

WINTR PARK, Jan. 31—Rollins broke a seven game losing streak tonight to clinch an 82-79 basketball victory over Florida State.

With FSU leading 79-77 and a minute and a half to go, Cost hit a hook shot from beyond the foul circle. Then Bob MacHardy stole the ball and fed Cost for a layup shot. After that the only scoring was a free throw by MacHardy.

It was a see-saw game all the way, neither team able to get much of an edge, and it avenged an FSU win over Rollins at Tallahassee.

Cost, only a part time regular until tonight, was the top scorer along with FSU star Ham Wernke, each at 22 points. MacHardy had 21 for Rollins.
