Oler, Gordon, Wernke Spark Tribe, Each Hitting Over 20

STATESBORO, Ga. (AP)—A trio of fast-moving teammates paced Florida State University to an 89-85 victory over Georgia Teachers College last night.

Guard Jim Oler poured in 23 points and forward Duane Gordon followed with 22. Ham Wernke, a guard, completed the triangular attack with 21 points.

FSU, trailing 69-68 as the fourth quarter began, pushed ahead with an eight-point rush as the game went into crucial stages. The Teachers made a quick recovery and knotted the score at 79-79, but FSU moved at a faster clip during the closing minutes.

The Floridians found their margin of victory at the free throw line, sinking 21 while GTC got only 13.

Center Chester Webb of GTC was high scorer for the game with 31 points.
