Florida State faces a major assignment here tonight, 8 o'clock, when it runs up against a team it has never beaten—Loyola of New Orleans. The Louisiana team has stopped FSU five times in a three-year span.

Loyola this year has another standout team, boasting a 7-2 record. Tuesday night Loyola extended Southeastern Conference power Louisiana State to the wire before bowing by four points, 69-65.

Jimmy Oler and Ham Wernke were the leaders for FSU in the scoring column last night, just as they have been all season. Oler bucketed 19 points and Wernke hit 17. Jerry Westhofer contributed 12.

Brooks of Tampa was the scoring leader for the night, however, with 22 points. Tampa played without the services of one regular, MacWilliams. He did not dress out.

-Tampa led briefly in the early moments, stepping out 2-0 and later 4-3. After that it was FSU all the way.

The Seminoles vaulted to an 18-7 lead after one quarter, extended it to 36-21 at halftime and to 56-43 after three periods. An oddity of the game was that the Seminoles scored exactly 18 points in the first, second and fourth quarters.

Tonight's Loyola engagement will be the final home test for the Seminoles in a long span here. The squad hits the road for a game at Miami on Saturday. Next week, Florida Southern, Rollins, Tampa and Stetson are opponents in road tests.

The Seminoles will be without the services of 6-7 center Gary Wold tonight. He was due to leave tonight for an army induction examination in Jacksonville. Kennedy expects him to rejoin the squad Saturday in Miami,
