## Seminoles Pound Troy State, 90-65

Oler Pours In 38 Points; Tampa Here For FIBC Tilt

Florida State basketballers, apparently unaffected by a three-week layoff, found the range early and late here last night, to deal Alabama's Troy State a 90-65 loss.

It was the 20th straight home court victory for the Seminoles, who meet the University of Tampa here tonight in an important Florida Intercollegiate Basketball Conference game. With Miami pressing from second place in the FIBC, the Tribe can't afford to lose to the Spartans.

FSU, which has yet to drop an FIBC contest, will be out after its 16th straight conference triumph in the Demonstration School gym tonight.

## AIMS AT MARK

On top of all this, Florida State's Jim Oler has been given a good chance to break the state scoring record of 549 points in one season he set last year. The stocky Tribe co-captain boosted his total to 527 last night, an average of 29.3 per game, and he needs just 23 tonight to establish a new standard.

In the win over the Red Wave of Troy State, the Seminoles were never behind from the time Oler sanw a pair of free throws in the opening seconds of play.

After building up a quick 16-2 lead, the winners coasted to a halftime margin of 48-31.

Oler, too, seemed unaffected by the inactivity. Playing all but the last two and a half minutes of the contest, the 5-10 guard scored 38 points.

## LARGE SUPPORT

The other Tribe co-captain, quiet Dick Artmeier, gave Oler

and FSU large support by chipping in 18 points and playing an able floor game.

Reserve Harry Jacobs, a 5-8 sophomore, led Troy State with 16 points, all coming on field goals. He missed only one.

Florida State coach Bud Kennedy cleared the bench in the final minutes, with every player seeing action.

The victory brings FSU's record to 11-7 with seven games remaining.
