## Hartman Paces FSU To 58-51 Cage Victory

BIRMINGHAM, Ala, Jan 20—With blonde Bob Hartman leading the way, Florida State University's Seminoles carved out a 58-51 decision over the Howard College Bulldogs in a Dixie conference cage tilt here Friday night.

Hartman, season-long scoring ace of Coach Bud Kennedy's Floridians, paced the Seminole attack with 19 points and turned in super floor game throughout. Hartman hit seven times from the field and five times from the free throw line to compile his total, but he had to relinquish scoring honors for the game to "Red" Parks. Bulldog sharpshooter. Parks piled up 24 points on eight field goals and eight foul shots to keep the Bulldogs in the battle.

## WIN NUMBER 9

The victory was Florida State's ninth against only three defeats as they moved another step nearer towards the completion of their most successful season in history. And the win was the second the Indians have scored over Howard this campaign. They beat the Bulldogs 60-44 in Tallahassee prior to the Christmas holidays.

FSU moved out in front in the opening minutes of the game and held an 11-6 edge at the 10-minute mark. The Bulldogs bounced back, however, to dominate the next 10-minutes of play and hit the halftime intermission with a 24-21 lead.

Coming out for the second half the Seminoles started to move again, and they fashioned a 48-39 lead with 10 minutes to play which they protected until the final buzzer.

Dick Trobaugh was runnerup to Hartman for the Seminoles with 11 points. Gann supported Parks with the same total.
