

# SCORE OVER MOCS, 86-55

## Hartman Paces Indians with 20

LAKELAND, Dec. 16. (AP)—The undefeated Florida State University Seminoles ran their win streak to five games here tonight with an 86-55 basketball victory over Florida Southern college in a Dixie conference engagement.

Both teams were off in shooting free throws but Florida Southern was also unable to sink its field goals consistently. FSU missed 15 foul shots and Florida Southern 24.

After five minutes of the fast passing, quick shooting contest, Florida State led 10-4 and had widened the margin to 48-30 at the half. The Seminoles kept up their pace after the intermission when Southern found its defense ineffective.

Florida State's Bob Hartmann shot eight field goals and four free throws for the night's top of 20 points. D C Kinlaw was in the front of the Moccasin five with 13.

The defeat was Florida Southern's fifth in six starts, while the victory was FSU's third in the Dixie conference.
