

NEW ORLEANS, Feb. 21. (AP)—Loyola University of New Orleans broke away from a third quarter tie to defeat Florida State 85-77 in a basketball game here tonight.

Loyola took an early lead and held a 25-14 margin at the end of the first quarter. Halftime score was 42-39 in favor of Loyola. Florida closed the gap and at the end of the third they were tied 58-58.

High scorer for Loyola was Ron Reynold with 26.

For Florida State, Ham Wernke was first with 21 points, and Florida's Duane Gordon followed with 15.
