FSU Conquers Troy, 79 To 71

TROY, ALA., Feb. 15—(P)— Led by Forward Dick Kendall, who scored 28 points for the night, the FSU Seminoles racked up a 79-71 basketball victory over Troy State Teachers College here tonight.

The FSU club overcame an early Troy lead and were out front most of the way although Troy pulled within striking distance several times. FSU led at

halftime, 42-40.

Kendall's 28 points was high for the night while center Junior Jones of Troy topped the losers in the scoring column with 21. FSU showed a marked superiority on shots from the floor, bagging 34 field goals to 25 for Troy. The losers made good on 21 foul shots to 11 for FSU.
