FSU's Oler Breaks Own State College Score Mark

Gets 33, Runs Total To 560 As Seminoles Thump Spartans

Jim Oler broke his own school and state scoring mark here Tuesday night as Florida State used a strong second-half attack to crush a stubborn University of

Tampa five, 88-73.

Orler's total for the night— 33 — shattered the record the Tribe co-captain set last year in 26 contests when he scored 549 points. Oler's new standard, subject to plenty of change in the Seminoles' remaining five games, is now 560.

A COMEBACK

Leading only 45-42 at halftime, the winners ball-hawked the Spartans to carelessness in the first 10 minutes of the second stanza and collected the dividends in the last ten.

Dick Artmeier and Stu Gregory did most of the pressing for the Florida State team, which won its 21st straight home court contest. The triumph also went a long way towards a second Florida Intercollegiate Basketball Conference title for FSU as it was the Tribe's sixth without a loss. For the season the Seminoles have now won 12 and dropped seven. The Spartans are 3-6 in conference play.

BOSWORTH TOUGH

Junior center Bill Bosworth was tough under the boards for Tampa Tuesday night and maneuvered his way to 22 points, high for the losers. Guards Howard Bernstein and Fred Guzielek caused the Seminoles the most trouble from behind the circle, Bernstein, the Tampa ace, managing 15 and Guzielek two less.

6-7 forward Gary Wold fouled out for the Seminoles near the end of the first half, but Gregory, Artmeier and Bob Williams filled in adequately in the rebound department. Artmeier, only 6-1, grabbed 13 for the night's high.
