

# Tom McLaughlin Paces FSU Offense With 18

TAMPA, Jan 15, (AP)—The Tampa University Spartans posted their first win of the basketball season here tonight in defeating the Florida State University Seminoles, 63 to 51.

It was also the Spartan's first win in the Dixie conference and FSU's second loss. The Seminoles' record now stands six wins in 10 starts.

MacWilliams, former local high school player, paced the Spartans by scoring 19 points. He played a stellar game under the backboard. Williams was assisted by Harry Bryan who totaled 10 points and big Holland Aplin with 11.

Coach Bud Kennedy's cagers but the locals scored soon afterwards and never were headed.

Wild passing and fumbling marred the game on both sides for the first half which ended with the Spartans holding a 27-19 lead.

Tampa started off with a whirlwind of scoring in the second half. The Spartans ran up a 42-28 lead before the Seminoles rallied to score seven points.

Williams and Avron Bryan found the range again and between them scored four baskets and two foul throws to give the Spartans a 50-31 lead in the first half of the second period.

Tom McLaughlin, who scored 18 points for the Seminoles was their star. He kept his team in the running with fine work under the basket and playing the rebounds.

Coach Mike Gaddis of the locals gave every player on his squad a chance to show his wares. They played good but erratic ball.
