

• DELAND, Jan. 29 (AP)—Rick Benson's tip-ins, combined with the usual high scoring performances of Jimmy Oler and Ham Wernke, gave Florida State an 84-73 victory over Stetson in a Florida Intercollegiate Conference basketball game Saturday night.

Benson hit three quick baskets in the opening minutes that got FSU off to a 6-0 lead and, although Stetson later caught up, the Hatters played an uphill game most of the way. FSU led at halftime 38-21.

Wernke came up with scoring honors on 25 points when his teammate Oler missed 10 free throws and scored only 21. Benson had 20.

Bobby Crumpton topped Stetson scoring with 17 points. Bill Reynolds, 6-foot-4 sophomore, played his best game for the hatters, rebounding and handling the ball well and scoring 12 points.
