. Please note that any clear bags larger than the permissible size, as well as any non-clear bags, large carry bags, or backpacks are not permitted inside Ben Hill Griffin Stadium.

If you require the use of medical equipment or devices throughout your time at Ben Hill Griffin Stadium, please note that all items will need to be inspected and approved by stadium medical personnel at the gates.

Prohibited items must be returned to vehicles or disposed of before entering the Stadium.

There are no provisions to check items at the gates.

Gameday staff including law enforcement officials have the right to inspect any item at any time for the purpose of spectator safety. Any items that are deemed hazardous by game management personnel will not be permitted inside Ben Hill Griffin Stadium.
