

Florida Intercollegiate Basketball Conference play against Miami's Hurricanes tomorrow night at 8:00 o'clock in the Men's Gymnasium.

Trailing the Wolfpack by a 38-26 margin at halftime, the Seminoles fell back to an 18-point deficit midway the third period, but as the final quarter started forward Fred Twomey and center Bob Williams took charge.

LED COMEBACK

Twomey popped in 14 markers in the second half to lead the scoring for both teams at 19 points, and Williams cleared the boards with 11 second half rebounds to help put the Tribe back in the game.

With one minute to go, the Tribe moved into a full-court press and tallied six points to none for the Wolfpack.

In total rebounds, the Wolfpack out-jumped the Seminoles 64-53, but the Tribe's shooting percentage from the floor showed 31.8 per cent to N. C. State's 29.5. The Wolfpack took 78 shots from the floor, hitting on 23 of them, while the Tribe connected on 22 out of 69 attempts.

Miami's Hurricanes dropped a 98-63 decision to Florida last night in Gainesville, but the Miamians have a 3-0 mark in Florida Intercollegiate Conference play with decisions over Florida Southern, Tampa, and Stetson.

Florida State's only loss in two seasons of FIBC play came in the final game of the Conference season last year when this same Miami team took a 91-85 decision in Miami. FSU won an earlier game 78-76 in Tallahassee and took the FIBC title with a 9-1 record.

MUTUAL FOES

Miami and Florida State have played two mutual opponents so far this season, with the Hurricanes coming out better in one clash and the Seminoles in the other.

The Hurricanes whipped Texas A&M 85-80 after the Aggies had dumped the Tribe 83-74, and Florida's Gators swamped the Hurricanes twice, by 89-65 and 98-63 scores, but barely nudged the Seminoles 67-65 on a last second field goal.

Freshman teams from the two schools will meet in a preliminary contest at 6:00 o'clock.
