WINTER PARK—Florida State basketballers forged a sharp second-quarter rally here last night to bounce the Rollins College Tars by 32-72.

Behind 13 points at one stage in the opening quarter and trailing by 10 entering the second frame, FSU started connecting from the field with a series of goals that moved the Seminoles ahead. Rollins led at half-time, however, 37-36.

Dick Artmeier was the stick-out in a third quarter that saw the Seminoles gain ground and lead at the end of the period 60-57. With a balanced flurry the Seminoles sewed it up in the final quarter.

Artmeier led scoring with 22 points. Tom Dellahan contributed 16. Ham Wernke 15 and Jimmy Oler. Rick Benson had 13 apiece for the Seminoles.

Bob MacHardy was Rollins' top man with 14.

Coach Bud Kennedy was pleased with the comeback effort of his squad and said he thought that much of the physical and mental effects of Friday's accident, in which an FSU station wagon overturned and slightly injured several players, was behind the squad.

The Seminoles play at Tampa tonight.
