Joan Gabel became the 19th chancellor of the University of Pittsburgh on July 17, 2023. In this role, she oversees a community of nearly 34,000 students and more than 14,000 faculty and staff members across five distinct campuses, all working to advance Pitt's legacy of academic excellence, community service and research innovation.

She previously served as the president and chief executive of the University of Minnesota System and Twin Cities campus. Under her leadership, the University of Minnesota developed its first comprehensive systemwide strategic plan. That plan resulted in record-setting graduation rates and annual research expenditures, as well as unmatched startups, patents and private giving, including the completion of a \$4 billion capital campaign that exceeded its goal by 10%. Transformational partnerships, such as the NXT GEN MED program between the

university, Mayo Clinic and Google, have led to reimagined research and student opportunities.

Prior to joining the University of Minnesota System, she served as executive vice president for academic affairs and provost at the University of South Carolina and as dean of the Robert J. Trulaske, Sr. College of Business at the University of Missouri. Gabel began her teaching career at Georgia State University, then joined Florida State University where she was the DeSantis Professor of Legal Studies; chair of the Department of Risk Management and Insurance, Real Estate and Legal Studies; and director of international relations within the College of Business.

Gabel is the recipient of numerous research, service and teaching awards, including recognition as a Fulbright scholar. She currently serves as vice chair for the Council on Competitiveness and on the boards of the American Council on Education, the Association of Public and Land Grant Universities, and Fulbright (CIES), among others. She holds a bachelor's degree in philosophy from Haverford College and a Juris Doctor from the University of Georgia School of Law.

The University of Pittsburgh is a state-related university and world leader in education, research and innovation with more than 330,000 alumni worldwide. Founded as the Pittsburgh Academy in 1787, the University is one of the oldest institutions of higher education in the nation and has a campus in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, as well as four regional campuses located throughout Western Pennsylvania.



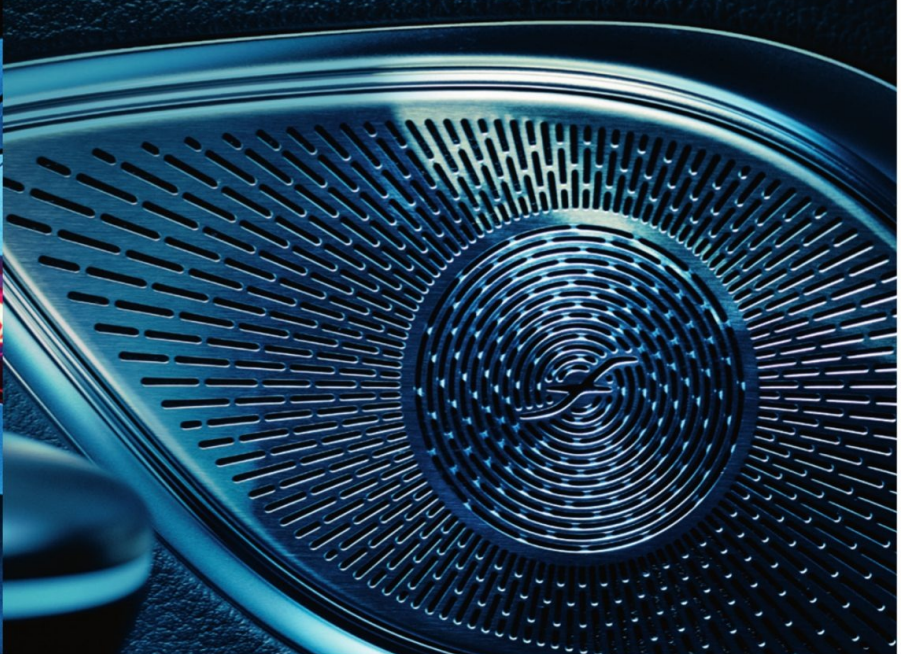

Under the leadership of Heather Lyke, Pitt Athletics is enjoying a remarkable and unmistakable ascension.

The Panthers' rising tide of success reached exciting heights during the 2022-23 year of competition, drawing national raves and accolades.

Wrote Pat Forde for Sports Illustrated, "Pitt athletics, once one of the weakest links in the well-rounded ACC and all of the Power 5 conferences, has become a broad-based success story."

Prophetically, upon her appointment as Pitt's director of athletics in March 2017, Lyke passionately spoke of achieving "comprehensive excellence." Pitt Athletics across the board, she said, would aspire high in every endeavor—athletically, academically and in the community.

That lofty goal has now become a reality thanks to Lyke's vision, unwavering commitment and good old-fashioned hard work.

National observers are taking notice of Lyke's blueprint for Pitt success. The National Association of Collegiate Directors of Athletics (NACDA) honored her as a 2023 Cushman & Wakefield AD of the Year Award recipient. She additionally was a finalist for the Sports Business Journal Athletic Director of

the Year award.

The Panthers' superlatives in 2022-23 were as plentiful as they were impressive. Among the highlights:

- Pitt achieved its highest point total ever in the LEARNFIELD Directors' Cup with nine teams combining to score 469 points. The Panthers finished 52nd out of 298 Division I schools, placing them among the top 17% of the NCAA's highest classification.
- Football defeated UCLA in the Sun Bowl and earned back-to-back Top 25 finishes for the first time since 1982-83.
- Volleyball advanced to its second consecutive Final Four, firmly establishing the program as a national power.
- Men's soccer advanced to the College Cup for the second time in three seasons, also signaling its arrival as a national title contender.
- Women's soccer made its first NCAA Tournament appearance and earned a Sweet 16 berth.
- Men's basketball returned to March Madness, winning multiple NCAA Tournament games for the first time since 2009.
- Wrestler Nino Bonaccorsi won the NCAA 197-pound championship, becoming Pitt's first individual wrestling national champion since 2008.
- Ilse Steigenga was a first team All-American in the indoor long jump, becoming the first Pitt woman to earn such stature in that event since 1999.
- For the first time in program history, Pitt had two runners qualify for NCAA Cross Country Championship. Jack Miller and Luke Henseler become the first Pitt male runners to qualify for the NCAA Championships overall since 1994.
- A record 343 Pitt student-athletes were named to the 2023 Atlantic Coast Conference Academic Honor Roll.
- Pitt Athletics ranked No. 5 among all NCAA schools in the 2022-23 HelperHelper Teamworks Challenge, which tracks student-athlete community service hours.

Each of these successes come as no surprise to those who have observed Lyke's career. The first woman to hold the full-time director of athletics post at the University of Pittsburgh, her influence has been evident in the recruitment of nationally regarded head coaches, ambitious facility plans and a strengthened focus on the total student-athlete experience.

Lyke's leadership has been crucial for Pitt in a quickly changing collegiate athletics landscape. This has been especially evident in the realm of Name, Image, Likeness. Upon the new NCAA legislation taking effect, Lyke launched the Pitt NIL Program, an innovative initiative designed to equip Pitt's student-athletes with the knowledge and resources necessary to maximize their personal brand, platform and opportunities.

Generating resources and support for Pitt Athletics has been a major priority for Lyke's administration. Those efforts produced a record \$67 million raised over the past two fiscal years. That total included a historic \$20 million gift from 1997 alumnus Chris Bickell, the largest single donation in Pitt Athletics history.

Bickell's gift was the latest monumental donation received during Lyke's tenure. Previously, former Pitt All-American Aaron Donald, who now stars for the Los Angeles Rams, made a seven-figure financial commitment to the Pitt Football Championship Fund, the largest donation ever by a Pitt football letterman to the program.

Lyke's state-of-the-art facilities plan—known as "Victory Heights"—continues to steam ahead with construction beginning on a \$240 million sports performance center (that will serve 16 of Pitt's 19 teams) and a 3,000-seat arena for gymnastics, volleyball and wrestling.

The Victory Heights vision began with a recently completed \$16 million expansion of the Petersen Sports Complex. This included a third-floor addition featuring coaches office suites and conference rooms; the P.J. Dick, Trumbull, Lindy Paving Team Meeting Room with theatre-style seating; and the Bill and Sissy Lieberman Student-Athlete Lounge that features a 14-foot video wall, outdoor patio and communal spaces.

Future Victory Heights construction will include an eight-lane, 300-meter indoor track for the men's and women's programs as well as a band facility.

Lyke has presided over Pitt's highly productive relationship with the top sports apparel company in the world, NIKE, which outfits each of the Panthers' 19 athletics programs. She led a dynamic rebrand of Pitt's athletic marks and logos in 2019 that simultaneously evoked the Panthers' proud past while boldly anticipating the future. The rebrand continues to receive high praise not only among Pitt's faithful but also from national observers.

From an Equity, Diversity and Inclusion standpoint, Pitt Athletics unveiled a five-year strategic plan—Panthers United—aimed at fostering an inclusive environment for its student-athletes, coaches and staff. The strategic plan includes five areas of focus: recruitment and hiring; retention, development and success; a culture of belonging; positively impacting the community; and raising awareness and celebrating Pitt Athletics' EDI efforts.

Lyke's influence has not been limited to Pitt. She is an ACC representative on the NCAA Division I Council, a high-level group responsible for decision-making that shapes the future for all of Division I Athletics. She has been on the front lines of vital NCAA legislation geared to help student-athletes navigate this climate and beyond.

She also provides leadership for a number of prominent committees and professional organizations. Lyke is Chair of the ACC Director of Athletics group as well as the NCAA Division I Football Oversight Committee. She serves on the Executive Committee and as Board Chair for LEAD1, which represents the 131 athletic directors at the FBS level. Lyke additionally is on the NACDA Executive Committee and the board of directors for Women Leaders for College Sports, the UPMC Hillman Cancer Center and P3R.

During the 50th anniversary year of Title IX, Lyke's perspectives were highly sought from various national organizations and media outlets. She was a featured voice in the panel discussion "50 Years of Title IX in College Sports: Celebrating the History and Impact of Title IX and Discussing a Vision for the Future" held in Washington D.C.

Lyke owns an exemplary record of increasingly high-level roles in collegiate athletics administration that spans nearly three decades.

From 2013-17, Lyke served as vice president and director of athletics at Eastern Michigan University. Prior to EMU, she was a ranking athletic administrator at Ohio State for 15 years. Lyke additionally held posts at the University of Cincinnati and with the NCAA.

Lyke found the beginning of her professional path during her days as a scholarship student-athlete at the University of Michigan, where she captained the Wolverines' Big Ten champion softball team. She earned a bachelor's degree in education from Michigan and a Juris Doctor from the University of Akron School of Law.

At Eastern Michigan, Lyke oversaw a department that sponsored 21 varsity sports with more than 550 student-athletes. Her tenure witnessed high levels of achievement not only in the competitive arena but also academically and from a fundraising standpoint.

Eastern Michigan received the Excellence in Management Cup presented by Texas A&M's Laboratory for the Study of Intercollegiate Athletics. The "EM Cup" annually recognizes the athletic department that best maximizes fiscal resources through championship victories. EMU ranked No. 1 out of 128 Football Bowl Subdivision schools for 2015-16.

EMU annually distinguished itself in the Mid-American Conference under Lyke's watch. The Eagles captured 16 MAC team championships, garnered 17 MAC Coach of the Year awards and had nearly 400 MAC All-Academic honorees during her tenure. For the first time in school history, Eastern Michigan was honored with the MAC's Cartwright Award for all-around athletic department excellence (2013-14) and the Jacoby Award for female athletic excellence (2014-15).

Lyke spearheaded numerous capital improvement projects for EMU Athletics. The highest profile was the installation of college football's first gray Revolution Field Turf playing surface in 2014. Dubbed "The Factory" in honor of the region's automobile industry history, the field was selected No. 2 among all colleges in a USA Today fan vote (behind only the University of Tennessee).

In 2014, Lyke became the first woman to chair the NCAA Men's Lacrosse Committee. She additionally chaired the Mid-American Conference's Cost of Attendance Task Force.

From 1998-2013, Lyke worked at Ohio State, where she was a member of the athletic department's executive team and a lead figure in the development of the Buckeyes' strategic plan. Lyke directly oversaw 10 of Ohio State's 36 athletic programs and had oversight of all facets of the athletic councils involving budget, revenue generation, facilities and OSU's golf course operations.

She additionally supervised the Buckeyes' sport performance division, which included the strength and conditioning coaches, athletic training staff and sports medicine staff. Lyke also developed Ohio State's first student-athlete internship program, "Bucks Go Pro."

During her Ohio State tenure, the Big Ten Network tapped her expertise as a color analyst for softball telecasts from 2009-13.

Lyke served at Cincinnati as the assistant athletic director for compliance as well as the senior woman administrator from 1996-98. She began her career at the NCAA as an intern in the enforcement and student-athlete reinstatement department from 1995-96.

Born and raised in Canton, Ohio, Lyke starred at GlenOak High School in volleyball, basketball and softball. She accepted a softball scholarship from Michigan, where she lettered four years as a first baseman and was an All-Academic Big Ten honoree. She was a two-time team captain and helped Michigan to the 1992 Big Ten championship.

Lyke and her husband, David Catalano, have three children: Elle, Sophie and Eli.

Like the region it calls home, Pitt football under Pat Narduzzi has proven to be rugged, relentless and continuously rising.

Upon his hiring on December 26, 2014, Narduzzi pledged his Panthers would “play with a tough, blue-collar mentality—and how else would you want it in the City of Pittsburgh?”

Promise kept.

The ninth-year Chris Bickell '97 Head Football Coach has made an emphatic imprint on Pitt's program. His vision for the Panthers—on and off the field—continues to bear fruit with each passing season.

The momentum continued in 2022. Pitt finished 9-4, including a stirring 37-35 win over nationally ranked UCLA in the Sun Bowl. The victory in El Paso drew national raves as one of the most exciting bowl results of the year.

Pitt was one of the nation's hottest teams at season's end, closing with five consecutive wins by an average margin of 14 points.

The Panthers finished in the national Top 25 for the second consecutive season, placing No. 22 in both major polls. It marked the first time since 1979-83 that Pitt earned Top 25 finishes in back-to-back years.

It was a satisfying encore to the historic 2021 campaign, when the Panthers stormed to 11 victories and claimed their first outright conference title with a 45-21 triumph over Wake Forest in the ACC Championship Game. Pitt earned a No. 13 ranking in the final 2021 polls, its highest finish since 1982.

Narduzzi directed the Panthers to a combined 20 wins over the past two seasons. Pitt last achieved 20 wins over a two-year span in 1981-82.

The milestones have not been limited to the past two years. Indeed, the entirety of Narduzzi's tenure has been characterized by exciting achievements and ascension.

- Narduzzi has compiled a 62-41 overall record as the Panthers' head coach. His 62 victories rank second all-time at Pitt, trailing only the legendary Jock Sutherland, who compiled 111 wins from 1924-38.
- From 2015-22, Narduzzi directed Pitt to 41 victories in ACC play, the conference's second-highest win total during that span, trailing only Clemson (60).
- Narduzzi has coached nine first team All-Americans at Pitt. In 2022, defensive tackle Calijah Kancey earned unanimous All-America status, the Panthers' first unanimous pick since defensive tackle Aaron Donald in 2013.
- Over the past three seasons (2020-22), Pitt ranks third nationally (first in the ACC) with four consensus All-Americans. In addition to Kancey, wide receiver Jordan Addison (2021) and defensive ends Patrick Jones II (2020) and Rashad Weaver (2020) were consensus selections.
- Under Narduzzi's watch, Pitt continues to produce high-level NFL prospects. Six Pitt products—Kancey, offensive tackle Carter Warren, running back Israel Abanikanda, linebacker SirVocea Dennis and safeties Erick Hallett II and Brandon Hill—were selected in the 2023 NFL Draft, the most in the ACC (tied with Clemson) and fifth most nationally.
- Over the past three drafts (2021-23), the Panthers' 14 picks are the most of any ACC program. (Clemson is second with 13.)
- Kancey was drafted in the first round by the Tampa Bay Buccaneers, marking the second consecutive year Pitt produced a first-round pick. In the 2022 draft, quarterback Kenny Pickett was a first-round selection of the Pittsburgh Steelers—the first Pitt QB to be picked in the opening round since Dan Marino in 1983.
- Narduzzi's Panthers have a well-earned reputation as a dangerous opponent for highly ranked foes. In 2019, Pitt scored a 35-34 triumph over UCF, which visited Heinz Field riding a 27-game non-bowl winning streak. The winning touchdown—a gadget-play pass caught by quarterback Kenny Pickett—has been immortalized as the “Pitt Special.”
- In 2017, Pitt closed the season with a 24-14 victory over No. 2 Miami, which entered the game undefeated and on the cusp of the College Football Playoff.
- In 2016, the Panthers defeated two teams that finished in the top 5 of the final CFP rankings. Pitt gave No. 2 Clemson—that year's national champion—its only loss (43-42) and kept No. 5 Penn State out of the playoff field by defeating the Nittany Lions, 42-39.
- Pitt has also thrived off the field under Narduzzi's watch. During the 2021-22 academic year, Pitt led all college football programs in community service hours per Helper Helper.

- During Narduzzi's tenure, Pitt has two recipients of the Disney Spirit Award, presented to the most inspirational figure in college football: James Conner (2016) and Tre Tipton (2021). Additionally, Deslin Alexandre was honored as the Jason Witten Collegiate Man of the Year and the male collegiate recipient of the Coach Wooden Citizenship Cup for 2022.

- In 2020, Pitt earned an NCAA Public Recognition Award for achieving an Academic Progress Rate (APR) score that ranked in the top 10% of all football programs. The Panthers' multi-year 988 APR set a Pitt football program record and was 24 points higher than the national average.

Narduzzi has engrained toughness and tenacity into the program's culture. His passionate approach has spurred Pitt's rise in the ACC and nationally. Moreover, he is committed—in both word and deed—to his student-athletes' long-term growth.

That last point was vividly illustrated when Narduzzi and his wife, Donna, made a six-figure financial gift to the Pitt Football Championship Fund, which serves the program in such key areas as student-athlete development, facility improvement, technology and recruiting.

"I take great pride in wearing that Pitt Script on my chest each day as the University of Pittsburgh's head football coach," Narduzzi said. "This is an outstanding place with so many amazing people. Donna and I feel incredibly blessed to call Pitt our home.

"This gift is an expression of our thankfulness for the people of Pitt, especially the student-athletes we get to work with each day. Our responsibility is to give them the finest experiences possible—academically, athletically and personally. Donna and I feel truly honored and fortunate to be able to provide support for that mission at Pitt."

Narduzzi arrived at Pitt following eight highly successful years as the defensive coordinator at Michigan State under former head coach Mark Dantonio. During that time the Spartans achieved five Top 25 finishes and Narduzzi's defense proved instrumental in that success. Michigan State was the only team to rank in the nation's top 10 in total defense and rushing defense each season from 2011-14.

In 2014, the Spartans finished with a No. 5 national ranking and 11-2 record following a stirring 42-41 victory over Baylor in the AT&T Cotton Bowl. Narduzzi's defense shut out the high-scoring Bears in the fourth quarter, opening the door for 21 unanswered points by Michigan State.

Michigan State boasted the nation's top rushing defense in 2014, yielding just 88.5 yards per game. The Spartans finished third nationally with 34 turnovers gained and eighth in total defense, holding opponents to just 315.8 yards per contest.

In 2013, Michigan State finished No. 3 in the country following a Big Ten title and 24-20 victory over No. 5 Stanford in the Rose Bowl. In the wake of that championship season, Narduzzi was named the 2013 recipient of the prestigious Broyles Award, annually presented to the country's top assistant coach.

Narduzzi tutored an impressive list of decorated defensive players at Michigan State, including first team All-Americans in cornerback Darqueze Dennard, safety Kurtis Drummond, linebacker Greg Jones and defensive tackle Jerel Worthy.

Dennard was a unanimous All-American in 2013, becoming the first Michigan State cornerback to earn that distinction. He also was the school's first winner of the Jim Thorpe Award, given annually to college football's top defensive back. Dennard was a first-round NFL Draft pick of the Cincinnati Bengals in 2014, the first Spartans defensive back taken in the initial round since 1961. In the 2015 draft, another Narduzzi pupil, Michigan State cornerback Trae Waynes, was a first-round pick of the Minnesota Vikings.

Narduzzi coached 19 first-team All-Big Ten selections. Four players won the conference's top individual awards under his watch, including two Big Ten Defensive Back of the Year honorees (Dennard in 2013 and Drummond in 2014). Shilique Calhoun was the Big Ten Defensive Lineman of the Year in 2013 while Greg Jones was the overall Defensive Player of the Year in 2009.

Prior to Michigan State, Narduzzi spent three years (2004-06) as defensive coordinator under Dantonio at Cincinnati, helping the Bearcats to a pair of bowl invitations.

In 2003, Narduzzi was the defensive coordinator at Miami of Ohio under the late Terry Hoepfner. The RedHawks stormed to a 13-1 record that season, capturing the Mid-American Conference (MAC) championship and defeating nationally ranked Louisville in the GMAC Bowl to finish No. 10 in the Associated Press poll. While quarterback Ben Roethlisberger headlined Miami's offense, Narduzzi's stout unit topped the MAC in rushing defense (19th nationally), scoring defense (22nd nationally) and pass efficiency defense (34th nationally).

Narduzzi served as linebackers coach at Northern Illinois for three seasons (2000-02). NIU won a pair of MAC divisional titles during his tenure and in 2002 had the league's top rushing defense.

From 1993-99, Narduzzi coached at his alma mater, Rhode Island, serving as the Rams' defensive coordinator his final two seasons. He began his coaching career at Miami of Ohio, working as a graduate

assistant in 1990 and 1991, before earning his first full-time position as receivers coach for the 1992 season.

Narduzzi was an All-Ohio performer at Youngstown's Ursuline High School, leading the Irish to the Steel Valley championship and state playoffs as a senior in 1984. He was a starting linebacker under his father, the late Bill Narduzzi, as a freshman at Youngstown State University in 1985 before transferring to Rhode Island, where he became a three-year starter for the Rams from 1987-89.

Bill Narduzzi was head coach at YSU from 1975-85. He led the Penguins to two NCAA Division II playoff appearances, including the national championship game in 1979, and twice was named the Ohio Valley Conference (OVC) Coach of the Year. (One of Bill's first coaching posts was as a freshman line coach at Pitt in 1962.)

Narduzzi completed his bachelor's degree in physical education at Rhode Island in 1990 and later earned a master's degree in sports studies at Miami of Ohio in 1992.

He and his wife, Donna, have four children: Arianna, Christina, Patrick and Isabella.
