

STATESBORO, Ga., Jan. 14.—Florida State's Jim Oler and Georgia Teachers' Chet Webb poured in 41 points apiece here tonight but GTC came out with a 90-81 victory in a see-saw basketball game.

The visitors fell behind 7-0 in the opening minutes of the contest but rallied to go ahead. From there the score was tied eight times and there was never more than five points separating the two clubs until Georgia Teachers put on a closing drive.

HIKES AVERAGE

Oler, who boosted his season total to 460 points, scored 12 field goals and added 17 of 23 free throws for his night's work. The 5-10 guard from Economy, Ind., upped his average to 28.7 points per game in 16 contests.

Webb, a 6-7 center, hit 13 from the floor and scored 15 of 19 foul shots for 41 counters.

Forward Dick Artmeier and Center Gary Wold contributed 14 and 12 points, respectively, for FSU. The Seminoles, off their successful free throw pace, made good on just 65 per cent tonight. They hit 23 and missed 12 while Georgia Teachers put through 26 of 38 charity tosses.

SPLIT ON ROAD

The defeat left FSU with a split on the road trip. The Seminoles edged Georgia 79-76 in Athens Friday night.

for the season with 10 games remaining. The Tribe plays Loyola of New Orleans at Tallahassee Monday night.
