Florida State's basketball Seminoles popped a school record last night as they rolled to a 99-72 conquest of Florida Southern here last night.

Earlier this season Bud Kennedy's boys had set a school mark for points scored in a single game when they topped this same Southern team by 98-80 in Lakeland. Last night's total of 99 put the Seminoles one better.

A new record for field goals was also set, with 39. Three years ago, FSU pumped in 37 against Southern.

Bill Leach, playing his-final game for Southern, racked up 33 points. He got 20 in the first half. Leach graduates next month.

The Seminoles will be idle for over a week. Their next game is at Mercer a week from tomorrow.
