Guard Hugh Durham set a Florida State sophomore scoring record here last night as the Seminoles swamped Tampa 88-57, to close out their home basketball season.

Durham, a 8-0 soph from Louisville. Ky., scored 20 points to boost his season's total to 487, 19 better than the former sophomore standard set in 1952-53 by Ham, Wernke.
SENIORS OPEN

Coach Bud Kennedy started his live seniors in their final home game. Bob Ward. Stu Gregory. Bob Williams, Bob Waits and Fred Twomey, and three of them scored in double figures.

Gregory tossed in 16. Waits, the squad's number two scorer behind Durham, 17 and Ward 14 as the Tribe opened fast and coasted easily in to victory.

The victory evened the Seminoles' FIBC mark for the season at 5-5 as they closed out conference play, and gives them a 9-15 mark for the year with two games remaining:

Durham seems a cinch to become the second man in FSU basketball history to score 500 points in a season, Jimmy Oler being the only other

Oler tailied 743 points last year, for the existing school record,

b and had \$17 the year before.
Durham needs just 13 points in the next two games to become the second man to reach the 500 mark.

The Seminoles were off and running at the start, with Gregory and Waits exclusively scoring the first 18 points between them and the Tribe bolting to an 18-11 margin.

Since Kennedy started his five seniors. Durham played only 20; minutes of the ball game in scoring his 20 points, eight of which came in the last four minutes of play.

Kennedy alternated two teams freely in the second half, as the Spartans, winless in conference play, could do little to stop the flow of points.

HITTING FIGURES

The winning Seminoles made a good on 30 of 74 attempts from the field for a 420 average while Tampa hit just 22 of 75, only 22 per cent.

At the free throw line the Seminoles were good with 80 per cent of their attempts, 28 of 35, while Tamps made only 43 per cent from the charity line, 13 of 38.

Friday night, the Seminole cagers will be in Shreveport, La., to meet Centenary College and they close the 1956-57 season Saturday against Loyola of New Orleans in New Orleans.
