**LAKELAND**—Florida Southern stopped Florida State's basketball winning streak at four straight here last night when the Southerners turned back Bud Kennedy's Seminoles by a 72-63 count.

For the first time in five games FSU's sophomore sensation, Hugh Durham, was held under 30 points. The Louisville,

Ky. shot maker still managed to turn in a creditable performance with 18 markers.

On the other hand, the Southerners came up with the big scorer for the night when Dan Tobin netted 32 points.

Only three Seminoles managed to break into double figures as the Florida State crew cooled down considerably from the 90-plus average that had been maintained during that four-game winning streak.

Stu Gregory rang up 10 points for the Seminoles, as did guard Bob Waits, and these two, plus Durham, were the story for FSU.

The Southerners also proved more efficient on the free throw line, connecting on 30 out of 38 attempts, while FSU could count only 21 out of 35.

The loss to Southern left FSU's Florida Intercollegiate Basketball Conference mark at 3 wins and 3 losses, and practically eliminated all chance the Seminoles had for a third straight FIBC title. Miami is currently in first place with a 5-0 standing.

The Seminoles have another
