

Senior guard Ham Wernke put on a dazzling second-half scoring display as Florida State's unbeaten Seminoles knocked down Stetson, 94-79, for their fourth straight basketball victory here last night.

It was the second win for FSU in the six-team Florida Intercollegiate Basketball Conference race and ran the Seminoles' home-court winning streak to eight games. State has lost only twice in its last 22 Tallahassee starts.

Last night's victory was due largely to another smooth team effort on a mixed fast-break and play-pattern offense.

But it was Wernke, two-time Helms All-American, who led a furious last-half charge that kept Stetson coach Dick Morland sending a steady stream of subs onto the floor.

Wernke fired in 10 field goals and two free throws for a 22-point second half. It was one of the finest 20-minute scoring sprees in Seminole history. Getting most of his points on fast-break layins, Ham finished with 28 points.

Jimmy Oler, FSU's play-maker, hit 15 points in the first half and wound up with 21 points. Forward Dick Artmeier, junior who improves with every game, meshed 18 points before fouling out with eight minutes left.

Stetson made it interesting for the first 10 minutes, but wilted when the Seminoles started running. Jim Kitchens, only a freshman, led the Hi-Hatters with 22 points.

FSU tosses its perfect record on the line Monday night in a West Campus game with Miami.
