Florida State's basketballers caught fire in the last half last night to blast Rollins College, 96-79, as hot-shot sophomore guard Hugh Durham scored 27 points.

With Durham, forward Larry Strom and guard Bobby Waits firing the surge, the Seminoles battled oack from a 54-45 halftime defict to even their FIBC mark at 4-4.

The victory was the Tribe's sixtli against 14 losses, and left the losers with a 5-20 record. Rollins is fifth in the conference with a 2-7 state.
