

**STATE COLLEGE, Miss. (AP)**—Sharpshooting guards Jimmy Oler and Ham Wernke led Florida State to a 91-76 basketball victory over Mississippi State Wednesday night.

Oler, who had 11 free throws, led scorers with 27 points. Wernke followed with 23 points.

Sophomore guard Jim Ashmore, who fouled out late in the game, paced the losers with 24 points to maintain his scoring average at 22.6 points a game—third highest in the Southeastern Conference.

The Mississippians took an early lead before Oler sank a field goal to tie it at 11-11 after five minutes. It was tied six times during the first half before Florida State went ahead 28-26 with three minutes remaining before intermission. The half ended 43-40.

In the second half, the losers moved ahead 46-45, but two minutes later Florida State took the lead 49-48 and was in front the rest of the way.

It was Florida State's 11th victory against two losses and Mississippi State's eighth loss in 12 games.
