CLINTON, Miss.—Florida State University's Seminoles will be shooting for an even break on their two-game invasion of Mississippi tonight when they meet the Mississippi College Choctaws in a Dixie Conference cage game here.

The Ole Miss Rebels defeated FSU 79-75 in Oxford last night to hand the Seminoles their seventh loss of the season against 10 wins.

Ken Robbins led the Mississippi five with 19 points while Jack Merriman of Florida State captured high point honors in the game with 20 points.

Florida State, after trailing 41-30 at the halftime, rallied in the second half to tie the score at 44-44 with 15 minutes remaining.

From this point on, the score was tied four more times, and the lead changed hands nine times. Mississippi pulled away in the closing minutes on the accurate shooting of Robbins and Reeves to win the non-conference game.
