WINTER PARK—Senior guard Bob Waits teamed with sophomore sensation Hugh Durham here last night as both scored 32 points to lead Florida State's Seminoles to a 97-94 win over Rollins.

The win was the third straight for the Seminoles in Florida Inter-collegiate Basketball Conference action, and gave them a 3-2 league mark for the year.

Rollins also came up with a 32-point man. Forward Bob Schuder, who had averaged only 4.1 until last night's contest, found the range with regularity to share scoring honors with the two Seminoles.

Durham continued his scoring spree that started when the Seminoles resumed action after mid-semester exams. The Louisville, Ky., lad has now scored 141 points in the past four games for a tremendous 35.1 per game scoring average.

Durham's season total to date now reads 336 in 17 games for a per game mark of 19.7.

Waits, who was the team's lead-

ing scorer until a mid-December slump, was sharp again, and his outside shooting, plus the set-shooting accuracy of guard Tom Garcia, who tallied 19 points, gave the Seminoles a three-man scoring punch for the night that accounted for 88 points.

The Tribe hit a good 45.8 per cent from the floor, but Rollins did even better with a mark of 48.9. Florida State made up the difference in floor shooting by hitting 27 out of 33 free throws while Rollins scored on 26 out of 43.
